MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend the Estate Duty Ordinance,
No. 8 of 1919, as respects the Rates of Duty
payable on Estates not exceeding
Rs. 75,000 in Value.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Estate Duty Ordinance, No. of 1926. Short title.

2 The following shall be added at the end of the schedule to the principal Ordinance, viz. : Amended rates of estate duty.

Provided that in the case of persons dying on or after July 22, 1926, where the value of the estate does not exceed seventy-five thousand rupees, the rates of estate duty shall be as follows :

Where the Value of the Estate—	Estate duty shall be payable at the rate per cent. of Rs.
Exceeds Rs. 5,000 and does not exceed Rs. 25,000..	1
Do. Rs. 25,000 do.	Rs. 50,000.. 2
Do. Rs. 50,000 do.	Rs. 75,000.. 3

The rate of the settlement estate duty where the property is settled shall be one per cent.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THIS Ordinance gives effect to the recommendation in paragraph 24 of the interim report of the Taxation Commission that the limit of exemption be raised from Rs. 1,500 to Rs. 5,000 and that the gradations should be altered as indicated below :—
