A PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS by Chapter II., section 5, and sub-section (b), of the Forest Ordinance, No. 16 of 1907, it is enacted that whenever the following event has occurred, viz., when lands have been declared the property of the Crown by an order passed under the Waste Lands Ordinances, 1897 to 1903, the Governor may, by Proclamation to be published in the *Government Gazette*, declare all or any of such lands or any part or parts thereof to be a reserved forest, and such Proclamation shall specify the limits of the forest which it is intended to reserve, and declare the same to be reserved from a date fixed by such Proclamation :

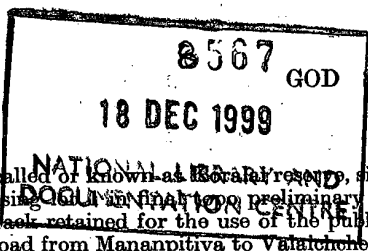
And whereas the lands hereinafter mentioned have been declared the property of the Crown by an order passed under "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903," on May 27, 1927, and appearing in the *Government Gazette* No. 7,597 of August 5, 1927; and it is expedient to specify the limits of such forest :

Now know all men that We, the Governor, do by this Our Proclamation proclaim the forest, the limits of which are set forth in the schedule hereto subjoined, to be a reserved forest from and after March 4, 1929, and We do hereby further specify the limits of the said reserved forest to be those set forth in the said schedule.

SCHEDULE.

**R**EGULATIONS under sections 53 and 58 of the Motor Car Ordinance, 1927, made by the Governor in Executive Council for the Urban area comprised within the administrative limits of the Local Board of Badulla.

### REGULATIONS.

#### Under Section 53.

1. A public stand for the purpose of these regulations shall mean a defined space with a constructed floor prepared for the accommodation of hiring cars and indicated as such by a notice exhibited by the Local Board.
2. No omnibuses shall be parked within the limits of the Local Board of Badulla except in the following public stands, viz. :—
  - Stand at the public market for 10 omnibuses.
  - Stand at Viharagoda junction for 10 omnibuses.
  - Stand at the Railway Station for 20 omnibuses.
3. When any portion of a public stand has been set apart for omnibuses plying upon any particular route, all omnibuses plying upon that route shall be parked in the portion of the stand so set apart. All omnibuses parked on a public stand must if required by a Police Officer or duly authorized officer of the Local Board be moved up as vacancies occur in front of them. The driver of any omnibus who fails to park his omnibus as prescribed by these regulations or to move his omnibus when required to do so by any Police Officer or duly authorized officer of the Local Board shall be guilty of an offence.
4. Any omnibus brought into a public stand shall be parked in such a manner as to cause no obstruction to other omnibuses standing in or entering or leaving the said stand. The driver of every such omnibus shall always be in attendance on his omnibus and shall move his omnibus to permit the ingress or egress of other omnibuses when required to do so by any Police Officer or duly authorized officer of the Local Board or when reasonably called upon to do so by the drivers of such other omnibuses.
5. The parking of motor cars is prohibited on the Bandarawela-Badulla road between the Circular road junction and the Taldena road junction.

#### Under Section 58.

6. The driver of a lorry shall not allow it to stand on any highway declared by regulation to be suitable for such traffic except—
  - (a) In the event of a breakdown and then only so long as may be necessary to enable essential repairs to be effected.
  - (b) For the purpose of loading or unloading goods and then only so long as may be reasonably necessary for the purpose.

10. The successful tenderer will be required to execute a purchase agreement, and all tenderers should read and initial a copy of this agreement at the Office of the Divisional Forest Officer, at the time of obtaining tender forms.

11. Before execution of the agreement the purchaser will be required (a) to pay either the full purchase amount or, if paying by instalments, 40 per cent. thereof; (b) to deposit as security for efficient and punctual fulfilment of the agreement 10 per cent. of the full purchase amount tendered by him. If paying by instalments the balance 60 per cent. of the full purchase price shall be paid by the purchaser in two equal instalments in accordance with clauses 2 and 4 of the special conditions set out below in this notice.

