#### Hambantota S. O. No. 1,858.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Udamattalawewa (tank and bund), Welagawalanda (reservation for tank bund), &c., situate in the village of Udamattala, in the Magam pattu of the Hambantota District, in the Southern Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."
