## PRELIMINARY NOTICES.

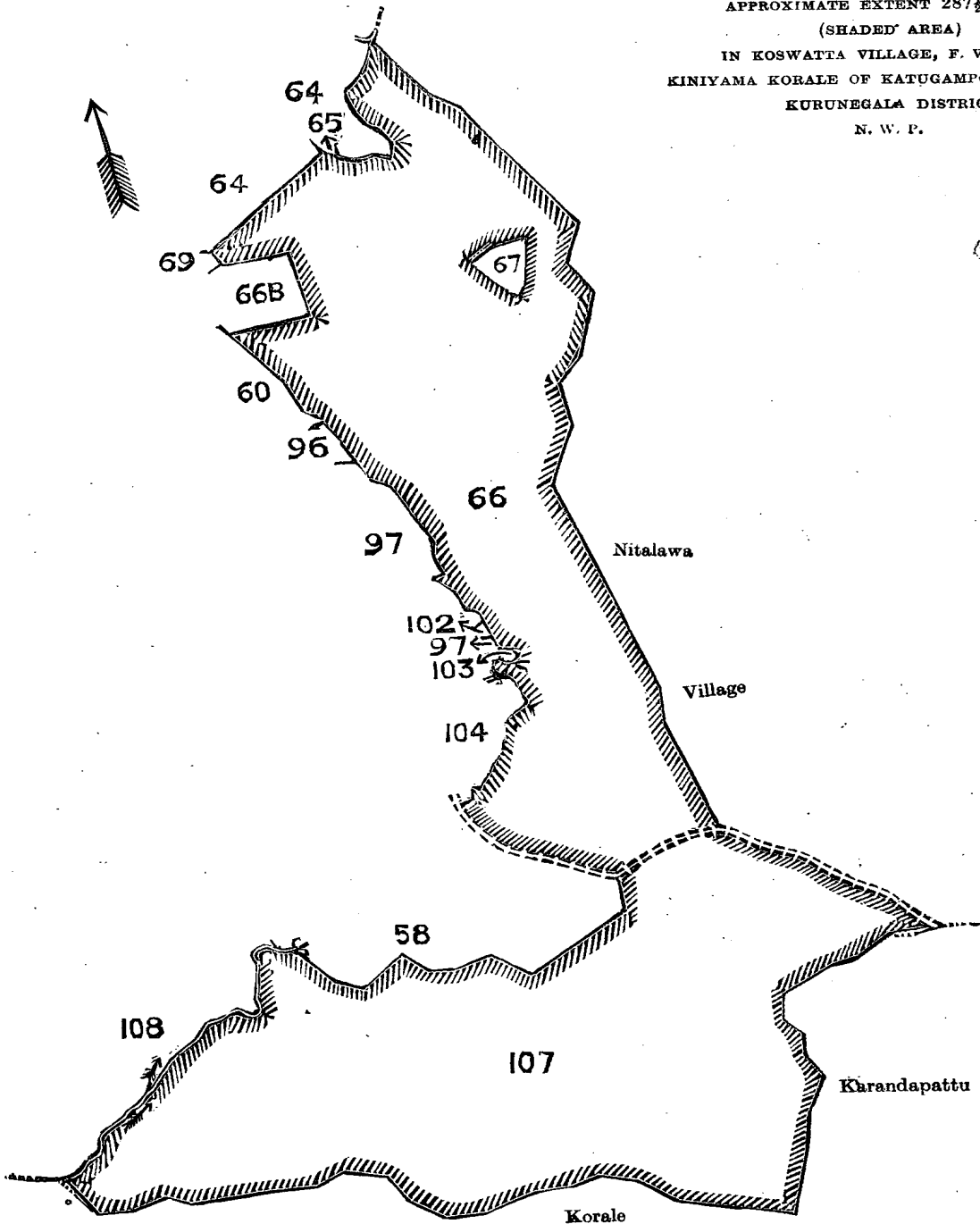
