REGULATIONS made by the Governor in-Council under section 14 of the Betting on Horse-racing (Taxation) Ordinance, 1930.

REGULATIONS.

In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—

(1) "The Ordinance" means the Betting on Horse-racing (Taxation) Ordinance, 1930; and
(2) All words and expressions which are defined or explained in the Ordinance shall have the same meaning as is assigned to them in the Ordinance.

2. The prescribed officer referred to in the Ordinance and in these regulations shall be the Colonial Treasurer.

3. Every application for the registration of a racecourse under section 5 of the Ordinance shall be in the Form A in the Appendix to these regulations, and the fee to be paid together with such application shall be twenty-five rupees.

4. Every certificate of registration of a racecourse issued under section 5 of the Ordinance shall be in the Form B in the Appendix to these regulations.

5. The return required by section 8 (2) of the Ordinance to be forwarded by a certificate-holder shall be forwarded by him within 10 days after every race-meeting held on the registered race-course for which he holds a certificate of registration, and shall be in the Form C in the Appendix to these regulations. The amount of the totalisator tax due in respect of every such race-meeting shall be made over by the certificate-holder together with the said return, in such manner as the prescribed officer shall require.