12. After payment of the first instalment of the purchase price, deposit of the security, and execution of the agreement the purchaser will be entitled on application to refund of his tender deposit. Should the successful tenderer fail to carry out the requirements of clauses 11 and 12 of this notice within 14 days of receiving notice in writing from the Divisional Forest Officer, that his tender has been accepted, the Rs. 20 deposited will be forfeited to the Crown. The unsuccessful tenderer will be entitled to a refund of the amount deposited by him on application to the Divisional Forest Officer concerned.

13. The special rules for felling, conversion, and removal which the agreement will require to be observed are specified in the special conditions advertised below. Nothing in these special conditions shall render the purchaser in any way exempt from liability under the Forest Ordinance of 1907, should he be responsible for the commission of a forest offence outside the boundaries of his purchased block.

## SPECIAL CONDITIONS.

(1) On payment of the full purchase amount the purchaser shall be entitled to fell and remove on or before December 31, 1929, in the manner specified below, all the timber contained in the purchased block. Any timber not removed by the expiry date (December 31, 1929) shall *ipso facto* revert to the Crown.

(2) If the purchaser desires to pay by instalments, payment of a first instalment of 40 per cent. of the full purchase price tendered shall entitle him to fell and remove all the trees in not exceeding one-third of the total area of the block. Payment of 70 per cent. of the full purchase price by means of a second instalment of 30 per cent. shall entitle the purchaser to fell and remove all the trees in not exceeding two-thirds of the total area of coupe.

(3) The purchaser shall agree to commence felling along the full length of the northern boundary of the block and to progress this felling line in the direction of the southern boundary, always keeping it parallel to the northern boundary along which felling commences.

(4) The purchaser shall pay for the second instalment or in all 70 per cent. of the full purchase price within five months, and the third and final instalment within nine months of the date of execution of the agreement. Should the purchaser fail to pay the second and final instalment when due, it shall be within the discretion of Divisional Forest Officer to cancel the agreement as from the date of such default. Any unremoved timber will revert to the Crown as from the date of such cancellation and the purchaser will forfeit all claims thereto. On no account shall any postponement of the instalment payment or extension of the felling dates be granted.

(5) Should the purchaser fell or remove timber trees in excess of the quantity specified in special condition 2, nothing in the agreement shall exempt him from being liable for illicit felling and removal under the Forest Ordinance, No. 16 of 1907.

(6) The purchaser shall either exercise such personal supervision as will ensure the conditions of this agreement being efficiently executed or employ an efficient supervisor.

(7) The purchaser or his agent or workmen shall not damage any boundary pillars, block up the boundaries by depositing any brushwood or branches. All lines so blocked must be re-cleared by the purchaser.

(8) A general removal permit will be issued by the Divisional Forest Officer authorizing the purchaser to remove the timber standing in one-third, two-thirds, or of the full block (according to the purchase amount paid, *vide* conditions 2 and 4) in such daily quantities as will be specified in cart notes which must accompany each and every cart in transit. The Forest Ranger or the Forest Overseer or the Forest Guard will measure up the timber which is ready for removal twice daily at 9.30 A.M. and 3.30 P.M., and will issue the necessary cart notes which shall accompany each and every cart in transit.

(9) The purchaser shall agree that for each and every infringement of the above conditions he shall become liable to a fine not exceeding Rs. 100, to be imposed by the Divisional Forest Officer in writing at his discretion and to be recovered from the purchaser's security money.

(10) The purchaser shall agree that, in the event of security money having become exhausted, it shall be within the discretion of the Divisional Forest Officer either (a) to accept a further security deposit amounting to 10 per cent. of the full tendered purchase price, or (b) to cancel the agreement and to refund to the purchaser such balance of the paid up purchase money, if any, as remains after deducting the value of all timber removed by the purchaser on the date of such cancellation. For the purpose of this clause the value of each removed cubic foot of timber shall be reckoned at full royalty rates.

(11) The purchaser shall have the right of appeal to the Conservator of Forests in the event of the enforcement of any of the penalties specified in these conditions, and the purchaser shall agree to accept the Conservator of Forests' decision as final and binding.

(12) The purchaser should make his own arrangements for the transport of timber over private lands.

