MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to prevent the circulation of seditious or offensive printed matter likely to provoke a breach of the peace.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Circulation of Provocative Printed Matter Ordinance, 1930.

2 The Ceylon Penal Code is amended by the addition of the following new section 157A immediately after section 157 :—

Dissemination of printed matter likely to provoke offence against State or public tranquility.

157A Whoever sells, distributes or wilfully exhibits to public view any printed matter which is likely to cause alarm or annoyance to the public or any section of the public and thereby induce any person to commit an offence against the State or an offence against the public tranquility shall be punished with imprisonment of either description for a term which may extend to one year or with fine or with both.

3 The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898, is amended as follows :—

(1) Section 119 is deleted and the following is substituted therefor :—

Search for false weights and measures and seditious and defamatory printed matter.

119. Any Peace Officer not below the rank of Sergeant, Korala, Muhandiram or Udaiyar may for the purpose of inspection and search enter without a warrant any place in which he has reason to believe there are either (a) any weights, measures or instruments for weighing which are false, or (b) any printed matter which is about to be used for the commission of an offence under section 157A of the Penal Code; and if he finds in such place any such weights, measures, instruments or printed matter he may seize them and shall forthwith give information of the seizure to the Police Magistrate having jurisdiction.

(2) In Schedule II the following additions are made in each of the columns immediately after the words and figures therein which refer to section 157 of the Ceylon Penal Code :—

(a) In column 1 the figure " 157A ".

(b) In column 2 the words " Dissemination of printed matter likely to provoke offence against State or public tranquility ".

(c) In column 3 the word " Same ".

(d) In column 4 the word " Warrant ".

(e) In column 5 the word " Same ".

(f) In column 6 the word " Same ".

(g) In column 7 the words " Imprisonment of either description for one year or fine or both ".

(h) In column 8 the words " District Court. Police Court ".

Objects and Reasons.

Though printed matter that is likely to induce the commission of an offence against the State or against the public peace is most advantageously dealt with before publication than after, the law at present does not authorize the prompt action that is sometimes necessary to prevent its publication. This Bill is designed to supplement the powers of the courts and the police in their endeavour to prevent such printed matter getting into circulation.

Clause 2 of the Bill by an amendment of the Penal Code makes the circulation or public exhibition of such printed matter a new offence which clause 3 (2) (c) makes cognizable, by an amendment to the Criminal Procedure Code. And a further amendment to the Criminal Procedure Code introduced by clause 3 (1) by elaborating section 119 permits a peace officer to enter any place on suspicion and to search for and seize such printed matter without a warrant when the commission of the new offence seems imminent. Besides, the Bill makes the new offence punishable with imprisonment or fine or both, bailable, non-compoundable, and triable by either a Police Court or a District Court.

MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend the Local Government Ordinance, No. 11 of 1920.

III. 726.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Government Amendment Ordinance, 1930.

Short title.

2 Section 175 of the principal Ordinance is amended by the addition of the following new sub-section (8) at the end thereof :—

Amendment of section 175 of the principal Ordinance.

(8) When any vehicle or animal is ordinarily liable both to the tax imposed under section 173 and the tax imposed under section 127 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, the said vehicle or animal shall be liable to only one such tax which shall be payable (a) to the District Council or Municipality within whose limits it is principally kept if the vehicle or animal is kept within the limits of a District Council or Municipality or (b) to the District Council or Municipality within whose administrative limits it is principally used if the vehicle or animal is not kept within the limits of a District Council or Municipality.

Objects and Reasons.

The terms in which section 173 of the Local Government Ordinance, No. 11 of 1920, and section 127 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910, empower the local authorities established under these Ordinances to impose and recover taxes on vehicles and animals permit of taxes under each of these sections being recovered in respect of a vehicle or animal that happens to be used within the limits of both a District Council and a Municipality. Sub-section (7) of section 173 of the former Ordinance already provides against such double taxation where a vehicle or animal is used within the limits of more than one District Council. The new sub-section now introduced is designed to prevent similar double taxation in the case of vehicles and animals which are used within the limits of a District Council and the limits of a Municipality.

An Ordinance to amend The Vagrancy Ordinance, 1907.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Vagrancy Amendment Ordinance, 1930.

Amendment of section 4 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 4 (2) of the principal Ordinance is amended by the substitution of the words " he avails himself of suitable employment " for the words " work has been ".

Amendment of section 7 of the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 7 of the principal Ordinance is amended by—
(a) the deletion of the figure " (1) " in sub-section (1);
and
(b) the deletion of sub-section (2).

Amendment of section 9 of the principal Ordinance.

