Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 9 of 1928.

No. 18 of 1890, An Ordinance to amend the Chanks Ordinance, 1890, and to amend further the Customs Ordinance, No. 17 of 1869.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Chanks Ordinance, No. 9 of 1928.

Amendment of section 4 of the Chanks Ordinance, 1890.

2 In sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Chanks Ordinance, 1890, the words "not exceeding one cent on each chank" are hereby repealed, and the following shall be added at the end of that sub-section, viz. :—

"Every notification under this section shall, as soon as conveniently may be, be laid before the Legislative Council, and may at any of the next following three meetings be rescinded by resolution of the Legislative Council, but without prejudice to anything already done thereunder, and if not so rescinded shall be deemed to be valid."

Repeal of section 5 of the Chanks Ordinance, 1890, and substitution of new section.

3 Section 5 of the Chanks Ordinance, 1890, is hereby repealed and the following section is substituted therefor :—

5 The royalty imposed by this Ordinance shall be deemed to be an export duty and shall be collected in accordance with the provisions of the Customs Ordinance, No. 17 of 1869, as amended by any subsequent enactment, and that Ordinance amended as aforesaid shall apply accordingly.

Amendment of section 6 of the Chanks Ordinance, 1890.

4 Section 6 of the Chanks Ordinance, 1890, is hereby amended by the repeal of the words "or contrary to the requirements of section 5,".

Repeal of section 7 of the Chanks Ordinance, 1890.

5 Section 7 of the Chanks Ordinance, 1890, is hereby repealed.

Amendment of Schedule B of the Customs Ordinance, 1869.

6 Schedule B of the Customs Ordinance, No. 17 of 1869, is hereby amended by the repeal of the Export Duties relating to "Chanks (live)," "Chanks (dead)," and "Chanks (inferior)."

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend the Naval and Military Goods (Exemption from Customs Duties) Ordinance, No. 3 of 1927. V. 875.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Naval and Military Goods (Exemption from Customs Duties) Amendment Ordinance, 1928.

Short title.

2 Paragraphs (c) and (d) of section 2 (1) of the principal Ordinance are hereby amended by the substitution of the words "Naval and Military" for the word "Naval" in the third line of each of the said paragraphs.

Amendment of section 2 (1) of the principal Ordinance.

3 Sections 4 and 5 of the principal Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Repeal of sections 4 and 5 of the principal Ordinance.

4 The amendments and the repeals effected by sections 2 and 3 of this Ordinance shall operate retrospectively from and including the 1st day of April, 1928, and paragraphs (c) and (d) of section 2 (1) and sections 4 and 5 of the principal Ordinance shall be deemed to have been respectively amended and repealed with effect from the said 1st day of April.

Objects and Reasons.

THE object of this Bill is to amend the Naval and Military Goods (Exemption from Customs Duties) Ordinance, No. 3 of 1927, so as to give to His Majesty's Regular Military Forces in Ceylon the same benefits as the Naval Forces receive under section 2 (1) (c) and (d) of that Ordinance, namely, the exemption from Customs duty of all articles imported for use in their athletic sports, and imported, purchased, or procured or exported for the use of their messes and canteens in the Colony.

2. The procedure now in force is that goods for Naval messes and canteens are exempted from duty, but the Government makes an annual grant to the Military Authorities in lieu of exemption. It is now proposed that this grant should be discontinued and that the Naval and Military Forces should be placed on the same footing as regards exemption.

3. The Naval, Army, and Air Force Institutes opened a canteen in Ceylon on April 1, 1928, for the supply of local Naval and Military messes and canteens, and it is, therefore, provided in clause 4 of the Bill that the new procedure shall operate retrospectively from and including April 1, 1928. A temporary arrangement has been sanctioned by the Finance Committee pending the passing of this legislation.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Councils Amendment Ordinance, 192 .

Amendment of section 45 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 45 (1) of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the following paragraph immediately after paragraph (j) thereof :—

(j) Payment of salary not exceeding three hundred rupees a month to a Charity Commissioner appointed under section 58A.

Addition of new section 58A to the principal Ordinance

3 The following section is inserted in the principal Ordinance immediately after section 58 thereof :—

Charity
Commis-
sioner.

58A (1) The Council may at any time by resolution appoint any person to be Charity Commissioner of the Municipality, who shall be under the direct supervision of the Chairman.

(2) The duties of the Charity Commissioner may be defined by the Council and may include, *inter alia*—

(a) the giving of assistance and advice to existing charitable societies or institutions for the purpose of preventing waste of effort and extending the activities of such societies or institutions, and generally for such other purposes as may be necessary ;

(b) the making of reports to the Council as to the expenditure of contributions made by the Council to any such societies or institutions ;

(c) the systematic study of poverty, distress, and unemployment and the making of proposals for the prevention thereof ;

(d) the consideration of applications for relief and the direction of applicants to the most appropriate society of institution ; and

(e) the keeping of records or registers of applicants for relief or persons in search of employment.

THE object of the Bill is to enable Municipal Councils to appoint a Charity Commissioner and pay the salary of such an officer from Municipal funds.
