MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

II. 895.

An Ordinance further to amend the Stamp Ordinance, 1909.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Stamp Second Amendment Ordinance, 1928.

Amendment of item 22 of Part I. of Schedule B of the principal Ordinance.

2 Item 22 of Part I of Schedule B of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the following paragraph immediately after paragraph (d1) thereof :—

(d2) Conveyance or transfer of shares executed by a trustee in favour of the person beneficially entitled or of another trustee; and bearing an endorsement signed by the transferor and the transferee to the effect that the transferor is a trustee and is conveying or transferring the shares without consideration or for a nominal consideration to the person beneficially entitled thereto or to another trustee, as the case may be .. 10 0

Objects and Reasons.

SECTION 22 of the Joint Stock Companies Ordinance, 1861, provides *inter alia* that no notice of any trust, express, implied or constructive, shall be entered on the register of a company.

2. It not infrequently happens in practice that a person receives by way of conveyance or transfer shares which he holds in trust for another, although the beneficiary's name or interest cannot be entered on the company's register.

3. The object of this amendment is to enable such a trustee to convey or transfer the shares to the beneficiary or to another trustee on payment of a stamp duty of Rs. 10, provided that the document of conveyance or transfer bears the requisite endorsement. As such conveyances or transfers by a trustee are executed either without consideration or for a purely nominal consideration, it is felt that it will be inequitable to insist on the payment of stamp duty assessed on an *ad valorem* basis.

4. Similar transfers executed in England are subject to a nominal stamp duty of ten shillings, and in future the local practice will be uniform with that obtaining in England in similar matters.
