MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information and in substitution for the Draft Ordinance previously published in the Gazettes Nos. 7,672 and 7,673 of November 2 and 9, 1928 :—

III. 292.

An Ordinance to amend the Housing and Town Improvement Ordinance, No. 19 of 1915.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Housing and Town Improvement Second Amendment Ordinance, 1929.

Amendment of section 106 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 106 (3) of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "upon conviction of any person under sub-section (1) (b)" for the words "upon such conviction" in the fourth line thereof.

Amendment of section 107 of the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 107 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

(1) by the substitution of the word "agreement" for the word "deed" wherever the latter word occurs in sub-section (1) thereof ;

(2) by the substitution of the word "agreements" for the word "deeds" in the second line of sub-section (3) thereof ; and

(3) by the addition of the following sub-section at the end thereof :—

I. 113.

(4) The provisions of section 2 of Ordinance No. 7 of 1840 shall not apply to any agreement or instrument referred to in this section.

Objects and Reasons.

SECTION 106 (1) (b) and (2) of the Housing and Town Improvement Ordinance, No. 19 of 1915, provide that in the case of a street for which no street lines have been defined, the Chairman of the local authority may permit either a masonry boundary wall or a gateway to be erected within the space of 20 feet from the middle of the street, and may require as a condition precedent to such permission that the owner shall execute an undertaking to waive compensation in the event of subsequent acquisition of the wall or gateway in question.

2. Section 106 (3) provides a penalty for offences against sections 106 (1) (a) and 106 (1) (b), and gives the court power on conviction to make an order in the terms of the undertaking referred to in section 106 (2). This undertaking can however only be required in cases falling within section 106 (1) (b), and the words "upon such conviction" in section 106 (2) have therefore been altered to "upon conviction of any person under sub-section (1) (b)".

3. The amendments effected by clause 3 are made with the object of exempting the instruments referred to in section 107 from the necessity of notarial execution.

An Ordinance to make Supplementary Provision for the Public Services for the Financial Year 1927-28.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (1927-28) Ordinance, No. of 1929. Short title.

2 The several sums of money appearing in the schedule hereto amounting in all to the sum of Rupees Two million Nine hundred and Twenty-eight thousand Five hundred and Sixty-three and cents Twenty are hereby declared to be payable for the service of the Financial Year beginning on October 1, 1927, and ending on September 30, 1928, out of the revenue of the Colony for and in respect of the several services in the said schedule mentioned in addition to the sums appropriated by Ordinance No. 7 of 1927.
