Wallooppillai & Goonesekere, Proctors on the part of the petitioner, Kitulgasgamarally & Kiriappuhamy of Udagama; and the affidity of the table petitioner dated September 4, 1929, having been ead: It is ordered and decreed that Ahuliyadde Lekamalaye Kirimenike be appointed guardian ad litem over the minor respondents—(2) guardian ad litem over the minor respondents—(2) Kitulgasgafaarallaye Heenmenike, (3) ditto Appuhamy, (4) ditto Podimenike, (5) ditto Jayewardene, and (6) ditto Dingirimenike, all of Udagama—unless the respondents or any person or persons interested shall, on or before January 13, 1930, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary.

It is further ordered that the said petitioner is the son of the above-named deceased, and that he is entitled to have letters of administration to the estate of the said deceased issued to him accordingly, unless Kitulgasgamarallaye Lokumenike and the above-named respondefits of any other person or persons interested shall, on on before January 13, 1930, show sufficient cause to the satisfaction of this court to the contrary.