4 Section 9 (1) of the principal Ordinance is amended by the substitution of the words " a vagrant who is not a British subject born in Ceylon has refused or neglected either to avail himself of suitable employment found for him or to enter " for the words " no suitable employment is obtainable for a vagrant detained in the house of detention, and such vagrant, not being a British subject born in Ceylon, has not entered ".

Objects and Reasons.

Sub-section (1) of section 7 of the principal Ordinance requires the superintendent of a house for the detention of vagrants to find when possible suitable employment outside the house for those detained there, and sub-section (2) makes it possible to impose a sentence of imprisonment on any person so detained who refuses or neglects to avail himself of such work. On instructions issued by the Secretary of State as a result of representations made against similar legislation at the Twelfth International Labour Conference held at Geneva in 1929, clause 3 (b) of this bill abolishes this right to imprison those who refuse to work outside the house of detention. The other clauses of the bill introduce the necessary amendments consequent on the said abolition.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend the Poisons, Opium, and Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1929.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Poisons, Opium, and Dangerous Drugs Amendment Ordinance, 1930.

2 Section 47 (2) of the principal Ordinance is amended by inserting the words “(a) to import on behalf of any medical practitioner, dentist, veterinary surgeon, pharmacist or wholesale druggist, and (b)” between the word “Director” and the word “to” in line 2 thereof.

Objects and Reasons.

To control the introduction of “dangerous drugs” into Ceylon, the right to import them is at present vested solely in the Director of Medical and Sanitary Services, who is apparently expected to purchase on behalf of Government and stock for sale or distribution such quantities of the drugs as are likely to be needed in the Island for “medical, dental, veterinary or scientific purposes”. This system while it imposes duties of rather an onerous character on the Director and is not free from the possibility of involving Government in losses owing to the deterioration of the drugs, does not sufficiently ensure to medical practitioners and others the local availability of the drugs at all times. By virtue of the amendment introduced by this Ordinance and suitable additions to the regulations in Part II of the Third Schedule to the principal Ordinance, it is proposed in future to enable medical practitioners, dentists, veterinary surgeons, pharmacists and wholesale druggists to import such drugs through the Director but at their own expense and risk, and thereby make it possible for the Director to confine his import of these drugs to such quantities as are required for the purposes of Government.

An Ordinance to amend the Civil Procedure Code, 1889. 2 of 1889,

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Civil Procedure Code Amendment Ordinance, 1930. Short title.

2 Section 189 of the principal Ordinance is repealed and the following is substituted therefor :—
Amendment of section 189 of the principal Ordinance.

189 (1) The court may at any time, either on its own motion or on that of any of the parties, correct any clerical or arithmetical mistake in any judgment or order or any error arising therein from any accidental slip or omission, or may make any amendment which is necessary to bring a decree into conformity with the judgment. Amendment of judgments, decrees and orders.

(2) Reasonable notice of any proposed amendment under this section shall in all cases be given to the parties or their proctors.

Objects and Reasons.

Section 189 of the Civil Procedure Code, 1889, is not sufficiently wide in its present form to authorize the judge of an original court to make all the formal amendments in his judgments, orders and decrees that are sometimes necessary; and as a result such matters have to be brought up before the Supreme Court for rectification. By widening the powers of the original court judge in this respect this amendment is designed to avoid the necessity for such appeals.

**An Ordinance to amend the Colombo Municipal
Waterworks Ordinance, 1907.**

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title and
commencement.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Colombo Municipal Waterworks Amendment Ordinance, 1930, and shall come into operation on such date as the Governor may, by proclamation published in the Gazette, appoint.

Repeal of section 8
of the principal
Ordinance, and
substitution of
new section.

2 Section 8 of the principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and the following section is substituted therefor :—

Supply of
water to
Government.

8. The Council shall within the limits of the Municipality of Colombo provide a supply of water for the use of the Ceylon Government, which for domestic purposes shall be supplied free of charge, but for other than domestic purposes shall be supplied in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance and of any regulations made thereunder relating to the supply of water for other than domestic purposes.

Objects and Reasons.

The Waterworks originally constructed by the Government were transferred to the Municipal Council by Ordinance No. 18 of 1907 under certain financial arrangements which included the free supply of water up to 250,000 gallons per diem to the Government by section 8 of the Ordinance.

The remaining financial arrangements were concluded in 1924, by which date the Council had paid to the Government the sums agreed upon.

The general financial relations between Government and the Municipality were at that time (1924) under review and it is part of the settlement of those relations which has now been reached that the Government is entitled to the free supply of water for domestic purposes and will pay for all water supplied for other purposes.
