“THE FLOOD PROTECTION ORDINANCE, NO. 4 OF 1924.”

THE Governor in Council has, under the provisions of section 6 of the Flood Protection Ordinance, No. 4 of 1924, ordered that the scheme on the schedule hereto be confirmed.

SCHEDULE.

*Bolgoda Flood Protection Scheme.*

The scheme is devised for the protection (from floods) of the low-lying lands in the neighbourhood of the Bolgoda lakes, in the Western Province, and consists, briefly, of the following works:—

- (i.) A flood bund on the right bank of the Kalu-ganga closing the Paraduwa gap.
- (ii.) A flood bund and a canal lock at the outlet of the Kapu-ela.
- (iii.) The blocking of the Alut-ela bridge on the Kirimetiya-Yale road.
- (iv.) Flood bunds in the gaps at Dikhena.

2. The scheme will protect 9,200 acres of low-lying lands.

The construction of the scheme is estimated to cost Rs. 220,000 approximately (exclusive of Establishment, Transport, Tool, and Plant charges) and its annual maintenance about Rs. 5,500 (exclusive of the above charges). The capital cost of the scheme and the cost of its maintenance will be borne by Government.

3. The works to be maintained on completion of the scheme are shown in the plan of the Bolgoda Flood Area.

## AMENDMENTS REFERRED TO.

*Clause 17 (i).*—In the first sentence alter "The school must be open for instruction for at least 180 days during the year" to "The school must be open for instruction for at least 180 sessions during the year in a one-session school and for at least 360 sessions during the year in a two-session school."

*Clause 19.*—In line 12 add a new sentence as follows:—"Adequate accommodation for physical training must be provided where possible."

*Clause 32 (iii).*—In line 3 after the word "may" insert "assume the management or."

*Clause 36.*—Alter to read as follows:—

(a) Primary classes which have an average attendance of not more than 55 eligible pupils for the past school year will be allowed to count one teacher for every 18 units of average attendance.

Where the average attendance in primary classes is over 55 and not more than 100 eligible pupils, the allowance will be one teacher for every 20 units of average attendance, and the maximum staff eligible for grant will be four teachers.

Where the average attendance in primary classes is over 100 eligible pupils, the allowance will be one teacher for every 25 units of average attendance.

(b) In post-primary classes (*i.e.*, above Standard V.), the allowance will be one teacher for every 15 units of average attendance.

(c) To secure the adequate distribution of trained teachers, there should not be more than one trained teacher for every 40 units of average attendance.

(d) Vernacular schools which provide an approved optional course of English (one period a day), for pupils above Standard III. will be allowed, in addition to the number of teachers under Clause 36 (a) and (b), a full-time English teacher for every 80 units of average attendance of pupils taking this course. Where the number of units of average attendance is less than 80, proportionate grant for a part-time English teacher will be allowed provided the units of average attendance of such pupils is not less than 20.

(e) The grant paid on account of English teachers in Vernacular schools shall be the difference between the approved salaries of these teachers and the Manager's contribution as shown in Appendix C.

*Clause 52 (h).*—Delete, and insert the following as a separate paragraph:—

"The number of eligible pupils will be further subject to the limits of accommodation indicated in Clause 19."

*Clauses 66, 68-74, 77 (2nd paragraph).*—Delete.

*Appendices B and C.*—In the headings alter "Bilingual schools" to "Vernacular and Bilingual Schools."

In Appendix B alter the scale for uncertificated teachers as follows:—

## RULE.

Rule 191 of the General Rules dated August 12, 1926, published in *Gazette* No. 7,542 of August 20, 1926, is amended so as to read as follows:—

Any such prisoner who prefers to provide his own food for any meal shall give notice thereof beforehand at the time required; but the Superintendent shall not permit any such prisoner to receive any prison allowance of food for the meal for which he procures or receives food at his own expense, nor should he be paid for the supplies procured by him. European Civil prisoners who do not provide their own food shall receive ordinary No. 2 diet. Ceylonese and Burgher Civil prisoners who do not provide their own food shall receive full Ceylonese diet. If at any future period the cost of a full Ceylonese diet exceeds the rate fixed by Government for the subsistence of Ceylonese and Burgher Civil prisoners the Inspector-General of Prisons shall report the matter to Government.

5. The tenders are to be made upon forms which will be supplied on application at the Divisional Forest Office, Ratnapura. No tender will be considered unless it is on the recognized form. Alterations must be initialled, otherwise the tenders may be treated as informal and rejected.

