An Ordinance to amend the Rabies Ordinance, 1893.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Rabies Amendment Ordinance, 1928.

Amendment of section 3 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 3 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following words at the end of the definition of "stray dog" contained therein :—

"and not wearing a collar of a pattern to be prescribed by regulations made under this Ordinance or a collar bearing a badge to be similarly prescribed."

Objects and Reasons.

THE amendment contained in this Bill will enable the owner of a dog to prevent it from being seized under section 4 of the Ordinance as a stray dog, if he takes the precaution of fitting the dog with a collar or badge of a prescribed pattern.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Powers of the Legislative Council Ordinance, No. of 1928.

2 The Legislative Council of Ceylon and the Committees and members thereof respectively shall hold, enjoy, and exercise, and shall be deemed at all times to have held, enjoyed, and described such and the like privileges, immunities, and powers as and the privileges, immunities, and powers of the said Council and of the Committees and members thereof respectively are hereby defined to be the same as were or are held, enjoyed, and exercised by the Commons House of Parliament of Great Britain and Ireland and by the Committees and members thereof, whether such privileges, immunities, or powers were or are so held, possessed, or enjoyed by custom, State, or otherwise.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Boards Amendment Ordinance, 1928.

Short title.

2 The following proviso shall be inserted at the end of section 12 of the principal Ordinance :—

Amendment of section 12 of the principal Ordinance.

Provided that if at any time before the holding of any such meeting, the Governor in Executive Council is satisfied that it is impracticable for an election to be duly held on any date in the said month of December, by reason of any failure or neglect to comply with any or all of the provisions of sections 8, 9, and 10, the Governor in Executive Council may, by order to be published in the Government Gazette,—

- (a) prescribe a date, subsequent to the said month of December, for the holding of such election, and the date on which any members elected thereat shall go out of office ; and
- (b) declare that the elected members who would otherwise go out of office as provided by section 11, shall continue in office until such election, with the like powers, duties, rights, privileges, obligations, and immunities as theretofore.

A CASE has arisen in which it is impracticable to hold the Local Board election at Minuwangoda within the time prescribed by section 12 of the Local Boards Ordinance, 1898. The necessary preliminaries by way of preparation of lists of electors and persons qualified to be elected, notices, &c., have by an oversight not been complied with. The existing Local Board will go out of office under the Ordinance on December 31, 1928, and a new Board cannot be elected.

2. The object of this Bill is to provide a means whereby an emergency of this nature can be met, and it is essential that steps should be taken to deal with the difficulty in this case before the end of the year.

3. It is proposed that in such circumstances, the Governor in Council may be given power to prescribe a date for the election, and to extend the life of the existing Board until the new election.
