**MINUTE.**

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

**An Ordinance to amend the Estate Duty Ordinance,  
No. 8 of 1919, as respects the Rates of Duty  
payable on Estates not exceeding  
Rs. 75,000 in Value.**

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.           1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Estate Duty Ordinance, No.    of 1926.

Amended rates of estate duty.   2 The following shall be added at the end of the schedule to the principal Ordinance, viz. :

Provided that in the case of persons dying on or after July 22, 1926, where the value of the estate does not exceed seventy-five thousand rupees, the rates of estate duty shall be as follows :

The rate of the settlement estate duty where the property is settled shall be one per cent.

*Statement of Objects and Reasons.*

THIS Ordinance gives effect to the recommendation in paragraph 24 of the interim report of the Taxation Commission that the limit of exemption be raised from Rs. 1,500 to Rs. 5,000 and that the gradations should be altered as indicated below :—

## MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

**An Ordinance to amend the Supreme Court  
(Vacation) Ordinance, 1905.**

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Supreme Court (Vacation) Ordinance, No. of 1926.

Short title.

2 Sub-section (1) of section 4 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended so as to read as follows, viz. :

Amendment of section 4 of the principal Ordinance.

4 (1) The Christmas vacation shall commence on the twenty-second day of December and terminate on the twelfth day of the next following January. The Easter vacation shall commence on Good Friday and shall continue for twenty-two days. The August vacation shall commence on such day in August as the Chief Justice shall appoint in each year for the purpose and shall continue for twelve days.

*Statement of Objects and Reasons.*

ASH Wednesday, Ascension Day, the Accession Day of His Majesty the King, and the Prince of Wales' Birthday were till 1917 public holidays by virtue of Schedule A to the Holidays Ordinance, 1886, and as such they were holidays for the Supreme Court. The 28th, 29th, 30th, and 31st of December were also holidays for the Supreme Court, being part of its Christmas vacation under section 4 (1) of the Supreme Court (Vacation) Ordinance, 1905.

2. A notification of December 31, 1917, under section 9 of the Holidays Ordinance, 1886, amended Schedule A by substituting December 28, 29, 30, and 31 as public holidays in place of Ash Wednesday, Ascension Day, the Accession Day of His Majesty the King, and the Prince of Wales' Birthday, which were henceforth to be working days.

3. This alteration deprived the Supreme Court of Ash Wednesday, Ascension Day, the Accession Day of His Majesty the King, and the Prince of Wales' Birthday as holidays, but did not give it any further holidays in their place, as the 28th, 29th, 30th, and 31st of December were already part of its vacation.

4. This Ordinance seeks to restore to the Supreme Court its four lost holidays.
