DRAFT ORDINANCE.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend the law relating to the Church of England in Ceylon.

WHEREAS the Church of England in Ceylon has since its foundation been a diocese of the Ecclesiastical Province of the Church of England in India under the jurisdiction of the Bishop of Calcutta as Metropolitan Bishop of the Province of India, Burma and Ceylon and the Bishops of Colombo have been and still are under the jurisdiction of the Bishop of Calcutta as such Metropolitan :

And whereas the Church of England in India and Burma has under the Indian Church Act, 1927, and the Indian Church Measure, 1927, severed its legal connection with the Church of England in England, and has under the powers recognised and conferred by the said Act and Measure established for its fuller governance a system of Diocesan Councils and a representative General Council acting under a written constitution agreed upon by that General Council and the Diocesan Councils (including the Synod of the Church of England in Ceylon) :

And whereas it is desirable that the Diocese of Colombo (commonly called the Church of England in Ceylon) should retain its connection with the Church of India, Burma and Ceylon (by whatsoever name called) and the Metropolitan Bishop of Calcutta :

And whereas the regulation of the affairs of the Church of England in Ceylon has been provided for by certain Ordinances of the Legislative Council of Ceylon and it is desirable that so much of the said Ordinances should be repealed as is necessary to enable the Diocese of Colombo to be a Diocese of the Ecclesiastical Province of the Church of India, Burma and Ceylon (by whatsoever name called) under the constitution of that Church which will be adopted after the passing of the aforesaid Indian Church Act and Indian Church Measure :

And whereas to this end it is necessary that the legal connection between the Church of England in Ceylon (by whatsoever other name it may be called in certain Ordinances) and the Church of England, which is constituted by certain provisions of Ordinance No. 6 of 1885, be dissolved :

Be it therefore enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Episcopal Church Amendment Ordinance, 1929.

Continuation of Church of England in Ceylon, and interpretation of expressions relating thereto.

2 The Diocese of Colombo of the Ecclesiastical Province of the Church of India, Burma and Ceylon (by whatsoever name called) shall for all intents and purposes be deemed to be a continuation of and identical with the Church of England in Ceylon sometimes called or known as "the United Church of England and Ireland", "the Episcopal Churches in the Island of Ceylon", or "the Church of England in the Diocese of Colombo", and all property, rights and privileges which belong to, and all duties and liabilities which have been imposed upon, the Church of England in Ceylon shall devolve upon the said Diocese of Colombo of the Ecclesiastical Province of the Church of India, Burma and Ceylon (by whatsoever name called), and the expressions "the Church of England in Ceylon", "the United Church of England and Ireland", "the Episcopal Churches in the Island of Ceylon", "the Church of

England in the Diocese of Colombo " and all other expressions relating to the said Church of England in Ceylon heretofore used in all Ordinances, rules, regulations, deeds, contracts and writings of whatsoever nature or description shall henceforth be deemed to refer to the said Diocese of Colombo of the Ecclesiastical Province of the Church of India, Burma and Ceylon (by whatsoever name called).

3 Ordinance No. 6 of 1885 is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) by the deletion of the words " Provided that nothing be done at variance with the doctrine and discipline of the Church of England, or that will sever this diocese of Colombo from the said church, and that any alteration which shall by mistake or otherwise effect such severance as aforesaid shall be null and void " at the end of section 2 thereof ;
- (b) by the deletion of the words " , and provided that nothing be done at variance with the doctrine and discipline of the Church of England, or that will sever this diocese of Colombo from the said church ; and that any alteration which shall by mistake or otherwise effect such severance as aforesaid shall be null and void " at the end of section 8 thereof ; and
- (c) by the deletion of the words " , and provided that nothing be done at variance with the faith, doctrine and discipline of the Church of England " at the end of section 12 thereof.

4 (1) Nothing in this Ordinance shall be deemed to deprive the members of the congregations of any Churches, consisting entirely or predominantly of persons who have been accustomed to the use of the Services of the Book of Common Prayer in the English language whether in Ceylon or elsewhere of the right to the Services of the Book of Common Prayer in use at the commencement of this Ordinance as authorised by the Church of England subject to such modifications as from time to time have been allowed by lawful authority for the more convenient use of the said Book in this Island.

