The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information:—

An Ordinance to amend the Housing and Town Improvement Ordinance, No. 19 of 1915.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Housing and Town Improvement Amendment Ordinance, 1929.

Amendment of section 30 of the principal Ordinance.

- 2 Section 30 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following sub-sections immediately after sub-section (5) thereof:—
 - (6) It shall be lawful for the Governor in Executive Council by order to be published in the Government Gazette, to declare that any board so appointed shall be dissolved from and after a date to be specified in the said order, and further to declare, if necessary, that the local authority or any particular local authority having jurisdiction within the administrative limits for which such board was appointed shall be the successor of the board for all purposes, or for any limited time or purpose, or subject to such restrictions, terms, or conditions, as may be specified in the said order.

(7) Any such order of dissolution shall have effect notwithstanding the fact that the term of office of the board named in the said order shall not have expired at the date

of dissolution specified therein.

(8) Any local authority so declared to be the successor of a board that is dissolved by an order made under subsection (6) shall, if not already a body corporate, be deemed upon publication of the said order of dissolution to be a body corporate, with power to sue and to be sued under such designation as shall be specified in the said order, and all property of the board, whether movable or immovable, shall, upon publication of the said order and subject to the provisions thereof, be deemed to be transferred to and vested in such local authority.

(9) The powers and duties conferred and imposed on a Board of Improvement Commissioners under section 31 (1) (a), (b), (c), and (d) shall, upon publication of any such order of dissolution and subject to the provisions thereof, be deemed to be conferred and imposed on the local authority which is declared by the said order to be the successor of the board named in the order; and without prejudice to the generality of the powers so conferred, or of the duties so imposed, it shall be lawful for such local authority upon

dissolution of the board,

(a) to call in, collect, sue for, receive, recover, or appropriate all moneys, debts, dues, or funds belonging or owing to the board;

(b) to receive and expend all moneys voted, appropriated, or otherwise assigned to the board or to such local authority for the purpose of carrying out any scheme or work under this Ordinance;

(c) to pay and discharge all debts and obligations by way of contract or otherwise which may have been incurred by the board or for which the board may be liable;

*(d) to continue, complete, discontinue, or abandon any scheme or work initiated, commenced, or undertaken by the board;

(e) to employ such officers or servants of the board as it may deem expedient on such terms or conditions as it may think fit; and

(f) generally, to do or perform all such other acts, matters, or things as may be necessary to give effect to the said order of dissolution, and the provisions thereof.

Objects and Reasons.

The primary object of this Bill is to enable the Kandy Board of Improvement Commissioners to be abolished as it is considered inadvisable to have such a board side by side with the Municipal Council. The existence of the board in the same area as the Municipal Council occasions duplication of authority and of officers and unnecessary expense.

2. The Bill has, however, been made general in form and provides machinery for the dissolution of any Board of Improvement Commissioners, and enables a local authority to succeed to the rights, duties, powers, and privileges of such a Board, subject to such conditions or limitations as may be specified in the order of dissolution.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information and in substitution of the Draft previously published in the Government Gazette of December 14 and 21, 1928:—

An Ordinance further to amend the Local Boards Ordinance, 1898.

II. 447.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Boards Amendment Ordinance, 1929.

2 The following proviso shall be inserted at the end of section 12 of the principal Ordinance:—

Provided that where it is shown to the satisfaction of the Governor in Executive Council that—

(i.) A meeting for the election of members was not duly held in the month of December, whether before or after the enactment of this section, as required by section 12; or

(ii.) For any reason it is impracticable to hold a meeting for the election of members in the month of December as required by section 12;

the Governor in Executive Council may by order published in the Government Gazette—

(a) Prescribe a date, subsequent to the said month of December, for the holding of a meeting for such election, and the date on which any members elected thereat shall go out of office; and

(b) Declare that the elected and unofficial members holding office immediately before the end of the said month of December shall continue and shall be deemed to have continued to hold office from the end of the said month of December until the election held pursuant to the order made under this proviso, with the like powers, duties, rights, privileges, obligations, and immunities as theretofore.

Amendment of section 12 of the principal Ordinance.

Objects and Reasons.

A case has arisen in which it has been impracticable to hold the Local Board election at Minuwangoda, within the time prescribed by section 12 of the Local Boards Ordinance, 1898. The necessary preliminaries by way of preparation of lists of electors and persons qualified to be elected, notices, &c., have, by an oversight, not been complied with. The existing Local Board went out of office under the Ordinance on December 31, 1928, and a new Board has not been elected.

- 2. The object of this Bill is to provide a means whereby an emergency of this nature can be met.
- 3. It is proposed that in such circumstances, the Governor in Council should have power to prescribe a date for the election and to extend the life of the existing Board until the new election.
