CODE OF REGULATIONS FOR ASSISTED ENGLISH SCHOOLS.

AMENDMENTS REFERRED TO.

Clause 15 (vi).—In line 2 alter "payable" to "paid."
Clause 30 (last para).—Alter to read as follows:—

To find the number of units of average attendance, the following procedure is adopted:—

(i.) Where the number of sessions is equal to or below the minimum prescribed by clause 15 (i.), the total number of attendances of eligible pupils is divided by the minimum number of sessions prescribed by clause 15 (i.).

(ii.) Where the number of sessions is above the minimum prescribed by clause 15 (i.), the Manager shall have the option of—

(a) dividing the total number of attendances of eligible pupils by the total number of sessions actually held during the year, or

(b) dividing the total number of attendances of eligible pupils during the best 180 sessions (in a one-session school) or 360 sessions (in a two-session school) by the minimum number of sessions prescribed by clause 15 (i.).

Clause 44.—Alter to read as follows:—

To find the number of units of average attendance, the following procedure is adopted:—

(i.) Where the number of sessions is equal to or below the minimum prescribed by clause 17 (i.), the total number of attendances of eligible pupils is divided by the minimum number of sessions prescribed by clause 17 (i.).

(ii.) Where the number of sessions is above the minimum prescribed by clause 17 (i.), the Manager shall have the option of—

(a) dividing the total number of attendances of eligible pupils by the total number of sessions actually held during the year, or

(b) dividing the total number of attendances of eligible pupils during the best 180 sessions (in a one-session school) or 360 sessions (in a two-session school) by the minimum number of sessions prescribed by clause 17 (i.).

"Council" means the Urban District Council of Kalutara.
"Chairman" means the Chairman of the Council.
"Public Stand" means any space within the administrative limits of the Council which is defined and reserved for the parking of motor cabs or omnibuses or hiring cars by a notice signed by the Chairman and exhibited at the spot.
2. No vehicle other than a motor cab or omnibus shall be parked in or enter a Public Stand.
3. When a Public Stand or any portion of a Public Stand is reserved for the use of motor cabs or omnibuses or hiring cars, no motor car not belonging to the class for which the stand is reserved shall be parked in it or enter it.
4. All motor cabs and omnibuses in a Public Stand shall be parked—
(a) in accordance with the orders of either the Police Officer on duty at the spot or the person authorized for this purpose by the Chairman, and
(b) so as to cause no obstruction to other motor cabs or omnibuses entering or leaving the Public Stand.
5. The driver of the motor cab or omnibus or a person capable of driving it shall be in charge while the motor cab or omnibus occupies a Public Stand.
6. No motor cab or omnibus shall be parked in any public place except a Public Stand; and no motor cab or omnibus shall enter or remain in a Public Stand—
(a) unless its driver is in possession of a valid permit in respect of it issued under rule 7, and
(b) unless he produces it when required to do so by a Police Officer or a person authorized for the purpose by the Chairman.
7. The Chairman may issue permits authorizing motor cabs or omnibuses to use a Public Stand and charge fees

8. The driver of a lorry shall not allow it to stand on any highway declared by regulation to be suitable for lorry traffic except—

- (a) In the event of a breakdown and then only so long as may be necessary to enable essential repairs to be effected;
- (b) For the purpose of loading or unloading goods and then only so long as may be reasonably necessary for the purpose.

9. The parking of motor cars other than motor cabs, omnibuses, or lorries, is prohibited on the following roads:—

- (a) Station road, Kalutara South.
- (b) Goods Shed road, Kalutara South.
- (c) Colombo-Galle road, Kalutara South, between the junction of Chapel street and the Station road junction, Kalutara South.
- (d) Cross road, Kalutara South.
- (e) De Silva road, Kalutara South.

VITAL STATISTICS.

Registrar-General's Report on Vital Statistics of the City of Colombo for the Week ended October 25, 1930.

Births.—The total births registered in the city of Colombo in the week were 204 (6 Burghers, 133 Sinhalese, 23 Tamils, 34 Moors, 7 Malays, and 1 Other). The birth rate per 1,000 per annum (calculated on the estimated population on July 1, 1930, viz., 270,700) was 39.3, as against 37.8 in the preceding week, 32.1 in the corresponding week of last year, and 32.5 the weekly average for last year.

Deaths.—The total deaths registered were 127 (1 European, 4 Burghers, 78 Sinhalese, 24 Tamils, 17 Moors, 1 Malay, and 2 Others). The death rate per 1,000 per annum was 24.5, as against 27.4 in the previous week, 31.0 in the corresponding week of last year, and 30.9 the weekly average for last year.

Infantile Deaths.—Of the 127 total deaths, 25 were of infants under one year of age, as against 31 in the preceding week, 26 in the corresponding week of the previous year, and 33 the average for last year.

Still births.—The number of stillbirths registered during the week was 13.

Principal Causes of Death.—1. (a) Eight deaths from *Pneumonia* were registered, 2 in Maradana hospitals (of non-residents) and 1 each in Kotahena North, Kotahena South, New Bazaar, Maradana North, Kollupitiya, and Wellawatta North, as against 16 in the previous week, and 22 the weekly average for last year.

(b) One death from *Influenza* was registered in New Bazaar, as against 6 in the previous week, and 9 the weekly average for last year.

(c) Six deaths from *Bronchitis* were registered, 3 in Maradana hospitals (including 1 death of a non-resident), 2 in Maradana North and 1 in Kotahena South, as against 3 in the previous week, and 3 the weekly average for last year.

2. (a) Fourteen deaths from *Phthisis* were registered, 6 in Maradana hospitals (including 3 deaths of non-residents), 3 each in St. Paul's and Slave Island, and 1 each in Kotahena South and Wellawatta South, as against 11 in the previous week, and 11 the weekly average for last year.

(b) Two deaths from *Phthisis* of residents of Colombo town, occurred at the Anti-Tuberculosis Hospital, Ragama, during the week.

3. One death from *Enteric Fever* was registered in Maradana hospitals, as against 3 in the previous week, and 4 the weekly average for last year.

The mean atmospheric pressure was 29.859 in., against 29.875 in., in the preceding week and 29.897 in., in the corresponding week of the previous year. The total rainfall in the week was 6.66 in. against 1.93 in. in the preceding week and 0.94 in. in the corresponding week of the previous year.
