## DRAFT ORDINANCE.

### MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

#### An Ordinance for making provision for the Public and Railway Services for the Financial Year 1929-30.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Appropriation Ordinance of 1929.

Appropriation for year 1929-30.

2 Without prejudice to any other law authorizing any expenditure, sums not exceeding one hundred and thirty-three million four hundred and thirty-one thousand six hundred and sixty-six and thirty-three million rupees are hereby declared to be payable for the service of the financial year beginning on October 1, 1929, and ending on September 30, 1930, out of the revenue and other funds of the Colony and the revenue of the Ceylon Government Railway respectively ; and the said sums may be expended as specified in the schedules to this Ordinance.

and that such appointment will be made accordingly,  
and that the petitioner, as the husband of the deceased  
above named, is entitled to have letters of administration  
issued to him, and that such letters will be issued to him  
accordingly, unless the respondents above named or any  
other person or persons interested in the matter shall,  
on July 3, 1929, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction  
of this court to the contrary.
