DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance for the better preservation of public health and the suppression of nuisances in rural areas.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title and construction.

No. 15 of 1862, I. 450.

Interpretation.

Powers of Board of Health under the principal Ordinance to be exercisable by Government Agent.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Nuisances Ordinance, 1929, and shall be read and construed as one with the Nuisances Ordinance, 1862 (hereinafter called "the principal Ordinance").

2 In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, "rural area" means any part of a revenue district which is not within the limits of a Local Board, Sanitary Board, Municipal or District Council, or the Nuwara Eliya Board of Improvement.

3 In every rural area all powers and duties which by the principal Ordinance are conferred or imposed on a Board of Health shall after the commencement of this Ordinance be exercisable or performed by the Government Agent of the province or the Assistant Government Agent of the district in which the rural area is situate, and not by the Board of Health for that area.

Objects and Reasons.

THIS Bill is introduced in order to provide for the maintenance of sanitary work and the prevention of nuisances in rural areas.

2. The Nuisances Ordinance, 1862, is inadequate for these purposes since the authorities under that Ordinance are the Board of Health and the Police Magistrate. In practice, Boards of Health no longer exist, save in the Western Province, and there is objection to the Police Magistrate functioning as an authority under the Ordinance, since the Magistrate who signs a notice will also try the case if the person on whom it is served is prosecuted for non-compliance.

3. It is proposed that in future the powers and duties of the Board of Health shall, in rural areas, be transferred to the Government Agent or the Assistant Government Agent.