(2) Any members of a congregation who are not a majority of the congregation and who have been accustomed to the use of the Services of the Book of Common Prayer in the English language may request the Bishop of the Diocese to have certain services provided at which the Book of Common Prayer shall be used, and if the Bishop considers it necessary he shall make special provision accordingly.

(3) If the predominant part of any congregation which worships in a Church erected after the commencement of this Ordinance desires the use of the Services of the Book of Common Prayer, such Services, as authorised for use at the commencement of this Ordinance, shall be said and used therein, subject to such modifications as aforesaid.

5 Nothing in this Ordinance shall prejudice or affect the rights of His Majesty the King, His Heirs and Successors, or of any body politic or corporate, or of any other persons except such as are mentioned in this Ordinance, and those claiming by, from or under them.

Objects and Reasons.

It is the desire of the Church of England in Ceylon, as expressed in a resolution passed at its Synod on September 21, 1927, that the necessary steps be taken to enable it to free itself from the restrictions imposed by Ordinance No. 6 of 1885 or by any other Ordinance which may stand in the way of its joining the Church of the Ecclesiastical Province of India and Burma after the severance of the legal connection of the latter with the Church of England.

2 At the time that the Church of England in India addressed the Imperial Parliament with a view to securing its freedom from the Church of England, it was required by the Colonial Office that all reference should be omitted to the Church of England in Ceylon in the Indian Church Act 1927, and the Indian Church Measure 1927, because the legal bond between the Church of England in England and the Church of England in Ceylon is now constituted by Ordinances of the Legislature of Ceylon, and it is contrary to constitutional precedent that such Ordinances should be repealed by the Imperial Parliament; they ought to be repealed, if at all, by the Ceylon Legislature itself. The freedom which the Church in India seeks from the Imperial Parliament must be sought for the Church in Ceylon from the Ceylon Legislature.

3. The main object of this Bill is to enable the Diocese of Colombo to retain its connection with the Ecclesiastical Province of the Church of England in India, and for that purpose to sever what legal connection it has with the Church of England in England. This object and the reasons for it are set out in the preamble to the Bill. The object is sought to be attained (a) by the enactment in clause 2 of the Bill regarding the interpretation of terms in Ordinances and documents, and (b) by the repeal in clause 3 of certain portions of Ordinance No. 6 of 1885 in which express mention is made of the legal connection between the Church of England in Ceylon and the Church of England in England.

4. One of the conditions on which freedom was granted to the Church in India by the Indian Church Act and the Indian Church Measure was that the Church in India should provide for the demand on the part of the English residents in India of the right to continue to use in their services the Book of Common Prayer of the Church of England. This condition was fulfilled by a special provision that that right should be allowed in churches which are known in India as Maintained Churches. There are no such churches in Ceylon; hence provision is sought to be made to meet the needs of English residents in Ceylon in clause 4 of the Bill.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 19 of 1929.

An Ordinance to provide for the extension of the term of office of the Councillors of the Colombo Municipal Council.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Colombo Municipal Council (Extension of Office) Ordinance, 1929.

Power to extend term of office of the Colombo Municipal Council.
No. 6 of 1910,

2. (1) Notwithstanding anything in the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, it shall be lawful for the Governor in Council, if for any reason he deems it expedient to do so, by proclamation published in the Gazette at any time before the 31st day of December, 1929, to declare that the term of office of the Councillors of the Municipal Council of Colombo, who are in office at the time when such proclamation is so published shall be extended until, and shall expire on, a day to be specified in the proclamation, such day being not later than two years after the 31st day of December, 1929.

(2) Any such proclamation may be revoked, at any time before the day specified therein, by order of the Governor in Council published in the Gazette, if Councillors have been duly elected in accordance with the provisions of any Ordinance other than the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, in succession to the Councillors referred to in the proclamation: Provided that, upon the coming into office of any such Councillors so elected as aforesaid, the proclamation shall be deemed to be revoked.

(3) Until the expiry or revocation of any such proclamation, the Councillors whose term of office is thereby extended shall continue to be subject to the provisions of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, and to administer the affairs of the Municipality in accordance with those provisions; and any vacancies in their number may be filled in the manner provided by that Ordinance.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 20 of 1929.

