## GOVERNMENT NOTIFICATION.

ORDINANCE No. 17 of 1869.

 $V \ 3/29$ 

IT is hereby notified that under section 11 (a) of Ordinance No. 17 of 1869 the Legislative Council did, at its Session on January 31, 1929, pass the following resolution, and that the resolution has been duly sanctioned by His Excellency the Governor:—

That in terms of section 11 (a) of the Customs Ordinance, No. 17 of 1869, on and after the day following the date of this resolution there shall be levied and paid upon all unrefined salt imported into this Island an import duty of Rs. 4 per cwt. in lieu of the present duty of Rs. 3 per cwt. as set out in Schedule B of the said Ordinance.

It is further notified that the said resolution has been duly submitted to and sanctioned by the Secretary of State for the Colonies as required by section 11 (b) of the said Ordinance.
