BY-LAW REFERRED TO.

*Preaching or holding Meetings on Thoroughfares prohibited.*—No person shall preach or address any assembly or crowd or hold any meeting on any thoroughfare within the limits of the Negombo Urban District Council area, except in pursuance of a permit from the Chairman of the Urban District Council, and within the times and limits specified in such permit. "THE EXPLOSIVES ORDINANCE, 1902."

REGULATIONS made by the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, under section 7 of "The Explosives Ordinance, 1902."

REGULATIONS.

1. Gunpowder when conveyed shall be packed in barrels properly joined and hooped; other explosives, such as dynamite, gelignite, and detonators, shall be packed in cases properly joined and secured with copper or brass screws. All packages containing explosives other than gunpowder shall have brass or galvanized iron seals fixed in such a manner as effectively to secure their contents.

2. The owner, master, or agents of every ship carrying cargo any part of which consists of explosives shall, before the ship enters the Harbour, give notice in writing of the nature of such cargo to the Master Attendant and the Collector of Customs, and shall place or moor his ship in such place as the Master Attendant may direct, and while any explosive remains on board, shall not, except for the purpose of proceeding to sea, remove his ship without the written permission of the Master Attendant.

3. No boat shall be employed in the conveyance of a greater quantity of any explosive than one hundredweight, until three hours' notice shall have been given in writing by the master, owner, or agents of the vessel to the Inspector of Harbour Police, and until a Police Officer shall have boarded the boat.

4. No Explosive shall be placed on board any boat unless it is packed in the manner required by regulation No. 1.

5. No more than one hundredweight of explosive shall be loaded or unloaded until all boats, except such as are necessary for the purpose, shall have been removed to a distance of not less than 50 feet from the place of loading or unloading, and no boat except the boats aforesaid, shall come within 50 feet of such place of loading or unloading.

6. No cargo of any other description shall be taken in any boat conveying a quantity of explosive greater than one hundredweight.

7. The conveyance in the same vehicle or boat of explosive of the 5th (Fulminate) class, of the 6th (Ammunition) class containing its own means of ignition, or of the 7th (Firework) class, together with any explosive of a different class and division from its own is prohibited.

8. The owner and tindal of any boat engaged in the loading or unloading of a quantity of any explosive greater than one hundredweight shall, as long as the explosive remains in the boat, be responsible for keeping it under hatches or covered with double tarpaulins, for displaying at the bow and at the stern a red flag not less than 2 feet square, on a staff not less than 6 feet above the deck, and for seeing that no light or fire is permitted on such boat.

9. Any boat engaged in the loading or unloading of a quantity of any explosive greater than one hundredweight shall, if there be already on board any explosive which cannot be shipped, or transhipped at once, be removed by the owner or tindal to a place of safety appointed by the Master Attendant and shall remain there until the explosive can be shipped or transhipped.

10. All boats containing explosives shall be removed at sunset by the owner or tindal to the mooring specially appointed by the Master Attendant.

11. Subject to regulation No. 3, any quantity of explosive greater than one hundredweight shall be loaded or unloaded at the MacCallum Quay between the hours of 7 A.M. and 4 P.M. or at such other place and time as shall be approved by the Principal Collector.

12. No explosive shall be conveyed to the Customs premises unless at least three hours' notice in writing shall have been given to the Collector. Explosives for shipment will not be allowed to remain in the Customs premises but shall be shipped forthwith.

*Note.*—Under section 9 of Ordinance (No. 8 of 1902) a breach of any of the above regulations will render the party or parties concerned liable to a penalty of Rs. 200, the explosives themselves being liable to forfeiture.

“THE EXPLOSIVES ORDINANCE, 1902.”

THE Governor has, with the advice of the Executive Council, framed under section 27 (b) of “The Explosive Ordinance, 1902,” the following prohibitions and restrictions which may be annexed to a licence granted thereunder. The prohibitions and restrictions published in *Government Gazette* No. 7,530 dated June 11, 1926, are hereby cancelled.

*Prohibitions and Restrictions referred to these Conditions shall be attached to Licences for the Importation of Explosives.*

1. Gunpowder when imported shall be packed in barrels properly joined and hooped; other explosives, such as dynamite, gelignite, and detonators, shall be packed in cases properly joined and secured with copper or brass screws. All packages containing explosives other than gunpowder shall have brass or galvanized iron seals fixed in such a manner as effectively to secure their contents. These seals shall bear the name or other distinguishing mark of the manufacturer of the explosives. Accommodation for explosives which are to be stored, on arrival, in the Government explosives magazine at Welikada shall be obtained from the Colonial Storekeeper before the explosives are imported.

2. The following explosives are not included in this licence:—Fulminates of mercury or of other metals except in the form of caps or detonators, manufactured fireworks containing aluminium powder with any oxygen-carrier, or containing chlorate of potash with sulphur or a sulphide with or without any other matter.

3. No boat shall be employed in the landing of a greater quantity of any explosive than one hundredweight, until three hours' notice shall have been given in writing by the master, owner, or agents of the vessel, to the Inspector of Harbour Police, and until a Police Officer shall have boarded the boat.

4. No explosive shall be placed on board any boat unless it is packed in the manner required by condition No. 1.

5. No more than one hundredweight of explosives shall be loaded or unloaded until all boats, except such as are necessary for the purpose, shall have been removed to a distance of not less than 50 feet from the place of loading or unloading, and no boat, except the boats aforesaid, shall come within 50 feet of such place of loading or unloading.

6. No cargo of any other description shall be taken in any boat conveying a quantity of explosive greater than one hundredweight.

7. The conveyance in the same vehicle or boat of explosive of the 5th (Fulminate) class, of the 6th (Ammunition) class containing its own means of ignition, or of the 7th (Firework) class, together with any explosive of a different class and division from its own is prohibited.

8. The owner and tindal of any boat engaged in the loading or unloading of a quantity of any explosive greater than one hundredweight shall, as long as the explosive remains in the boat, be responsible for keeping it under hatches or covered with double tarpaulins, for displaying at the bow and at the stern a red flag not less than 2 feet square, on a staff not less than 6 feet above the deck, and for seeing that no light or fire is permitted on such boat.

9. Any boat engaged in the loading or unloading of a quantity of any explosive greater than one hundredweight shall, if there be already on board any explosive which cannot be landed at once, be removed by the owner or tindal to a place of safety appointed by the Master Attendant and shall remain there until the explosive can be landed.

10. All boats containing explosives shall be removed at sunset by the owner or tindal to the mooring specially appointed by the Master Attendant.

11. Subject to condition No. 3 any quantity of explosive greater than one hundredweight shall be loaded or unloaded at the MacCallum Quay between the hours of 7 A.M. and 4 P.M. or at such other place and time as shall be approved by the Principal Collector.

12. No explosive shall be landed until a Police Escort is ready for its conveyance to a magazine, and it shall be conveyed only in vehicles approved by a Superintendent of Police. Every vehicle conveying explosives shall display a red flag, and shall be driven with due care.

*Note.*—Under section 27 (d) of Ordinance (No. 8 of 1902) a breach of any of the above regulations will render the party or parties concerned liable to a fine of Rs. 1,000, and a further penalty of Re. 1 for every pound of explosive concerned, the explosives themselves being liable to forfeiture.
