WHEREAS His Excellency Cecil Clement, Esquire, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Officer Administering the Government of Ceylon, with the Dependencies thereof, has quitted this Colony. It is hereby proclaimed that, by virtue of the Letters Patent passed under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom, constituting the Office of Commander-in-Chief of the Island of Ceylon and its Dependencies, dated the Eleventh day of September, One thousand Nine hundred and Twenty, the Honourable Mr. Edward Bruce Alexander, Companion of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, has this day assumed the Administration of the Government of the Island, of which all persons concerned are required to take due notice.
