Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Kiulchena, Kolongahatenna, &c., situate in the village of Tittawelgolla, in the Kandapalla korale of the Wellawaya division of the Badulla District, in the Province of Uva, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."