Abstract.—In paints, cements and the like in which metallic powders, earths and other suitable materials are suspended or dissolved in an alkaline silicate, sodium nitrate is added as a stab liser.

The claims are:—

1. A medium for coating material containing an alkali silicate in combination with sodium nitrate.
2. A medium for metal or other mineral substances employed in paints, cements and the like containing sodium silicate in combination with sodium nitrate.
3. A coating material containing a mineral pigment and a medium containing an alkali silicate mixed with sodium nitrate.

4. A metallic paint comprising a powdered metal mixed in a medium containing sodium silicate mixed with sodium nitrate.
  5. A medium for a mineral pigment and/or filler consisting of a mixture of an aqueous solution of sodium nitrate and an aqueous solution of sodium silicate.
  6. A medium for a mineral pigment and/or filler containing 60 volumes of commercial sodium silicate (140° TW) 35 volumes of water and from 2.5 to 10 volumes of saturated solution of sodium nitrate.
  7. A plastic or a cement-like composition comprising filling material, an alkali silicate and sodium nitrate.
  8. A coating material according to claim 3 in which the mineral pigments are carbonates such as barium carbonate, white lead, calcium carbonate.

Paint or waterproofing material and process of producing the same.

*Abstract.*—Mined asphalt of the Trinidad type is distilled at 400° F for 18 hours. Gilsonite is similarly treated at 600° F, the residues are fused together.

A suitable petroleum distillate is used as solvent and is added to the hot mixture.

A pigment may be added.

The claims are :—

1. A process of making paint or waterproofing material, including the step of heating Trinidad type asphalt to a temperature and for a period of time sufficient to vaporize substantially all light oils from the same and then adding to the hot asphalt residue of petroleum cold distillate so as to immediately cool the asphaltic residue and at the same time dissolve the same in said distillate.
  2. A process of making paint or waterproofing material, as set forth in claim 1, including the step of heating separately gilsonite to a temperature and for a period sufficient to drive out the light oils therefrom, mixing the residual asphaltic materials and adding to the hot mixture the petroleum distillate.
  3. A process of producing a paint or waterproofing material, as set forth in claim 2, in which the temperature maintained for heating the Trinidad type asphalt and the gilsonite are different temperatures to drive out the light oils from both of said materials.
  4. A process of producing a paint or waterproofing material, as set forth in claim 1, in which the addition of the solvent is effected rapidly by immediate application of all of the solvent to be employed to the asphaltic material while the same is still hot to firmly suspend the asphaltic materials in the solution.
  5. A paint or waterproofing material capable of adhering to wet uncured concrete and having as its basic constituent Trinidad type asphalt from which substantially all of its more volatile constituents have been eliminated, said asphalt being permanently suspended in a petroleum distillate.
  6. A paint or waterproofing material, as set forth in claim 5, comprising in addition to the Trinidad type asphalt as a part of the basic constituent gilsonite from which substantially all of the more volatile constituents have been eliminated.
  7. A paint or waterproofing material, as set forth in claims 5 and 6, including in addition to the asphalt or mixture of asphalt and gilsonite a pigment which combines therewith.
  8. A process of producing paint or waterproofing material, substantially as described.
  9. A paint or waterproofing material, substantially as described and produced by the process set forth.

Process for refining petroleum or petroleum products.

*Abstract.*—Basic compounds are separated from petroleum and petroleum products by a preliminary treatment with acid more dilute than that used for ordinary chemical refining.

The claims are :—

1. A process for refining petroleum or petroleum products (including cracked products) as well as the extracts obtained therefrom in known manner with liquid sulphur dioxide by means of acids, wherein the originating materials are in the first stage subjected to treatment with dilute acid of a strength which will not form acid sludge for the purpose of removing the basic substances therefrom and in a second stage with concentrated acid to effect the refining proper.
2. A process as claimed in claim 1 wherein the extracts obtained in the first stage are separated from the oil and utilized as such for the purpose described.
3. A process as claimed in claim 1, where in the basic substances in the extracts obtained in the first stage are liberated therefrom by neutralization of the acid and utilized as such or in conjunction with diluents, such as petroleum fractions, for the purposes described.
4. The process for refining petroleum or petroleum products (including cracked products) as well as the extracts obtained therefrom in known manner with liquid sulphur dioxide substantially as described.
5. The residues and bye-products resulting from the process for refining petroleum or petroleum products (including cracked products) as well as the extracts obtained therefrom in known manner with liquid sulphur dioxide as claimed in any of the preceding claims.

