#### Kurunegala S. O. No. 4,041.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Kardabodahenyaya, Kandabodapaluwatteyaya, &c., situate in the village of Nelliya, in the Ihala Otota korale of the Hiriyala hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."
