### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

No. 18 of 1907, III. 132. An Ordinance to amend the Colombo Municipal Waterworks Ordinance, 1907.

DE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Colombo Municipal Waterworks Amendment Ordinance, 1928.

Amendment of section 43 of the principal Ordinance.

- 2 Section 43 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:—.
  - (1) by the insertion of the words "the Municipal Magistrate or "immediately before the words" the Police Magistrate" in the second line thereof; and
  - (2) by the substitution of the words "either of such Magistrates" for the words "such Magistrate", where the latter words twice occur in the said section.

### Objects and Reasons.

THE object of this Bill is to extend the jurisdiction of the Municipal Magistrate of Colombo to enable him to try offences under the Colombo Municipal Waterworks Ordinance, 1907.

2. The Municipal Magistrate, Colombo, deals at present with all other Municipal cases, and it appears desirable that he should deal with these offences also.

### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

III. 255.

An Ordinance to amend the Informers Reward Ordinance, No. 1 of 1914.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Informers Reward Amendment Ordinance, 1928.

Amendment of section 2 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 2 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following proviso at the end thereof:—

Provided further that the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council may, by Proclamation for that purpose published in the Government Gazette, direct that the provisions of this section shall, for a period to be specified in such Proclamation, cease to be operative within the jurisdiction of any particular court in respect of all or any of the offences under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Ordinance, 1907.

### Objects and Reasons.

The Municipal Council of Colombo has agreed to contribute a lump sum towards the expenses of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals in consideration of the cancellation of the proclamation of January 28, 1913 (made under section 10 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Ordinance, 1907), by which fines recovered within the Municipal limits of Colombo in respect of offences under that Ordinance were appropriated to the funds of the Society.

- 2. Under section 2 of the Informers Reward Ordinance, No. 1 of 1914, officers of the Society in their capacity as informers may however still be awarded a moiety of the fines recovered, and the object of this Bill is, therefore, to amend the Informers Reward Ordinance, No. 1 of 1914, so as to give power to the Governor in Executive Council to direct that the provisions of section 2 of that Ordinance shall cease to be operative for any definite period within the jurisdiction of any particular court in respect of offences under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Ordinance, 1907.
- 3. It is intended to use this power in the present case and in any similar case that may arise.