Improvements in or relating to composite rubber-faced surfacing material.

*Abstract.*—The invention relates to composite rubber-faced surfacing material of the type comprising a cement base faced with rubber which is then vulcanized.

An excess of sulphur is used at the bond, enough to form hard rubber on vulcanization and in addition to form metallic polysulphides with the base which penetrate both layers. The base may be compounded with fibre.

Silicate reacting substances may be used as fillers.

The claims are :—

1. A process of manufacture of composite rubber-faced surfacing material of the type referred to, characterized in that the cement base, or the rubber-facing, or both, at the interface between these parts, contains, during the vulcanizing step, a sufficiency of sulphur or sulphur-containing compounds (*e.g.*, sulphides) to result, on vulcanizing, in the formation, at the interface, of a stratum of hard rubber, and in excess of this sufficiency, a further quantity which, during the step of vulcanizing, will form *in situ* at said interface, with mineral components of the cement base, or of the rubber-facing or of both, polysulphides which intimately permeate the interfacial surfaces of the base, on the one hand, and of the hard rubber stratum on the other, so as firmly to unite these parts together.

2. A process according to claim 1, wherein, prior to vulcanization, the sulphur contents of the rubber-facing in the stratum adjacent the interface is such that the sulphur-rubber ratio is not substantially less than 1 : 4.

3. A process according to claim 1, wherein, prior to vulcanization, the sulphur-contents of the rubber-facing in the stratum adjacent the interface is such that the sulphur-rubber ratio is approximately 1 : 1 or in excess of this ratio.

4. A process according to claim 1, wherein, the sulphur required for vulcanizing and bonding is partly or wholly derived from the cement base, the latter having sulphur or sulphur compounds incorporated for the purpose in its substance.

5. Composite rubber-faced surfacing material according to preceding claims wherein the entire rubber facing or part thereof adjacent to the cement base contains silicate reacting compounds, such as Portland cement, which enhance interfacial unity between the rubber facing and the silicious components of the cement base.

6. Composite rubber-faced surfacing material whenever produced by a process of manufacture as claimed in any of the preceding claims.

7. Composite rubber-faced surfacing material according to claim 6, wherein the cement base is a mixture of cement and fibrous material for the purpose described.

8. Composite rubber-faced surfacing material according to claim 7, wherein the fibrous material is in a finely subdivided condition for the purpose described.

9. Composite rubber-faced surfacing material according to claim 7 or 8, wherein the fibrous material of the base consists of mineralized organic fibre, for the purpose described.

10. Composite rubber-faced surfacing material according to claims 7, 8 or 9, wherein the fibrous material of the base consists of an inorganic mineral fibre, for example, asbestos.

11. A method of producing the cement base for the manufacture of composite rubber-faced surfacing material according to claims 7, 8, 9 or 10, which comprises impregnating felted or woven fibre with cement or a cement aggregate building up a layered pile of the desired thickness of such cement impregnated material and allowing the whole to set, with or without the employment of pressure.

12. Composite rubber-faced surfacing material according to claim 6, whenever produced by a process of manufacture involving the method claimed in claim 11.

13. Composite rubber-faced surfacing material according to claims 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 or 12, wherein the rubber-facing is stratified and comprises an outer exterior surface layer of resilient rubber.

14. Composite rubber-faced surfacing material according to claims 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 or 12, wherein the rubber-facing is composed of rubber of substantially uniform hardness throughout the thickness of the facing, for example, is ebonite throughout its thickness.

15. A method of applying the rubber-facing, or the hard intermediate stratum thereof, to the cement base of composite rubber-faced surfacing material according to claims 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12 or 13 which comprises superimposing upon the surface of the cement base a layer of desired thickness of vulcanizable or vulcanized rubber latex composition or rubber solution.

