MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend the Small Towns Sanitary Ordinance, 1892.

No. 18 of 1892,
II. 207.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Small Towns Sanitary Amendment Ordinance, 1928.

Short title.

2 Section 5 (1) of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

Amendment of section 5 (1) of the principal Ordinance.

(1) by the addition of the following words at the end of paragraph (f) thereof :—

“ and to the payment of the salaries and wages of, and retiring pensions and gratuities to, the officers and servants employed by such Boards, and gratuities to the widows and children of such officers and servants ” ; and

(2) by the addition of the following paragraph at the end thereof :—

“ (g) The payment of any such pensions or gratuities as are mentioned in paragraph (f) of this sub-section shall be subject to rules made by the Governor in Executive Council for that purpose, and any such rule shall be laid, as soon as conveniently may be, on the table of the Legislative Council at two successive meetings of the Council, and shall be brought before the Council at the next subsequent meeting held thereafter by a motion that the said rule shall not be disapproved, and if upon the introduction of any such motion, or upon any adjournment thereof, the said rule or any part thereof is disapproved by the Council, such rule, or such part thereof as is so disapproved, shall be deemed to be rescinded as from the date of such disapproval, but without prejudice to anything already done thereunder ; and any such rule, or any part thereof, which is not so disapproved, shall be deemed to be valid. Every such disapproval shall be published in the Gazette.

3 Section 2 (1) of this Ordinance shall operate retrospectively so as to validate all payments of salaries, wages, pensions, or gratuities made by any Sanitary Board before the commencement of this Ordinance to its officers or servants or to their widows or children, and to enable any such pensions or gratuities to be paid after the commencement of this Ordinance in cases where officers or servants have retired before the commencement of this Ordinance, provided that any such payments of pensions or gratuities made after the commencement of this Ordinance shall be subject to the rules made under section 5 (1) (g) of the principal Ordinance, as enacted by this Ordinance.

Retrospective effect of section 2 (1).

4 Section 9E (1) of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following proviso at the end thereof :—

Amendment of section 9E of the principal Ordinance.

“ Provided that it shall be lawful for the Governor acting with the advice of the Executive Council to approve and ratify any expenditure which may be or may have been in good faith incurred by any Sanitary Board in supposed pursuance of the powers granted by this sub-section, but which has nevertheless been incurred contrary to the provisions thereof.”

Objects and Reasons.

THE amendment effected by clause 2 (1) of this Bill is made with the object of enabling Sanitary Boards to pay salaries, wages, pensions, and gratuities to their officers and servants, and to the widows and children of such officers and servants, out of the funds vested in those Boards. A doubt exists as to whether such payments, or some of them, are at present legal. The payment of pensions and gratuities is (by clause 2 (2) of the Bill) subject to rules made by the Governor in Executive Council, and it is also provided that clause 2 (1) of the Bill will operate retrospectively so as (1) to validate all salaries, wages, pensions, and gratuities already paid, and (2) to enable pensions and gratuities to be paid, subject to the rules, after the passing of the Bill in cases where officers have retired before the passing of the Bill.

2. The particular object contemplated by clause 4 of the Bill is to enable the Governor in Executive Council to validate certain expenditure which was incurred by the Sanitary Board of Nuwara Eliya District on the construction, equipment, and extension of a school at Talawakele in the mistaken belief that such expenditure was warranted under the powers conferred by section 9E (1) of the principal Ordinance. The clause has been drafted in general terms, so as to extend to any such similar payments which have been *bona fide* made in supposed pursuance of the powers conferred by that Ordinance.
