### Kurunegala S. O. No. 4,224.

#### Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Mylagahahenyaya, situate in the village of Pahala Kalugama, in the Yagampattu korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 26th day of March, 1926, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Mylagahahenyaya, situate in the village of Pahala Kalugama, in the Yagampattu korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent 3 acres 2 roods and 31 perches, and shown as lot 28 in block survey preliminary plan No. 2,000, was made to Navroji Maneckji Bharucha, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (*vide* Notice No. 9,063):