16. The method claimed in 15, wherein the superimposition of the latex composition is effected while the cement base is in a wet or semi-dry condition, for the purpose described.

17. Composite rubber-faced surfacing material produced according to the preceding claims, wherein the cement base consists of reinforced concrete or ferro concrete.

18. Composite rubber-faced surfacing material as hereinbefore described.

An improved rain shield for wet tapping of rubber and like trees.

*Abstract.*—The shield is made by forming a gutter by bending up the hypotenuse of a right angle triangle of tin, the tin is bent round the tree and the upper edge held by a wire held by a bolt and nut.

The claims are :—

1. A rain shield for wet tapping of rubber and like trees made of tin or any other suitable material consisting of a gutter with a spare band having vertical deep cuts made in one piece substantially as described and illustrated.

2. In a rain shield for wet tapping of rubber and like trees as described in claim 1 the fixing of the gutter to the trunk of the tree by means of a wire with a bolt and nut placed in a rigid frame substantially as described and illustrated.

3. A rain shield for wet tapping of rubber and like trees substantially as described and illustrated in the accompanying drawings.

Improvements in tea rolling machines.

*Abstract.*—Pressure is to be applied to the tea automatically and periodically.

The period during which pressure is applied can be varied automatically. Suitable mechanism is described.

The claims are :—

1. The combination with a tea rolling machine of the kind hereinbefore referred to of means operable in such a manner that the pressure is applied to the tea under treatment automatically and periodically.
2. A tea rolling machine as claimed in claim 1, wherein the period during which pressure is applied is adapted to be varied automatically.
3. A tea rolling machine as claimed in claims 1 and 2, wherein a presser normally resting upon the tea is actuated by a push-rod arranged to be reciprocated by a cam driven from the main shaft of the tea rolling machine.
4. A tea rolling machine as claimed in claims 1 and 2, wherein a presser normally resting upon the tea is actuated through a flexible connection operable by a lever arm driven from the main shaft of the tea rolling machine.
5. A tea rolling machine as claimed in claim 4, wherein the flexible connection is adapted to extend from the said lever arm upwardly and over a pulley and is thereafter secured to the free end of a second lever pivotally secured in fixed relation to the presser and arranged to apply pressure periodically to the presser through the said flexible connection.
6. A tea rolling machine as claimed in claim 3 or claim 4, wherein the cam or lever arm is operatively connected to a toothed segment arranged to mesh with a second toothed segment driven by gearing from the main shaft of the tea rolling machine.
7. A tea rolling machine as claimed in claim 3, wherein means are provided to maintain the cam in operative engagement with the push-rod for a predetermined period.
8. A tea rolling machine as claimed in claim 4, wherein means operatively connected to the lever arm permit the flexible connection to apply pressure to the presser for a predetermined period.
9. A tea rolling machine as claimed in claim 7, wherein the means for maintaining the cam in operative engagement with the push-rod comprise a detent pawl arranged to be automatically released.
10. A tea rolling machine as claimed in claim 8, wherein means for applying pressure through a flexible connection for a predetermined period comprise a detent pawl arranged to be automatically released.
11. A tea rolling machine as claimed in claim 3 or claim 4, wherein the cam or lever arm is operatively connected to the main drive through a slipping clutch mechanism.
12. The improved tea rolling machine constructed, arranged and adapted to operate, substantially as described with reference to the accompanying drawings.

An improved drying house for preparing copra and the like.

*Abstract.*—A furnace sends hot gases through flues which radiate heat into a lower chamber of the house: the nuts are placed on rafters half way up and adjustable vents for the moist air are provided.

The claims are :—

1. In drying houses for preparing copra, a first chamber heated by radiation from hot plates arranged in the floor of it, and a second chamber arranged above the first whose floor is constructed as a grating or the like on which the coconut kernels to be dried may be spread, this said second chamber being provided as well with means for regulating the temperature and expelling moisture laden air, as and for the purpose described and illustrated.
2. A drying house for preparing copra, comprising means for providing hot gases and for distributing them to the aforesaid plates arranged in the floor of the said lower chamber and for discharging them, an upper chamber with its floor constructed as a grating or the like and means for regulating the temperature and for expelling moisture-laden air as and for the purpose described and illustrated.
3. A drying house for preparing copra, constructed and arranged substantially as described and illustrated.

