THIS matter coming on for disposal before P. Saravanamuttu, Esq., District Judge, Kegalla, on October 24, 1929, in the presence of Mr. D. S. Crispeyn, Proctor, on the part of the petitioner ; and his affidavit and petition dated September 24 and October, 1929, respectively, having been read :

It is ordered and declared that the 4th respondent above named, as the mother of the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd respondents, minors above named, is a fit and proper person to be appointed their guardian *ad litem*, and that such appointment will be made accordingly, and that the petitioner above named, as the eldest son of the deceased aforesaid, is entitled to have letters of administration issued to him, and that such letters will be issued to him accordingly, unless the respondents above named or any other person or persons interested in the matter shall on December 11, 1929, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary.
