### Colombo S. O. No. 137.

#### Order under Section 2 of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927," declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Agarakumbura, situate in the village of Galgomuwa, in the Meda pattuwa of Siyane korale west of the Colombo District, in the Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Kongahamulahena, situate in the village of Kelegedera, in the Karandapattu korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."
