**VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON IN THE  
MONTH OF JANUARY, 1929.**

**REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.**

THIS report deals with the Vital Statistics of the 35 principal towns in the Island, proclaimed under sections 31-36 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

**Marriages.**

2. The number of marriages of residents in proclaimed towns was 493 (427 General, 3 Kandyan, and 63 Muslim), as against 372 in the preceding month and 505 in the corresponding month of last year.

**Births.**

3. The births registered numbered 2,352 (1,220 males and 1,132 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 42·43 per 1,000 of the population, as against 40·19 in the preceding month, 39·77 in the corresponding month of last year, and 35·21 the average for the corresponding months since 1919. The rate exclusive of Lunugala, where no births were registered, ranged from 10·99 in Teldeniya to 73·03 in Nawalapitiya. There were 2,052 births of children whose mothers were residents of the towns, equivalent to an annual rate of 37·02, as against 34·87 in the preceding month and 35·04 in the corresponding month of last year.

4. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 901 (455 males and 446 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 39·63, as against 39·25 in the preceding month, 37·82 in the corresponding month of last year, and 31·90 the average for the corresponding months since 1919. The rate exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards ranged from 17·97 in Maradana South to 36·75 in Wellawatta South. There were 761 births of children whose mothers were residents of the city, equivalent to an annual rate of 33·48, as against 32·02 in the preceding month and 32·16 in the corresponding month of last year.

**Deaths.**

5. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 2,528 (1,306 males and 1,222 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 45·60, as against 41·87 in the preceding month and 37·74 in the corresponding month of last year. There were 1,938 deaths of residents of the towns, equivalent to an annual standardized rate of 37·81, as against 34·20 in the preceding month, 30·45 in the corresponding month of last year, and 34·07 the average for the corresponding months since 1919. The standardized death rate ranged from 105·25 in Mannar to 8·34 in Ambalangoda.

6. In the city of Colombo the deaths registered numbered 841 (446 males and 395 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 36·99, as against 34·79 in the preceding month and 32·07 in the corresponding month of last year. There were 673 deaths of residents of the city, which corresponded to an annual standardized rate of 34·09, as against 30·56 in the preceding month, 29·02 in the corresponding month of last year, and 33·63 the average for the corresponding months since 1919. The death rate of residents exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards ranged from 37·38 in San Sebastian to 11·76 in Kollupitiya.

7. The stillbirths registered during the month numbered 181 (95 males and 86 females), as against 170 in the preceding month and 172 in the corresponding month of last year.

#### Infant Mortality.

8. The deaths of children under one year of age amounted to 542 and corresponded to a rate of 268 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended January, 1929. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 230, as against 232 in the preceding month, 198 in the corresponding month of last year, and 244 the average for the corresponding months since 1919. There were 497 deaths of children under one year of age whose mothers were residents of the towns, which corresponded to a rate of 242, as against 246 in the preceding month and 205 in the corresponding month of last year.

9. In the city of Colombo the deaths of children under one year of age amounted to 178 and corresponded to a rate of 220 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended January, 1929. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only the rate was 198, as against 211 in the preceding month, 173 in the corresponding month of last year, and 237 the average for the corresponding months since 1919. There were 159 deaths of children under one year of age whose mothers were residents of the city, which corresponded to a rate of 209, as against 220 in the preceding month and 187 in the corresponding month of last year.

#### Causes of Deaths.

10. The highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, to which 14 per cent. of the total deaths were due. *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia* caused 8 per cent.; *Debility* (of children under one year), 7 per cent.; *Convulsions*, *Dysentery*, and *Senility*, each 6 per cent.; *Anchylostomiasis*, *Enteritis*, *Worms*, *Phthisis*, and *Diarrhoea*, each 4 per cent.; *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, *Diseases* and *Accidents of Childbirth* and *Prematurity*, each 3 per cent.; *Influenza*, *Enteric Fever*, and *Accidents* and *Negligence*, each 2 per cent.; and *Paralysis*, *Bronchitis*, and *Heart Disease*, each 1 per cent.

11. In Colombo, too, the highest mortality was from *Pneumonia*, to which 14 per cent. of the total deaths were due. *Debility* (of children under one year) caused 8 per cent.; *Enteritis*, 7 per cent.; *Influenza*, 6 per cent.; *Senility* and *Phthisis*, each 5 per cent.; *Convulsions*, *Anchylostomiasis*, *Bright's Disease* and *Nephritis*, *Malaria* and *Malarial Cachexia*, *Diarrhoea*, and *Diseases* and *Accidents of Childbirth*, each 3 per cent.; *Dysentery*, *Heart Disease*, *Worms*, *Paralysis*, *Enteric Fever*, *Prematurity*, and *Bronchitis*, each 2 per cent.; and *Diabetes*, *Accidents* and *Negligence*, and *Cancer*, each 1 per cent.

12. Three deaths from *Plague* were registered (in Colombo), as against 5 in the previous month and 5 in the corresponding month of last year.

13. *Infectious Diseases reported*.—The infectious disease most prevalent during the month was *Measles*, of which 326 cases were reported (241 in Colombo, 34 in Moratuwa, 25 in Kalutara); *Chickenpox* followed with 114 cases (63 in Colombo, 17 in Moratuwa); *Phthisis* 92 (86 in Colombo); *Enteric Fever* 56 (18 in Colombo, 9 each in Panadure and Galle, 6 in Jaffna); *Dysentery* 34 (6 in Moratuwa, 5 in Panadure, 4 each in Kalutara, Matara, and Hambantota); *Continued Fever* 28 (12 in Colombo, 10 in Galle, 5 in Kandy); *Mumps* 17 (12 in Colombo); *Whooping Cough* 7 (in Colombo); *Plague* 6 (in Colombo); *Diphtheria* 6 (3 in Colombo); *Cholera* 1 (in Colombo); and *Diarrhoea* 1 (in Galle).

#### Meteorology.

14. *Rainfall*.—Ratnapura recorded the highest rainfall (8·55 in.). In the other towns the rainfall ranged from 6·61 in. in Colombo to 0·01 in. in Hambantota.

15. *Mean Temperature*.—The mean temperature varied from 80·0° in Ratnapura to 55·0° in Nuwara Eliya, and was 77·8° in Colombo.
