Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

#### No. 5 of 1926.

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 5 of 1891 intituled "An Ordinance to incorporate the Public Service Mutual Provident Association."

E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

- This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Service Mutual Provident Association Ordinance, No. 5 of 1926.
  - Section 1 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and the following shall be inserted in lieu thereof:
    - From and after the passing of this Ordinance, the Assistant Controller of Revenue or such other public officer of similar standing as the Governor may be pleased to appoint instead of him, the Chief Clerk of the Secretariat, the Chief Clerk of the Audit Office, and such and so many persons as now are members of the said association, or shall hereafter be admitted members of the corporation hereby constituted, whose names shall be inscribed in the register mentioned in section 11, shall be and become a corporation with continuance for ever under the name of "The Public Service Mutual Provident Association" (hereinafter referred to as the corporation), and by that name shall and may sue and be sued in all courts, and shall have full power and authority to have and to use a common seal, and change and alter the same at their will and pleasure.

Substitution of new sub-section for sub-section (1) of section 3 of the principal Ordinance.

Sub-section (1) of section 3 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and the following shall be inserted in lieu thereof:

(1) The affairs of the corporation shall, subject to the rules made as hereinafter provided, be administered by a committee of management consisting of-

(a) The officer for the time being lawfully acting as Assistant Controller of Revenue, or such other public officer of similar standing as the Governor may be pleased to appoint instead of him;

(b) The officer for the time being lawfully acting as Chief Clerk of the Secretariat;

(c) The officer for the time being lawfully acting as Chief Clerk of the Audit Office; and

(d) Seven members of the corporation to be elected once a year at the annual general meeting, subject to the proviso that if in service they should be officers stationed in Colombo.

Substitution of new section for section 5 of the principal Ordinance. President.

- Section 5 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and the following shall be inserted in lieu thereof:
  - (1) The officer for the time being lawfully acting as Assistant Controller of Revenue, or such other public officer of similar standing as the Governor may be pleased to appoint instead of him, shall be President of the said corporation and committee, and in case of his absence at any meeting a Chairman for the occasion shall be chosen by the members present.
  - (2) Such President shall receive such remuneration from the funds of the corporation as the Governor may from time to time direct, provided that such remuneration shall not exceed the sum of two hundred rupees per month or proportionately for any part of a month.

Committee of management.

- 5 Section 6 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and the following shall be inserted in lieu thereof:
  - 6. The committee of management shall subject to his consent select an officer of the Public Service with the approval of Government to act in the joint office of Secretary and Treasurer to the corporation, and the officer so appointed shall be duly seconded by Government on such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon from time to time between the Government and the said committee with the consent of the said officer, and he shall furnish security in such amount and in such manner as the said committee may from time to time direct.
- 6 Section 7 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and the following shall be inserted in lieu thereof:
  - 7. The Joint Secretary and Treasurer shall receive and keep account of all the moneys and funds belonging to the corporation, and shall pay all claims, loans, advances, and expenses authorized by the committee of management. He shall also prepare and submit monthly to the said committee an account of the transactions of the corporation, and generally act under the direction of the President.
- 7 Section 10 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and the following shall be inserted in lieu thereof:
  - 10. On the death, resignation, transfer from Colombo (if in service), or absence from the Island of any member of the committee of management not being the President or one of the two Chief Clerks of the offices mentioned in section 3 above, or in the event of such member of the committee of management ceasing to be a member of the corporation under the rules made as hereinafter provided, it shall be lawful for the remaining members of the committee of management to elect any member of the corporation as his successor, and the member so elected shall continue in office until the annual general meeting of the corporation next following his election. Provided that the member so elected, if in service, shall be stationed in Colombo.
- 8 Sub-section (3) of section 11 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph at the end thereof:
  - (d) Such other information as may be required by the committee of management from time to time.
- 9 Sub-section (1) of section 15 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by defeting the words "The secretary" in line I thereof and substituting therefor the words "The Joint Secretary and Treasurer."
- 10 Sub-section (1) of section 16 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and the following shall be inserted in lieu thereof:
  - 16. (1) An annual general meeting of the members of the corporation shall be held not later than the 30th day of September in each year, when there shall be submitted a balance sheet, a statement of assets and liabilities, and an account of receipts and disbursements during the twelve months ending the 30th day of June preceding, all of which shall be prepared by the Joint Secretary and Treasurer and duly audited.
- 11 The following section shall be inserted as section 20 A f the principal Ordinance:
- 20 A. The funds of the corporation shall be placed in the name of the corporation in one or more banks to be approved by the Governor in Executive Council, and such funds may be operated on in the due course of the corporation's business by any two of the following:
  - (a) The President;