An Ordinance to authorize the issue of Cash Certificates by the Postmaster-General on behalf of the Government of Ceylon.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Post Office Cash Certificates Ordinance, 1929, and shall come into operation on such date as may be appointed by the Governor by Proclamation in the Gazette.

Short title.

2 In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires,—

Interpretation.

(1) (a) "Cash certificate" means a certificate which is issued under this Ordinance by the Postmaster-General on behalf of the Government to any person on payment of a sum of money therefor, and under which such person, by virtue of the said payment, becomes entitled, on surrender of the certificate at any time, to receive its surrender value at that time.

(b) "The Local Loans and Development Commissioners" means the Board of Commissioners appointed under section 2 of the Local Loans and Development Ordinance, No. 22 of 1916

(c) "Prescribed" means prescribed by regulations made under this Ordinance.

(d) "The Fund" means the Cash Certificates Fund.

(2) In relation to a cash certificate,—

- (a) "Purchase price" means the sum of money paid or to be paid for a cash certificate at the time of its issue.
- (b) "Purchaser" means the person to whom a cash certificate is issued by the Postmaster-General on payment of the purchase price.
- (c) "Surrender value" means the prescribed sum of money which the purchaser of a cash certificate is entitled to receive on surrendering it at any time.

Issue of cash certificates.

3 (1) The Governor, whenever authorized thereto by a resolution of the Legislative Council, may direct the Postmaster-General to borrow sums, not exceeding the amount specified in such resolution, by the issue of cash certificates.

(2) The Postmaster-General may also, when so directed by the Governor, borrow by the issue of cash certificates, such sums as may be required for the purpose of meeting current demands for the surrender values of cash certificates already lawfully issued by him.

Surrender values of cash certificate charged upon general revenue.

4 The surrender values of cash certificates lawfully issued are hereby charged upon, and shall be payable out of, the general revenue and assets of the Colony.

Particulars to be entered on cash certificates.

5 The name of the purchaser, the purchase price, and the surrender values of every cash certificate shall be written or printed thereon at the time of issue.

Regulations.

6 The Governor in Council may make regulations for all or any of the following matters :—

- (a) the denominations in which cash certificates may be issued ;
- (b) the forms, the purchase prices, and the surrender values of cash certificates ;
- (c) the places at which cash certificates may be issued and surrendered, and the procedure to be adopted in connection with their issue and surrender ;
- (d) the maximum amount for which cash certificates may be held by any one person ;
- (e) the terms and conditions on which a cash certificate may be transferred to a person other than the purchaser ;
- (f) the terms and conditions on which, and the person or persons to whom, the surrender value of a cash certificate may be paid on the death of the purchaser ; and
- (g) every other matter which may be necessary for carrying out the provisions of this Ordinance, or which may or is to be prescribed.

All regulations made under this section shall be laid, as soon as conveniently may be, on the table of the Legislative Council at two successive meetings of the Council, and shall be brought before the Council at the next subsequent meeting held thereafter by a motion that the said regulations shall not be disapproved, and if upon the introduction of any such motion, or upon any adjournment thereof, the said regulations are disapproved by the Council, such regulations shall be deemed to be rescinded as from the date of such disapproval, but without prejudice to anything already done thereunder ; and such regulations, if not so disapproved, shall continue to be of full force and effect. Every such disapproval shall be published in the Gazette.

Payments into and out of the Cash Certificates Fund.

7 (1) Every payment made to the Postmaster-General by the purchaser of a cash certificate on the issue thereof shall be paid by the Postmaster-General, as soon as possible after the receipt of such payment, into a fund to be called "The Cash Certificates Fund".

(2) The Fund shall be kept by the Colonial Treasurer who shall be the trustee thereof.

8 (1) The Colonial Treasurer shall retain in his custody in such bank or banks as he may think fit such portion of the Fund as is in his opinion required for the purpose of meeting current demands for the surrender values of cash certificates already issued and shall from time to time issue to the Postmaster-General on his request such sums as may be necessary for that purpose.

(2) The Colonial Treasurer may employ the balance of the Fund for such of the following purposes as the Governor may direct :—

(a) Loans of such amounts and on such terms and conditions as to repayment and interest as the Governor in Council may approve, to—

(i) The Local Loans and Development Commissioners subject to the provisions of section 9 ; and

(ii) the Municipal Council of Colombo for any purpose for which, and subject to the conditions on which, the said Council is by law entitled to borrow money.

