**An Ordinance to amend the Victoria Home for Incurables
Incorporation Ordinance, 1903.**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Victoria Home Amendment Ordinance, 1928.

Provided that, from the _____ day of _____, 1928, the Government Agent, Western Province, shall be a member of the said Committee for all purposes whatsoever in place of the Colonial Secretary, and the said Committee shall, from the said date, be deemed to be incorporated as hereinbefore provided with the Government Agent, Western Province, as a member thereof in place of the Colonial Secretary.
