The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :---

An Ordinance to amend the Local Loans and Development Ordinance, No. 22 of 1916.

Amendment of section 8 of the principal Ordinance.

III. 932

2 Section 8 of the principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the repeal of paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) thereof and by the substitution of the following paragraph therefor :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Loans and Development Amendment Ordinance, 1930.

"(b) To any society registered under the Co-operative Societies Ordinance, No. 34 of 1921, for any purpose of the society."

Objects and Reasons.

SECTION 8 (1) (b) of the Local Loans and Development Ordinance, No. 22 of 1916, permits the Commissioners under that Ordinance to make loans to certain types of co-operative societies only, viz., to co-operative credit agricultural or industrial societies. At the time when this Ordinance was passed the only co-operative societies which could be registered were credit societies, registration being then governed by the Co-operative Credit Societies Ordinance, 1911 (No. 7 of 1911). At a later date, Ordinance No. 7 of 1911 was repealed by the Co-operative Societies, but section 8 (1) (b) of the Local Loans and Development Ordinance was not similarly extended. The result has been that, although societies for such purposes as co-operative supply, marketing and sale, building and village improvement can now be registered, none of these societies are able to borrow from the Local Loans and Development Fund.

It is proposed, therefore, in this Bill to amend section S(1)(b) of the Local Loans and Development Ordinance so as to permit loans to be made from the fund to any society registered under the Co-operative Societies Ordinance of 1921.

And it is further ordered and declared that the last will of Gregory de Jansz Abeyesekera, deceased, of which the original has been produced and is now deposited in court, be and the same is hereby declared proved, and that the petitioner is the executrix named in the said will, and that she is entitled to have probate thereof issued to her accordingly, unless the respondents above named or any other person or persons interested in the matter shall, on January 30, 1930, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary.