(b) Loans, on such terms and conditions as may be approved by the Legislative Council, to the Government of Ceylon for expenditure on such public works of development and utility as the Governor, with the approval of the Secretary of State for the Colonies and the Legislative Council, may have authorized to be carried out with borrowed money, including loans to repay any such expenditure already incurred out of general revenue or surplus balances in anticipation of the raising of loan funds.

(c) Investments in bonds or debentures issued by—

(i) any Land or Mortgage Bank over which the Governor exercises control ; and

(ii) any central bank within the meaning of the Co-operative Societies Ordinance, No. 34 of 1921.

(d) Deposits for fixed periods not exceeding one year in any bank in Ceylon approved by the Governor in Council.

9 The Local Loans and Development Commissioners are hereby empowered to receive such loans as are referred to in section 8 (2) (a) (i) of this Ordinance, and every such loan shall be deemed to be a sum appropriated to the Local Loans and Development Fund by Ordinance, and shall, together with the interest due thereon, be repaid out of that fund.

10 (1) As soon as possible after the 30th day of September in each year, the Colonial Treasurer shall furnish to the Colonial Auditor a statement of account showing—

Annual

(a) all sums paid into, or issued from, the Fund under sections 7 or 8 (1) during the year ending on that date;

(b) the income of the Fund derived from interest earned on loans, investments or deposits under section 8 (2) during the said year ;

(c) the liabilities and assets of the Fund on the said date ; and

(d) such other information as may be necessary to set forth the financial results of the said year.

(2) Every such statement shall be published in the Gazette with a certificate by the Colonial Auditor as to its accuracy and completeness.

An Ordinance to amend the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910.

H. J. STANLEY.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Councils Amendment Ordinance, 1929.

Amendment of sections 96 to 101 of the principal Ordinance.
Budget.

2 Sections 96 to 101, both inclusive, of the principal Ordinance are hereby repealed and the following sections are substituted therefor :—

96 After consultation with the several standing committees, the Chairman shall, on a date to be fixed by him in each year, submit to the Council a budget containing an estimate of the available Municipal income and details of the proposed expenditure for the ensuing financial year.

Budget to be circulated and open to inspection.

97 Every budget shall—

- (1) be circulated among the Councillors at least seven days prior to the date referred to in section 96; and
- (2) be open to inspection at the Municipal Office or elsewhere for seven days prior to the said date and notice thereof shall be given in the *Government Gazette* and in two or more of the local newspapers.

Final consideration of budget.

98 The Council shall finally consider the budget at a special meeting to be called in the last month of the financial year.

Supplemental budget.

99 (1) The Chairman may at any time prepare a supplemental budget and lay it before the Council.

(2) Every supplemental budget shall—

- (a) be circulated among the Councillors at least seven days prior to the meeting of the Council before which it is laid; and
- (b) be open to public inspection at the Municipal Office or elsewhere for seven days prior to the said meeting and notice thereof shall be given in the *Government Gazette* and in two or more of the local newspapers.

Powers of Council with regard to budget and supplemental budget.
Reduction or increase of expenditure.

100 It shall be in the discretion of the Council to pass, modify, or reject all or any of the items in any budget or supplemental budget, or to add any item thereto.

101 The Council may in case of necessity during the year reduce or increase the expenditure under any head of the budget or of any supplemental budget, or may transfer the moneys assigned under one head of expenditure to another head: Provided that the total amount of expenditure sanctioned by the budget or by any supplemental budget passed by the Council shall not be exceeded.

Amendment of sections 109 and 185 of the principal Ordinance.

3 Sections 109 (3) and 185 (1) of the principal Ordinance are hereby amended by the deletion of the words "in the English, Sinhalese, and Tamil languages" where those words occur in each of the said sections.

Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 22 of 1929.

An Ordinance to amend the Motor Car Ordinance, 1927. No. 20 of 1927

H. J. STANLEY.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Motor Car Amendment Ordinance, 1929. Short title.

Amendment of section 2 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 2 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:—

(1) by the addition of the words "and includes a tractor" at the end of the definition of "Lorry" contained therein;

(2) by the insertion of the following definition immediately after the definition of "Lorry" contained therein:—

"Tractor" means a motor car constructed solely for hauling another vehicle, and not for carrying passengers or goods.;

(3) by the insertion of the following definition immediately after the definition of "Licensing authority" contained therein:—

"Register" means the register of motor cars kept under this Ordinance.

