The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

III. 268.

An Ordinance to repeal the Aerial Navigation Ordinance, No. 24 of 1914.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as The Aerial Navigation Repeal Ordinance, 1929.

Repeal.

2 The Aerial Navigation Ordinance, No. 24 of 1914, is hereby repealed.

Objects and Reasons.

THIS Bill is introduced on instructions from the Secretary of State. The purpose for which the Ordinance to be repealed by clause 2 of the Bill was originally enacted is now amply provided for by the Air Navigation (Colonies, Protectorates and Mandated Territories) Order, 1927, published in Government Gazette No. 7,695 of March 1, 1929.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

I. 747.

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 1 of 1871 intituled "An Ordinance to amend the Customs Ordinance, No. 17 of 1869, and to provide for the issue of Warehouse Warrants".

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Amendment Ordinance, 1929.

Amendment of section 8 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 8 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

- (1) by the substitution of the words "any animals or vehicles" for the words "horses, mules, bullocks, trucks, carts, sledges, or other carriages" in the second and third lines of paragraph (2) thereof;
- (2) by the insertion of the words "or property within the customs premises" immediately after the word "goods" in paragraph (3) thereof;

(3) by the insertion of the following two paragraphs immediately after paragraph (3) thereof :—

“(4) For prohibiting or regulating the admission of persons to the customs premises, and for excluding persons therefrom ; and

(5) For regulating the conduct of persons within the customs premises ;”

and

(4) by the deletion of the words “ and be liable to a fine not exceeding five pounds ” in the last two lines thereof, and the substitution of the following words therefor :—

“ and shall be liable to forfeit a sum not exceeding fifty rupees, or, on summary trial and conviction by a Police Magistrate, to a fine not exceeding fifty rupees or to imprisonment of either description for any term not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment.

In this section and in any regulation made thereunder, “ customs premises ” means the customs premises as defined from time to time by the Principal Collector of Customs by notification in the Government Gazette ”.

Objects and Reasons.

A NOTIFICATION published in Government Gazette No. 7,002 of March 21, 1919, prohibits unauthorized persons from entering the Colombo customs premises upon pain of a prosecution under section 450 of the Ceylon Penal Code.

2. It has been found in practice that the provisions of section 450 of the Penal Code are inadequate for dealing with cases of unauthorized entry into customs premises, and in one case doubt was expressed as to whether the Colombo customs premises are an “ enclosure ” within the meaning of that section.

3. This Bill therefore extends section 8 of Ordinance No. 1 of 1871 (which contains a power to make regulations for certain purposes in connection with customs premises) so as to permit regulations to be made relating to the admission of persons to, the exclusion of persons from, and the conduct of persons within the customs premises.

4. Clause 2 of the Bill effects this extension and, besides making two minor amendments in section 8, provides also for a penalty of three months imprisonment, the same term as is authorized by section 450 of the Penal Code, being imposed by a Police Magistrate for breach of regulations, and states that “ customs premises ”, for the purposes of the section and regulations made thereunder, means the customs premises as defined by the Principal Collector of Customs by notification in the Gazette.
