## MINUTE.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

No. 8 of 1902,  
II. 574.

**An Ordinance to amend the Explosives Ordinance, 1902.**

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Explosives Amendment Ordinance, 1930.

Amendment of section 10 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 10 of the principal Ordinance is amended by the deletion of the words "or the principal" in the tenth line thereof.

Amendment of section 11 of the principal Ordinance.

3 Section 11 of the principal Ordinance is amended by the addition of the following paragraph at the end thereof :—

Every police officer of and above the rank of sub-inspector shall in respect of the area for the time being under his jurisdiction be deemed to be an inspector of explosives duly appointed under this section.

Amendment of section 15 of the principal Ordinance.

4 Section 15 of the principal Ordinance is amended by the substitution of the words "except on a licence granted by the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council" for the words "except with the licence of the Governor under the hand of the Colonial Secretary" in the third and fourth lines thereof.

Insertion of new section 24 A in the principal Ordinance.

5 The following new section is inserted in the principal Ordinance immediately after section 24 thereof :—

To be exposed for sale in limited quantities.

24 A The amount of explosive exposed for sale shall not exceed one pound, provided (a) that in the case of safety cartridges the amount may be a quantity containing of gunpowder or of small-arm nitro-compound not more than five pounds, and (b) in the case of manufactured fireworks the amount shall not exceed five pounds.

If any explosive is exposed for sale in contravention of this section, the person exposing it for sale shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding twenty rupees, and all or any part of the explosive so exposed may be forfeited.

Amendment of section 25 of the principal Ordinance.

6 Section 25 of the principal Ordinance is repealed and the following is substituted therefor :—

To be sold in canisters, etc. or in limited quantities.

25 The amount of explosive sold otherwise than in a substantial case, canister, or other receptacle made and closed so as to prevent any explosive from escaping, shall not exceed one pound, provided (a) that in the case of safety cartridges the amount may be a quantity containing of gunpowder or of small-arm nitro-compound not more than five pounds, and (b) in the case of manufactured fireworks the amount shall not exceed five pounds; and except when the same is sold to any person employed by or on the property occupied by the vendor for immediate use in the service of the vendor or on such property, the outermost receptacle containing such explosive shall have affixed the word "explosive" and the name of such explosive in conspicuous characters by means of a band or securely attached label or other mark.

If any explosive is sold in contravention of this section the person selling it shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding twenty rupees.

*Objects and Reasons.*

Officers in the police force of and above the rank of sub-inspector are at present usually appointed "inspectors of explosives" for the area within their respective jurisdictions. But as every such appointment has still to be specifically made by the Governor and gazetted under section 11 of the

Explosives Ordinance, 1902, whenever a police officer vested with the powers of an "inspector of explosives" is transferred a fresh appointment and fresh gazetting become necessary. Because these appointments of police officers as inspectors of explosives are now made as a matter of course, there is little advantage in insisting on the present formalities; especially if by avoiding the consequent delays the inconvenience caused by the transfers can be lessened. Therefore within their respective police jurisdictions clause 3 of this Bill vests police officers of and above the rank of sub-inspector with the powers of an inspector of explosives duly appointed under the principal Ordinance.

2. Clause 2 corrects an obvious error in the principal Ordinance.

3. Clause 4 is designed to relieve the Colonial Secretary of the duty of himself signing the licences contemplated in section 15 of the principal Ordinance. As is now the case with the licences mentioned in sections 16 and 27, it will hereafter be possible for the Clerk of the Executive Council to sign the licences issued under section 15 also.

4. Clauses 5 and 6 re-enact section 25 of the principal Ordinance in a modified form separating the provisions dealing with exposure for sale from those concerned with the sale of explosives, so that the amount of explosives that is permitted to be exposed for sale may be limited (clause 5 to quantities that are not capable of being used to seriously endanger the public peace.

## COUNCIL OF LEGAL EDUCATION NOTICES.

### The Incorporated Council of Legal Education.

### The Incorporated Council of Legal Education.

AT a meeting of the Council of Legal Education held on Friday, October 17, 1930, rule 56 was repealed and the following rule substituted in lieu thereof:—

*Rule 56.*—A proctor of the Supreme Court who has practised the profession for not less than 5 years may apply for admission as an advocate of the Supreme Court upon passing the several parts of the examination for the admission of advocates. Upon entering for the examination he shall pay a fee of Rs. 50 for each of the three parts of the said examination and in case of re-entry for any part he shall pay a further fee of Rs. 50 for each such part.