Amendment of section 4 (4) of the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 4 (4) of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "or of any particular motor car" between the word "cars" and the word "in" in the first line of paragraph (a) thereof, and by the insertion of the word "measurements," between the word "the" and the word "dimensions" in the second line of the said paragraph.

Amendment of section 7 of the principal Ordinance.

4 Section 7 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "The number of passengers which an omnibus is licensed to carry shall also be painted in similar letters in a conspicuous position in the interior of the omnibus." immediately after the word "height." in the eighth line thereof.

Insertion of new section 7A in the principal Ordinance.

5 The following section shall be inserted immediately after section 7 of the principal Ordinance:—

General condition.

7A No motor car shall be driven on any highway unless it is in all respects in such a condition as not to cause, or to be likely to cause, danger to any person therein or to any person using the highway at the time, or to any property on or adjoining the highway.

Amendment of section 10 (1) of the principal Ordinance.

6 Section 10 (1) of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:—

(1) by the substitution of the words "two brakes independently controlled," for the words "two independent brakes" in the second line thereof;

(2) by the deletion of the words "to the motor car" in the fourth line thereof; and

(3) by the insertion of the following proviso at the end thereof:—

"Provided also that a motor car fitted with hydraulic brakes shall also be fitted with an independent emergency brake."

Amendment of section 13 of the principal Ordinance.

7 Section 13 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "on the off or right side of the car" in the third line thereof.

Amendment of section 14 (7) of the principal Ordinance.

8 Section 14 (7) of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "All lamps referred to in sub-sections (1) to (6), both inclusive," for the words "All lamps" in the first line thereof.

Amendment of section 18 of the principal Ordinance.

9 Section 18 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:—

(1) by the insertion of the words "in any case where no person has been registered as the owner thereof" between the word "sale" and the word "shall" in the tenth line of sub-section (2) thereof; and

(2) by the repeal of sub-section (3) thereof, and the substitution of the following sub-section therefor :—

(3) (a) Where the person entitled to the possession of a motor car is not the absolute owner thereof, but is registered as the owner thereof, any person claiming to be the absolute owner thereof (hereinafter called "the claimant") may apply to the registrar to enter his name in the register as the absolute owner in addition to the name of the registered owner.

(b) On receipt of any such application, the registrar shall cause the registered owner to be informed thereof by registered post, and shall call on him to show cause within seven days why the name of the claimant should not be so entered in the register.

(c) If the registered owner agrees that the name of the claimant should be so entered in the register, or if he fails to show cause within the said seven days why the said name should not be so entered, the registrar shall enter the name of the claimant in the register accordingly, and he shall be deemed to be the absolute owner.

(d) If the registered owner proceeds to show cause, the registrar shall inquire into the circumstances, and shall make such order thereon as he may think fit, and any person whose name is, as the result of the inquiry, entered in the register by the registrar as the absolute owner of the motor car shall be deemed to be the absolute owner.

(e) The absolute owner of a motor car, whose name has been entered in the register under the provisions of this section, shall, on ceasing to be the absolute owner thereof, require the registrar to remove his name from the register, and the registrar shall comply with such requisition on receiving the same.

(f) The registrar may also, if he is satisfied that the absolute owner of a motor car has ceased to be the absolute owner thereof, remove the name of such absolute owner, on being requested to do so by the registered owner.

(g) No proceedings, civil or criminal, shall be instituted against the registrar for anything *bona fide* done or omitted to be done in the exercise of his powers under this sub-section.

10 Section 20 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

(1) by the insertion of the words "or that it does not comply with the requirements of this Ordinance or any of the regulations made thereunder," immediately after the word "altered" in the fourth line of sub-section (1) thereof ;

(2) by the insertion of the words "in writing" immediately after the word "registrar" in the second line of sub-section (2) thereof ; and

(3) by the insertion of the following words at the end of sub-section (2) thereof :—

"and shall at the same time forward or deliver to the registrar the certificate of registration of the motor car for amendment and return".

Amendment of section 20 of the principal Ordinance.