6. A deposit of Rs. 25 will be required to be made at the Treasury or any Kachcheri and a receipt produced for same before any form of the tender is issued.

7. On execution of the agreement, the purchaser will be entitled on application to a refund of the sum of Rs. 25 deposited by him prior to tendering.

8. Offers should be made at a rate per cubic yard of fuel written both in words and figures. If tenderers intend removing any timber in the log they should offer a flat rate per cubic foot irrespective of species.

9. No tender will be considered unless the procedure laid down above has been strictly complied with. The Conservator of Forests reserves to himself the right, without question, of rejecting any or all tenders and of accepting any tender not necessarily the highest tender.

10. The successful tenderer will be required to execute a purchase agreement in respect of the coupe.

11. Before execution of the agreement, the purchaser will be required to deposit a sum of Rs. 250 as security for the efficient and punctual fulfilment of the agreement.

12. (a) After the security has been deposited and the agreement executed a proportionate area of the coupe will be demarcated to cover the security.

(b) The purchaser on felling the area demarcated shall remove all fuel and timber to a point outside the area, where it will be measured by a Forest Officer.

(c) Removal permits will be issued after the purchaser has paid at the tendered rate the full value of all timber and fuel stacked outside the area.

13. The special rules for felling, conversion, and removal which the agreement will require to be observed are specified in the conditions below. Nothing in these conditions shall render the purchaser in any way exempt from liability for punishment under the Forest Ordinance of 1907, should he or any of the workmen in his employ be responsible for the commission of a forest offence outside the boundaries of the coupe or of any compartment of the coupe as the case may be. For this purpose, the purchaser should ascertain beforehand the limits of the coupe or any compartment of the coupe in which he is authorized to fell under clause 12. In the event of any dispute no plea of ignorance of the boundaries will absolve him from being punished as mentioned before.

14. The felling and removal of the fuel in the coupe should be completed on or before June 30, 1930. All the material in the coupe not removed by this date shall be assessed by the Divisional Forest Officer and its value deducted from the security.

All material in the coupe should as far as possible be utilized. If the purchaser fails to do so he will be requested to pay at the tendered rate for material lying in the area which, in the opinion of the Divisional Forest Officer could have been utilized. The value of such material will be deducted from the security.

15. The purchaser shall commence felling along the full length of one boundary of the coupe previously pointed out by the Range Forest Officer, Ratnapura, and shall progress in a direction parallel to the boundary along which the felling has been commenced in the manner prescribed below:—

- (a) All tree seedlings and saplings which are under 3 inches in diameter shall be cut out flush with the ground.
- (b) All saplings and trees over 3 inches in diameter shall be felled within 6 inches of the ground.
- (c) The firewood shall be billeted into lengths of 3 feet.

16. If the purchaser fails to pay the value of the material of each compartment of the coupe within a week of the date of completion of felling and removal in terms of clause 12, it shall be within the discretion of the Divisional Forest Officer to cancel the agreement as from the date of such default and to forfeit the security. Any unremoved or unfelled material within the coupe shall unconditionally revert to the Crown as from the date of such cancellation of the agreement.

17. The purchaser shall strictly confine all transport of the fuel removed from the coupe to paths along which

such transport has been authorized by the Range Forest Officer, Ratnapura, either within the coupe or the forest of which the coupe forms a part. All damages caused to produce not paid for shall be compensated at rates assessed by the Divisional Forest Officer.

18. If no objection exists in the opinion of the Divisional Forest Officer, the purchaser shall be permitted to erect wire shoots for the transport of materials always, provided he pays full royalty value for the forest produce outside the coupe or compartment of the coupe in which he is felling damaged during such erection and in using such shoot. The permission of the Divisional Forest Officer should be obtained before erection of any wire shoot.

19. The purchaser further agrees that for each and every infringement of the above conditions, he shall become liable to a fine not exceeding Rs. 50 to be imposed in writing by and at the discretion of the Divisional Forest Officer and this fine shall be recoverable from his security.

