The Municipal Council of Colombo has agreed to contribute a lump sum towards the expenses of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals in consideration of the cancellation of the proclamation of January 28, 1913 (made under section 10 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Ordinance, 1907), by which fines recovered within the Municipal limits of Colombo in respect of offences under that Ordinance were appropriated to the funds of the Society.

2. Under section 2 of the Informers Reward Ordinance, No. 1 of 1914, officers of the Society in their capacity as informers may however still be awarded a moiety of the fines recovered, and the object of this Bill is, therefore, to amend the Informers Reward Ordinance, No. 1 of 1914, so as to give power to the Governor in Executive Council to direct that the provisions of section 2 of that Ordinance shall cease to be operative for any definite period within the jurisdiction of any particular court in respect of offences under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Ordinance, 1907.

An Ordinance to dispense with the necessity for publication of certain matters in the Government Gazette.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Government Gazette (Publication) Ordinance, 1928.

Amendment of certain enactments. Schedule.

2 The enactments specified in the first and second columns of the Schedule are hereby amended to the extent indicated in the third column thereof.

Power of Governor in Council to annul provisions of written law requiring publication or proclamation in the Gazette.

3 (1) It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, by order published in the Government Gazette, to declare that any provision of written law which requires that any matter or thing, or any order, notification, list, statement, abstract, notice, or other document, shall be published or proclaimed, or published by proclamation, in the Government Gazette, shall cease to be in force as from a date to be specified in such order.

(2) Any such order shall be laid, as soon as conveniently may be, on the table of the Legislative Council at two successive meetings of the Council, and shall be brought before the Council at the next subsequent meeting held thereafter by a motion that the said order shall not be disapproved, and if upon the introduction of any such motion, or upon any adjournment thereof, the said order or any part thereof is disapproved by the Council, such order, or such part thereof as is so disapproved, shall be deemed to be rescinded as from the date of such disapproval, but without prejudice to anything already done thereunder; and any such order, or any part thereof, which is not so disapproved, shall be deemed to be valid. Every such disapproval shall be published in the Gazette.

Objects and Reasons.

The object of this Bill is to dispense with the necessity for the publication in the Gazette of certain lists, orders, notifications, and other documents, matters and things which are now required by law to be so published, and thereby to effect a reduction in the size and cost of the Gazette. The idea originated from a recommendation put forward in paragraph 51 of the Report of the Retrenchment Commission (Sessional Paper III. of 1923).

2. Clause 2 and the Schedule authorize a number of minor amendments in various Ordinances with the intention of carrying out the object of the Bill. The Schedule is confined to cases where that object can be attained by a simple deletion or repeal. Cases in which actual amendments are necessary, either by way of recasting the section concerned or by the substitution of other provisions for Gazette publication, will be dealt with in separate Bills to be introduced later.

3. Clause 3 contains a general power for the Governor in Council to deal with future cases in which publication may be considered unnecessary. This power will be exercised by an order, published in the Gazette and brought before the Legislative Council.