11 Section 22 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

(1) by the substitution of the word "unless" for the word "until" in the fourth line of sub-section (1) thereof ;

(2) by the repeal of sub-section (4) thereof and the substitution of the following sub-section therefor :—

(4) On the death of the registered owner of a motor car, the person into whose custody the motor car shall come shall within seven days of its coming into his custody give notice of the fact to the registrar who shall give such instructions as he may think fit, in writing, as to the use of the motor car pending the registration of the new owner. Any person to whom permission to use the motor car pending such registration is given by the registrar shall for the purposes of this Ordinance be deemed to be the registered owner during the period for which such permission is given. ;

Amendment of section 22 of the principal Ordinance.

(3) by the addition of the following sub-section at the end thereof :—

(6) Sub-sections (1), (2), (3), and (4) shall not apply to any change of possession of a motor car which occurs by reason of the car being lawfully seized under a hire purchase agreement, but in any such circumstances the following provisions shall apply :—

- (a) The registered owner or his representative shall, within seven days of the seizure, deliver the motor car licence and the certificate of registration to the person who has seized the motor car and inform the registrar in writing of the change of possession.
- (b) Such person shall, within seven days of receiving the motor car licence and the certificate of registration, apply to the registrar to be registered as the owner thereof in place of the registered owner and shall on payment of the prescribed fee be registered accordingly unless the registrar thinks fit to order otherwise.
- (c) The registrar shall, if he is satisfied that any such person, whose name has been entered in the register under section 18 (3) as the absolute owner of the motor car, is unable within seven days of the seizure to procure the motor car licence and the certificate of registration from the registered owner or his representative, supply such person on request and on payment of the fees prescribed in the Second Schedule, with duplicates of the said licence and certificate, and such person shall thereafter cease to be the absolute owner and shall be deemed to be the registered owner, and the registrar shall accept his signature as such, until the next change of possession is effected.

Amendment of section 25 of the principal Ordinance.

12 Section 25 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following proviso at the end thereof :—

Provided that it shall be a good defence for the registered owner to prove that the motor car was, at the time of any alleged offence, in the possession of the absolute owner registered under the provisions of section 18 (3), and in any such case, if the court, after hearing the absolute owner or his representative, orders that the absolute owner shall be deemed to be the owner, the proceedings shall continue against the absolute owner as if he were the owner.

Amendment of section 28 of the principal Ordinance.

13 Section 28 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the addition of the following sub-section at the end thereof :—

(12) In the case of the plate required by section 27 (1) (b) (i.) to be fixed on the front elevation or the front mudguard of a motor cycle, the dimensions of the spaces, margins, letters and figures may be half those specified in sub-sections (2), (3), (8), and (9) of this section.

Amendment of section 30 (2) of the principal Ordinance.

14 Section 30 (2) of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "licensing authority" for the word "registrar" in the second and in the fifth lines thereof.

Amendment of section 32 (4) of the principal Ordinance.

15 Section 32 (4) of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the words "the annual duty payable" for the words "the duty paid" in the third and fourth lines thereof.

Insertion of new section 35A in the principal Ordinance.

16 The following section shall be inserted in the principal Ordinance immediately after section 35 thereof :—

Temporary licences.

35 A (1) Notwithstanding anything in this Ordinance contained, it shall be lawful for the registrar to issue a temporary licence to any person to possess or use a motor car without registering the motor car, for any period not exceeding three months, when it is shown to his satisfaction that the motor car has been imported into the Island for the purpose of being used by the owner during a visit to the Island.

(2) Any such temporary licence may be issued, in the case of motor cars imported at Talaimannar, by the Government Agent of the Northern Province, or the Assistant Government Agent at Mannar, or the Sub-Collector of Customs at Talaimannar, and a copy of the licence shall be forwarded to the registrar.

(3) The fee for any such licence shall be at the rate specified in the Second Schedule, and shall be credited to general revenue.

17 Section 36 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the repeal of sub-section (2) thereof and the substitution of the following sub-section therefor :—

Amendment of section 36 of the principal Ordinance.

(2) The motor car licence shall be carried on the front part of the motor car in a weather-proof holder having a transparent face and placed in a conspicuous position on the left or near side of the motor car, so that the front of the licence shall be clearly visible at all times by daylight to a person standing in front of the motor car on the left or near side thereof.

