MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend The Designs Ordinance, 1904.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :--

1 This Ordinance may be cited as The Designs Amendment Ordinance, 1930.

Amendment of section 13 of the principal Ordinance.

Short title.

Cancellation of registration of designs.

2 Section 13 of The Designs Ordinance, 1904, is repealed and the following is substituted therefor :—

13 (1) At any time after the registration of a design any person interested may apply to the Registrar for the cancellation of the registration of the design, on either of the following grounds :—

- (a) That the design has been published in Ceylon, rior to the date of registration :
- (b) That the design is appli€d by manufacture to any article in a foreign country, and is not so applied by manufacture in Ceylon to such an extent as is reasonable in the circumstances of the case :

Provided that, if the application be on the last mentioned ground, and the Registrar is satisfied that the time which has elapsed from the date of registration has been insufficient for such application by manufacture in Ceylon, the Registrar may adjourn the application for such time as he may deem sufficient for that purpose; and that in lieu of cancellation the Registrar may order the grant of a compulsory licence on such terms as he may consider just.

(2) From any order made by the Registrar under this section an appeal in the prescribed manner shall lie to the District Court of Colombo, which shall, after such inquiry as may appear necessary, make an order determining whether and subject to what conditions if any cancellation is to be permitted.

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Objects and Reasons.

A design which is used in manufacture in a foreign country and is also registered in Ceylon under the principal Ordinance loses the protection of the local copyright unless within six months of such registration the design is used in manufacture in the Island. This condition is rarely fulfilled, and consequently the copyright which is obtained in these cases by registration usually lapses six months after registration.

2. Representations have been made by the Manchester Chamber of Commerce against this automatic termination of copyrights under section 13 of the principal Ordinance, and it appears reasonable that the protection obtained by registration should prevail until the copyright is formally cancelled. The new section 13 introduced by this Bill therefore does not prescribe the duration of the copyright or make it dependent on use in local manufacture; but it permits the Registrar, after an inquiry held at the instance of any one interested in the termination of the copyright, to cancel it in specified circumstances at any time after registration. From the Registrar's order an appeal is permitted to the District Court of Colombo, and a further appeal to the Supreme Court. 3. The same method of cancellation will be necessary

3. The same method of cancellation will be necessary for terminating a copyright wrongfully granted in respect of a design which had been published in Ceylon prior to its local registration.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information, in substitution for the Draft Ordinance proviously published in the *Government Gazettes* Nos. 7,750 and 7,751 of December 13, 1929, and December 20, 1929, respectively :---

An Ordinance to amend the Registration of Documents Ordinance, No. 23 of 1927.

DE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Registration of Short title. Documents Amendment Ordinance, 1930.

2 The following section is hereby inserted in the principal Ordinance immediately after section 43 thereof :---

43A The document required to be retained by the registrar when a priority notice, seizure priority notice, caveat, or *lis pendens* is registered may, unless its preservation is ordered by any court, be destroyed by him at any time after the expiry of two years from the termination of the period during which the registration is in force.

(1) By the insertion of the following item between items 6 and 7 thereof :---

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6A Cancellation of registration of a priority notice, seizure priority notice; *lis pendens* or caveat, for each Land Registry in which the cancellation is registered, a fee of

(2) By the insertion of the words "requiring registration" immediately after the words "bill of sale" in the note "N B." to item 8 thereof.

4 Part III of the First Schedule to the principal Ordinance is hereby amended as follows :---

- by the substitution of the words "of deeds, instruments or documents, or the attested or certified copies thereof transmitted or delivered under Chapter II" for the word "attested" in the first line of item 1 (a) thereof;
- (2) by the substitution of the words "or index kept under Chapters III, IV, V or VI" for the words "kept under Chapters III or IV" in the first and second lines in item 2 thereo.;
- (3) by the substitution of the word "or" for the word "of" in the first line of item 3 (a) thereof;
- (4) by the numbering of the paragraph in item 3 thereof beginning with the words "For supplying an endorsement" as item 4 thereof.

Objects and Reasons.

The object of this Bill is to amend the Registration of Documents Ordinance, No. 23 of 1927, in certain respects.

2. Clause 2. The efficacy of a registration under the principal Ordinance of a priority notice, a seizure priority notice, a caveat or a *lis pendens* is of limited duration, but nevertheless the documents deposited with a registrar in connection with their registration have at present to be preserved even after they have become valueless. As these documents uselessly encumber the record rooms in registries and increase the congestion there, this amendment authorizes their destruction subject to conditions which will guarantee their existence while there is still a probability of their being required.

3. The remainder of the Bill amends the First Schedule to the principal Ordinance, by the imposition of fees for the inspection of certain books and the registration of certain documents not at present covered by the Schedule, and by the correction of an error and an omission. Amendment of Part III of the First Schedule to the principal Ordinance.

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Insertion of new section 43A in the principal Ordinance.

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Destruction of priority notices, &c., after expiry of registration.

4. Clause 3 (1) provides for a distinct registration fee of 50 cents in respect of the cancellation of a priority notice, seizure priority notice, *lis pendens* or caveat. The present fee of Rs. 12 50 recoverable under the general item 8 of Part I of the First Schedule is considered to be too high.

5. Clause 3 (2) restores the fee of Rs. $12 \cdot 50$ for the registration of a bill of sale that does not require registration, which was recoverable under item 4 of Schedule III of the Land Registration Ordinance, 1891.

6. Clause 4 (1) imposes the same fee for the inspection of attested and certified copies of duplicates as for an inspection of the duplicates themselves, as there is no difference in the legal value of duplicates and copies of them that are attested and certified.

7. Clause 4 (2) authorizes the recovery of fees under item 2 in respect of applications to inspect any book or index kept under Chapters III, IV, V or VI.

8. Clause 4 (3) corrects an obvious misprint, and clause 4 (4) is concerned with suitably marking the last paragraph in Part III of the Schedule.

An Ordinance to amend The Nuwara Eliya Board of Improvement Ordinance, 1896.

B^E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :--

1 This Ordinance may be cited as The Nuwara Eliya Board of Improvement Amendment Ordinance, 1930.

2 Section 13 of the principal Ordinance is amended as follows :---

- (1) By renumbering sub-section (i) as sub-section (j);
- (2) By inserting after sub-section (h) the following new sub-section (i):—

(i) To the payment in accordance with any scheme approved by the Governor in Executive Council of bonuses to its officers and servants and of contributions to a benevolent fund for their benefit.

3 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in section 13 of The Nuwara Eliya Board of Improvement Ordinance, 1896, all payments made by the Board of Improvement, Nuwara Eliya, before the commencement of this Ordinance as bonuses to its officers and servants or as contributions to any benevolent fund for their benefit shall be deemed to have been as validly made as if such payments had been made in pursuance of a scheme duly approved under the said section as now amended by this Ordinance.

Objects and Reasons.

The purposes for which the Board of Improvement, Nuwara Eliya, may apply its funds do not include the payment of bonuses to its officers and servants or contributions to a benevolent fund for their benefit. The Board finds that the expectation of such bonuses and the prospect of payments from a benevolent fund to which it contributes go far toward ensuring a stable and contented staff, and so clause 2 of this Ordinance authorizes for the future the making of such payments. But the Board is already making contributions to a benevolent fund on a mistaken conception of its powers under section 13 of the principal Ordinance; therefore these payments are validated by clause 3.
