An Ordinance to Amend the Public Officers' Security Ordinance, 1890.

No. 14 of 1890,
II., 62.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Officers' Security Amendment Ordinance, 1928.

Short title.

2 The following section shall be inserted immediately after section 1 of the principal Ordinance :

Insertion of new section 1 A in the principal Ordinance.

1A In this Ordinance "Colonial Secretary" shall include an Assistant Colonial Secretary.

Interpretation.