18 Section 37 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :—

Amendment of section 37 of the principal Ordinance.

(1) by the substitution of the words " class or classes " for the word " class " in the third line of sub-section (8) thereof ;

(2) by the insertion of the following sub-section immediately after sub-section (9) thereof :—

(9A) Where the applicant for a certificate of competence passes a driving test—

(a) on an omnibus, any certificate granted to him shall be valid for all classes of motor car except motor cycles and steam-driven motor cars,

(b) on a lorry, any certificate granted to him shall be valid for all classes of motor car except motor cycles, omnibuses, and steam-driven motor cars,

and the certificate shall in either case be endorsed accordingly. ;

(3) by the addition of the following sub-sections at the end thereof :—

(17) Notwithstanding anything in this Ordinance contained, it shall be lawful for the registrar to grant a temporary certificate of competence to any applicant for the same, with or without a driving test, when it is shown to his satisfaction that the applicant is a *bona fide* visitor to the Island for a period not exceeding three months.

(18) Any such certificate may be granted, in the case of any applicant entering the Island at Talaimannar, by the Government Agent of the Northern Province, or the Assistant Government Agent at Mannar, or the Sub-Collector of Customs at Talaimannar, and a copy of the certificate shall be forwarded to the registrar.

(19) The fee for any such certificate shall be at the rate specified in the Second Schedule and shall be credited to general revenue, and the applicant shall not be required to supply photographs on application for the same.

19 Section 38 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the substitution of the words " for so long as the certificate is valid in the country in which it was granted, but not in any case for any period exceeding one year in this Island " for the words " so long as the certificate is valid in the country in which it was granted " in the fifth and sixth lines thereof.

Amendment of section 38 of the principal Ordinance.

20 Section 39 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the repeal of sub-section (2) thereof and the substitution of the following sub-section therefor :—

Amendment of section 39 of the principal Ordinance.

(2) Every person who is prosecuted before any court for any such offence as is referred to in sub-section (1) shall, if he holds a certificate of competence, take the certificate to court with him ; and, if upon such prosecution he is convicted, shall forthwith produce the certificate to the court for the purpose of endorsement.

Amendment of section 42 of the principal Ordinance.

21 Section 42 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:—

(1) by the insertion of the words "issued under this Ordinance" immediately after the words "certificate of competence" in the fifth line of sub-section (1) thereof; and

(5) Every person whose driving licence has been endorsed or cancelled, or suspended for any stated period or time, shall be guilty of an offence if he applies for or obtains a certificate of competence under this Ordinance without giving particulars of such endorsement, cancellation, or suspension, as the case may be, and any certificate so obtained shall be of no effect.

(6) The registrar may refuse to grant a certificate of competence—

(a) to any person who has been refused a driving licence, or whose driving licence has been cancelled; or

(b) to any person whose driving licence has been suspended, or who has been disqualified from obtaining a driving licence, for the period of such suspension or disqualification.

Insertion of new section 42A in the principal Ordinance.

42A Whenever any court—

(1) under section 37 (16), cancels the endorsement on a certificate of competence; or

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Amendment Ordinance, 1929.

Amendment of
section 8 of
the principal
Ordinance.

2 Section 8 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:—

(1) by the substitution of the words "any animals or vehicles" for the words "horses, mules, bullocks, trucks, carts, sledges, or other carriages" in the second and third lines of paragraph (2) thereof;

(2) by the insertion of the words "or property within the customs premises" immediately after the word "goods" in paragraph (3) thereof;

(3) by the insertion of the following two paragraphs immediately after paragraph (3) thereof :—

“(4) For prohibiting or regulating the admission of persons to the customs premises, and for excluding persons therefrom ; and

(5) For regulating the conduct of persons within the customs premises ;”

and

(4) by the deletion of the words “ and be liable to a fine not exceeding five pounds ” in the last two lines thereof, and the substitution of the following words therefor :—

“ and shall be liable to forfeit a sum not exceeding fifty rupees, or, on summary trial and conviction by a Police Magistrate, to a fine not exceeding fifty rupees or to imprisonment of either description for any term not exceeding three months or to both such fine and imprisonment.

In this section and in any regulation made thereunder, “ customs premises ” means the customs premises as defined from time to time by the Principal Collector of Customs by notification in the *Government Gazette* ”.