Improvements relating to the manufacture of non-splintering glass sheets.

*Abstract.*—In a modification of application 2,342 the solvent is placed in the bag with the compound sheets standing on edge. By applying suction to the bag the excess liquid is squeezed out before the fluid pressure and heat are applied to the bag.

The claims are :—

1. In the method of manufacturing interadherent sheets of glass and cellulose derivative composition described and claimed in the specification of Ceylon Patent Application 2,342, a method of avoiding the trapping of air bubbles between the component sheets of a plurality of compound sheets conjointly pressed in a bag, consisting in immersing the sheets on edge in solvent or softening liquid within the bag and applying suction initially to the top of the closed bag, prior to subjecting the bag and sheets to conjoint direct fluid pressing and heating.
2. A method as set forth in claim 1, in which the sheets are immersed in the liquid by admitting the liquid at the bottom of the bag to rise and submerge the sheets.

3. An apparatus for carrying out the method as set forth in claim 1 or 2, consisting of pipe connections to the top and bottom of the bag, a channelled frame within and distending the bag and holding the sheets and a crate containing the bag.

4. The improved method of facilitating the manufacture of compound sheets of glass and cellulose derivative composition; and the apparatus therefore, substantially as described and illustrated.

2. A tapered vessel as claimed in the preceding claim fitted with fixed or hinged steadying handles.

3. An improved vessel as claimed in the preceding claims adapted for the use of coolies to carry latex collected from rubber trees or the like.

The claims are :—

1. An improved funnel for use in rubber estate factories and the like, characterized by being constructed with adjustable baffle plates in series and an adjustable slit as the final outlet.

2. An improved funnel as claimed in claim 1 for use in pouring rubber latex or the like into troughs or pans or the like to prevent objectionable formation of foam or froth in the said coagulating trough or the like.

Improvements in processes and means for drying and/or otherwise treating timber.

*Abstract.*—A log of wood is placed in a vacuum chamber and a pressure plate is applied to one end of the log. On operating the vacuum fluid can be forced through the log.

The claims are :—

1. The improved process for drying and/or otherwise treating timber, consisting of inserting it within a vacuum and subjecting it to fluid pressure, substantially as described.

2. Means for carrying out my improved process characterized by a vacuum cylinder having cradles and runners or the like for the timber and removable end plates, substantially as described.

3. Means for carrying out my improved process in which a pressure plate is secured on to the timber, substantially as described.

4. In means for carrying out my improved process wherein a pressure plate is secured on to the timber the provision of a union or the like on the pressure plate, a union within the vacuum cylinder communicating with the pressure supply and a detachable connection between said unions, substantially as described.

5. Means for carrying out my improved process wherein a plurality of pressure plates and lengths of timber are employed within one vacuum cylinder, substantially as described.

6. Means for carrying out my improved process wherein a trap is incorporated within the vacuum pipe substantially as described.

Improvements in and relating to sun-blinds.

*Abstract.*—An electric motor is connected to speed reduction gearing and both are enclosed within the roller. Means are provided to bring the motor to rest at desired positions of the blind.

The claims are :—

1. An electrically operated sun-blind comprising a hollow blind roller within which the operating motor is enclosed.
2. An electrically operated sun-blind according to claim 1, wherein the motor is operatively connected to the blind roller through the medium of speed reduction gearing also enclosed within the hollow blind roller.
3. An electrically operated sun-blind according to claim 2, wherein the speed reduction gearing comprises two worm and work wheel gears.
4. An electrically driven blind roller according to claim 2, wherein the electric motor and its speed reduction gearing are housed within the blind roller in a manner permitting easy removal of the motor and gearing when required.
5. An electrically operated sun-blind according to claim 1, wherein the blind roller is mounted to rotate on a movable rail carried by radius arms and the blind fabric extends from the roller to the building being protected.
6. The improved electrically operated sun-blind substantially as described with reference to the accompanying drawing.
