## VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON IN THE MONTH OF AUGUST, 1925.

### REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.

THIS report deals with the Vital Statistics of the 33 principal towns in the Island proclaimed under sections 31-36 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

#### Marriages.

2. The marriages of residents in proclaimed towns numbered 355 (310 General, 6 Kandyan, and 39 Muslim), the number in the preceding month was also 355, against 295 in the corresponding month of last year. In Colombo the number of marriages was 114 (92 General and 22 Muslim), as against 132 in the preceding month and 120 in the corresponding month of last year.

#### Births.

3. The births registered numbered 1,558 (800 males and 758 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 29·45 per 1,000 of the population, as against 31·68 in the previous month, 28·40 in the corresponding month of last year, and 26·77 the average for the corresponding months since 1915. The rate ranged from 11·81 in Vavuniya to 56·73 in Mannar. There were 1,453 births of children whose mothers were residents of the towns, equivalent to an annual rate of 27·47, as against 29·43 in the preceding month.

4. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 545 (286 males and 259 females), and were equal to an annual rate of 25·06, as against 25·38 in the preceding month, 24·29 in the corresponding month of last year, and 22·25 the average for the corresponding months since 1915. The rate, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 8·98 in Kollupitiya to 26·55 in Slave Island. There were 480 births of children whose mothers were residents of the city, equivalent to an annual rate of 22·07, as against 23·08 in the preceding month.

#### Deaths.

5. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 1,641 (864 males and 777 females), and were equal to an annual rate of 31·02, as against 35·07 in the preceding month. There were 1,268 deaths of residents in the towns, equivalent to an annual standardized rate of 25·92, as against 29·34 in the preceding month, 28·19 in the corresponding month of last year, and 27·77 the average for the corresponding months since 1915. The standardized rate ranged from 69·80 in Hatton-Dikoya to 12·57 in Panadure.

6. In the city of Colombo the deaths registered numbered 650 (354 males and 296 females), and were equal to an annual rate of 29·89, as against 33·38 in the preceding month. There were 533 deaths of residents of the city, which corresponded to an annual standardized rate of 28·22, as against 31·29 in the preceding month, 28·99 in the corresponding month of last year, and 27·72 the average for the corresponding months since 1915. The death-rate of residents, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 28·38 in New Bazaar to 13·33 in Maradana South.

7. The stillbirths registered during the month numbered 69 (30 males and 39 females), as against 109 in the preceding month.

#### Infant Mortality.

8. The deaths of children under one year amounted to 322, and corresponded to a rate of 190 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended August, 1925. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 207, as against 227 in the preceding month, 247 in the corresponding month of last year, and 243 the average for the corresponding months since 1915. There were 296 deaths of children under one year whose mothers were residents of the towns, which corresponded to a rate of 204, as against 225 in the preceding month.

9. In the city of Colombo the deaths of children under one year numbered 121 and corresponded to a rate of 189 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended August, 1925. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 222, as against 303 in the preceding month, 267 in the corresponding month of last year, and 264 the average for the corresponding months since 1915. There were 110 deaths of children under one year whose mothers were residents of the city, which corresponded to a rate of 229, as against 313 in the preceding month.

#### Causes of Death.

10. The highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, to which 15 per cent. of the total deaths were due. *Convulsions* caused 7 per cent.; *Phthisis* and *Debility* (of children under one year), each 6 per cent.; *Diarrhoea*, *Dysentery*, *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, and *Anchylostomiasis*, each 4 per cent.; *Enteritis* and *Influenza*, each 3 per cent.; *Prematurity*, *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, and *Enteric Fever*, each 2 per cent.; *Bronchitis* and *Puerperal Septicæmia*, each 1 per cent.

11. In Colombo, too, the highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, which caused 12 per cent. of the total deaths; *Phthisis*, caused 9 per cent.; *Convulsions*, 8 per cent.; *Influenza*, 5 per cent.; *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, *Debility* (of children under one year), and *Dysentery*, each 4 per cent.; *Diarrhoea*, *Enteric Fever*, and *Enteritis*, each 3 per cent.; *Prematurity*, *Anchylostomiasis*, *Bronchitis*, and *Cancer*, each 2 per cent.

12. Six deaths from *Plague* (all males) were registered in Colombo, as against 8 in the preceding month and 7 in the corresponding month of last year.

13. *Infectious Diseases reported*.—The infectious disease most prevalent during the month was *Phthisis*, of which 105 cases were reported (89 in Colombo, 8 in Galle); *Chickenpox* followed with 72 cases (50 in Colombo, 5 in Kalutara); *Measles* 53 (34 in Colombo, 12 in Moratuwa); *Enteric Fever* 52 (2 in Colombo, 8 in Moratuwa); *Continued Fever* 25 (21 in Colombo); *Plague* 10 (in Colombo); *Mumps* 6 (3 in Kandy); *Dysentery* 5 (3 in Panadure); and *Diarrhoea* 2 (in Batticaloa).

#### Meteorology.

14. *Rainfall*.—Nawalapitiya recorded the highest rainfall (31·38 in.). In the other towns the rainfall ranged from 27·06 in. in Hatton-Dikoya to 0·02 in. in Kalpitiya. Colombo recorded 4·80 in.

15. *Mean Temperature*.—The mean temperature varied from 85·5° in Trincomalee to 60·3° in Nuwara Eliya, and was 81·0° in Colombo.