20. The purchaser shall also agree that any deficit in the full amount of the security caused by fines imposed on him shall at once be made good, otherwise a proportionate deduction will be made in the extent of each compartment of the coupe he may at that time fell or become entitled to fell next under clause 12. If the security becomes so decreased as to cause only a small

area of the coupe to be taken over for felling and thus hamper the maximum rate at which exploitation is expected to proceed so that the work in the whole coupe may be completed before the prescribed date, it shall be within the discretion of the Divisional Forest Officer to demand a replacement of the deficit in the security or to cancel the agreement and forfeit the balance of the security. The cancellation of the agreement shall be made after 7 days of such demand in writing.

21. The purchaser shall have the right of appeal to the Conservator of Forests in the event of any of the enforcement of any of the penalties specified in the above conditions and the purchaser shall agree to accept the Conservator of Forests' decision as final and binding.

## VITAL STATISTICS.

### Registrar-General's Health Report of the City of Colombo for the Week ended August 31, 1929.

**Births.**—The total births registered in the City of Colombo in the week were 158 (3 Europeans, 12 Burghers, 85 Sinhalese, 30 Tamils, 20 Moors, 2 Malays, and 6 Others). The birth-rate per 1,000 per annum (calculated on the estimated population on July 1, 1929, viz., 267,667) was 30.8, as against 31.8 in the preceding week, 43.3 in the corresponding week of last year, and 36.1 the weekly average for last year.

**Deaths.**—The total deaths registered were 171 (10 Burghers, 92 Sinhalese, 39 Tamils, 18 Moors, 4 Malays, and 8 Others). The death-rate per 1,000 per annum was 33.3, as against 29.6 in the previous week, 33.8 in the corresponding week of last year, and 30.3 the weekly average for last year.

**Infantile Deaths.**—Of the 171 total deaths, 40 were of infants under one year of age, as against 38 in the preceding week, 38 in the corresponding week of the previous year, and 33 the average for last year.

**Stillbirths.**—The number of stillbirths registered during the week was 8.

**Principal Causes of Death.**—1. (a) Thirty-four deaths from *Pneumonia* were registered, 19 in Maradana hospitals (including 8 deaths of non-residents), 4 in Slave Island, 3 in Maradana North, 2 each in Kotahena North, New Bazaar, and Maradana South, and 1 each in Kotahena South and Maradana East, as against 18 in the previous week, and 23 the weekly average for last year.

(b) Ten deaths from *Influenza* were registered, 5 in New Bazaar, 2 in Kotahena South, and 1 each in San Sebastian, Kotahena North, and Slave Island, as against 6 in the previous week, and 8 the weekly average for last year.

(c) Two deaths from *Bronchitis* were registered, 1 in Kotahena South and 1 (of a non-resident) in Maradana hospital. The number registered during the preceding week was also 2, and the weekly average for last year was 3.

2. (a) Twelve deaths from *Phthisis* were registered, 5 in Maradana hospitals (including 1 death of a non-resident), 2 in New Bazaar, and 1 each in St. Paul's, Maradana North, Maradana South, Slave Island, and Wellawatta South. The number registered during the preceding week was also 12, and the weekly average for last year was 11.

(b) Three deaths from *Phthisis* of residents of Colombo town occurred at the Anti-tuberculosis hospital, Ragama, during the week.

3. Four deaths from *Enteric Fever* were registered, 3 in Maradana hospitals (including 1 death of a non-resident) and 1 in St. Paul's, as against 2 in the previous week, and 3 the weekly average for last year.

4. Twenty-five deaths from *Enteritis* were registered, 7 from *Debility*, 6 from *Infantile Convulsions*, 4 each from *Diarrhoea* and *Accidents*, 3 from *Dysentery*, 1 each from *Worms* and *Tetanus*, and 58 from *Other Causes*.

5. **Reported Cases.**—19 cases of *Chickenpox*, 9 of *Enteric Fever*, and 2 of *Measles* were reported during the week, as against 20, 6, and 13, respectively, of the preceding week.

**State of the Weather.**—The mean temperature of air was 80.7°, against 80.4° in the preceding week and 82.5° in the corresponding week of the previous year. The mean atmospheric pressure was 29.928 in., against 29.856 in. in the preceding week and 29.890 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year. The total rainfall in the week was 0.07 in., against 0.24 in. in the preceding week and 0.09 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year.

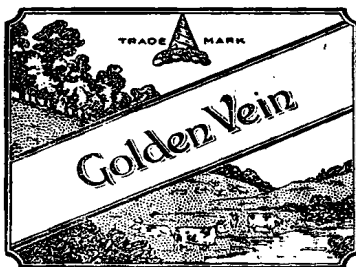
