The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to make Supplementary Provision for the Public Services for the Financial Year 1926-27.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

- Short title. 1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1926-27) Ordinance, No. of 1928.
- Appropriation. 2 The several sums of money appearing in the schedule hereto amounting in all to the sum of Rupees Three million Five hundred and Nineteen thousand Eight hundred and Sixty-six and Cents Eighteen are hereby declared to be payable for the service of the Financial Year beginning on October 1, 1926, and ending on September 30, 1927, out of the revenue of the Colony for and in respect of the several services in the said schedule mentioned in addition to the sums appropriated by Ordinance No. 7 of 1926.

An Ordinance to amend the Road Ordinance, 1861.No. 10 of 1861,
I. 378.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Road Amendment Ordinance, 1928.

Short title.

2 Section 25 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following section is substituted therefor :—

Amendment of
section 25 of
the principal
Ordinance.

25 A person shall be disqualified to be elected or to be a member of a District Committee—

- (1) who is under the age of twenty-one years ;
- (2) who has not been resident in the district for a period of six months immediately prior to the date of the election ;
- (3) who has been convicted of theft, fraud, forgery, or any other infamous crime :

Provided that the Governor may, by Proclamation to be published in the *Government Gazette*, require that the members of the District Committee to be thereafter elected for any district named in such Proclamation shall be able to read and write the English language.

3 Section 35 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the word "disqualification" immediately after the word "resignation" in the first line thereof.

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THIS Bill amends section 25 of the Road Ordinance, 1861, so as (1) to disqualify as members of a District Road Committee persons who have been convicted of certain offences, and (2) to make the residential qualification of a candidate a period of six months only instead of an indefinite period as at present. It has also been provided in addition, by the use of the words "shall be disqualified to be elected or to be", that the specified disqualifications apply before and after election.

2. The form of the section has been altered, but otherwise the meaning is the same. The amendment is based partly on the provisions of section 18 of the Village Communities Ordinance, No. 9 of 1924.

3. A consequential amendment of section 35 of the principal Ordinance is effected by clause 3.

An Ordinance to amend the Naturalization Ordinance, 1890.No. 21 of 1890,
II. 73.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Naturalization Amendment Ordinance, 1928.

Short title.

Insertion of new section in the principal Ordinance.

Loss of British nationality by foreign naturalization.

2 The following section shall be inserted in the principal Ordinance immediately after section 5 :—

5A When Letters Patent are issued to any person under this Ordinance, and such person, being in a foreign state and not under disability, becomes naturalized therein by obtaining a certificate of naturalization or by any other voluntary and formal act, such person shall thenceforth be deemed to have ceased to be a British subject and no longer to be entitled to the rights, powers, and privileges or subject to the obligations referred to in section 5 (1).

Statement of Objects and Reasons.

THIS Bill is directed towards ensuring that persons who have already been granted certificates of local naturalization in Ceylon shall be liable to lose their local status as British subjects in the event of their obtaining naturalization in a foreign state, it being manifestly undesirable that such persons should be able to claim that local status whether they return to Ceylon or not. The Bill is introduced on the suggestion of the Secretary of State and is based on section 13 of the British Nationality and Status of Aliens Act, 1914 (4 and 5 Geo. 5, c. 17).