- (b) The officer for the time being lawfully acting as Chief Clerk of the Secretariat;
- (c) The officer for the time being lawfully acting as Chief Clerk of the Audit Office;
- (d) The officer for the time being acting as Joint Secretary and Treasurer of the corporation.

The seal of the corporation shall not be affixed to any instrument whatsoever, except in the presence of any two of the four officers mentioned in section 20 A, who shall sign their names to the instrument in token of their presence, and such signing shall be independent of the signing of any person as a witness.

#### No. 6 of 1926.

An Ordinance to empower the Governor to grant Licences for the removal of Heavy Mineral Sand from the Foreshore.

HUGH CLIFFORD.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is expedient to empower the Governor to grant licences for the removal of heavy mineral sand from the foreshore: Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Heavy Mineral Sand Ordinance, No. 6 of 1926.

Interpretation.

- 2 In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires-
- "Foreshore" means the shore and bed of the sea extending seawards from high water mark at ordinary spring tides to a distance of one mile from low water mark at ordinary spring tides.

  "Heavy mineral sand" means sand consisting to the

"Heavy mineral sand" means sand consisting to the extent of at least 75 per cent. of mineral grains possessing a specific gravity of not less than 3.5.

Application of Ordinance.

- **3** (1) This Ordinance applies only to that part of the foreshore to which this Ordinance is by Proclamation published in the *Gazette* declared to be applicable.
- (2) Every such Proclamation shall specify and define as far as practicable the exact limits of the foreshore to which this Ordinance is to apply, and shall as soon as conveniently may be, be laid on the table of the Legislative Council, and may at any of the next three meetings of the Council be disallowed by resolution of the Council, and if so disallowed shall be annulled.

Heavy mineral sand to be Crown property.

Licences for removal of heavy mineral sand.

- 4 All heavy mineral sand on or under any part of the foreshore of the Island of Ceylon to which this Ordinance applies is hereby declared to be vested in the Crown.
- 5 (1) The Governor may, if he thinks fit, from time to time grant a licence to any person to remove heavy mineral sand from any part of the foreshore to which this Ordinance applies on such terms and conditions, including the payment of money, as the Governor shall think fit.
- (2) If any person shall remove any heavy mineral sand from any part of the foreshore to which this Ordinance applies without such a licence as aforesaid or otherwise than in accordance with the terms and conditions of the licence, he shall be guilty of an offence, and on conviction by a Police Magistrate shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one thousand rupees.

6 (1) A copy of every licence propes of the begranted under this Ordinance shall be laid on the table of the Legislative Council and published in at least one newspaper circulating in Ceylon, together with a report onProcedure to be observed before grant of licence.

- (a) Any erosion to the seacoast likely to be caused by the removal of sand under the licence and the precautions proposed to prevent such erosion;
- (b) Whether any railway or public highway or canal is likely to be injuriously affected by operations under the licence, and, if so, the precautions proposed to protect the same;
- (c) Whether any fishing grounds or landing places for boats are likely to be affected by the operations under the licence:
- (d) Whether any private property is likely to be injuriously affected by operations under the licence, and, if so, whether the owners thereof do or do not consent to the grant of the licence, and, if they do not consent, what arrangements will be made for the protection of their property and for securing the payment to them of compensation in the event of any damage being caused to such property by operations under the licence, whether during or after the expiration of the licence.
- (2) A licence under this Ordinance shall not be granted until it has been approved by a resolution of the Legislative Council, which shall not be moved until the copy of the proposed licence and of the report thereon has lain on the table for at least fourteen days.
- 7 Nothing in this Ordinance or in any licence granted thereunder shall exonerate a person operating under a licence from liability for any damage caused by his operations to any other person or to any land or buildings, or impose on the Governor or the Crown liability for any such damage.
