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## FINAL ORDERS.

## Kalutara S. O. No. 135.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927,"  
declaring Land to be Crown Property.

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Masmoruketiyyedeniya, Kosinnedeniya, &c., situate in the village of Botalawa, in the Maha pattu south of the Pasduw korale east of the Kalutara District, in the Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly notified on the 5th day of November, 1926, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Masmoruketiyyedeniya, Kosinnedeniya, &c., situate in the village of Botalawa, in the Maha pattu south of the Pasduw korale east of the Kalutara District, in the Western Province, containing in extent 766 acres 2 roods and 13 perches, and shown as lots 19, 30, 32, 35, 49, 57, 74½, 74¼, 74⅓, 78, 82, 84, 88, 96, 103, 110, 124, 144, 146, 149, 151, 213, 246, 254, 257, 267, and 276 in block survey preliminary plan No. 110, was made to Walter Terence Stace, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in such notice, such lands would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (*vide* Notice No. 9,363):

And whereas (1) Kudaudage Baron Appu, and (2) Palle Kankanage Dona Sophia Wijegunawardena made claim to the said lot 149 of the notice; and whereas (3) Abdul Rahaman Packeer Mohamed made claim to the said lot 276 of the notice; and whereas (4) Miyanakolatenné Hewahakuruge Pediris made claim to the said lots 96 and 103 of the notice; and whereas (5) Watagalawage Udaris Appu, (6) Watagalage Uraneris, (7) ditto Jamonis, (8) ditto Hendrick, and (9) ditto Singho Appu made claim to the said lots 124, 149, and 213 of the notice; and whereas (10) Watagalage Silinduhami made claim to the said lots 110, 124, 149, and 213 of the notice; and whereas (11) Samarapuli Suduhakuruge Salonchi made claim to the said lot 84 of the notice; and whereas (12) Nallaperuma Arachchigo Don Iyaneris Appuhami made claim to the said lots 32, 35, 49, 82, 84, and 88 of the notice; and whereas (13) Don Harmanis Alwis Gunatilleke made claim to the said lots 144, 146, 151, 246, 254, 257, 267, and 276 of the notice; and whereas (14) John Henry Peter Dassanayako made claim to the said lot 254 of the notice; and whereas (15) Mananahakuruge Katcho made claim to the said lots 19 and 30 of the notice; and whereas (16) Hewahakuruge Sintcha made claim to the said lots 30 of the notice; and whereas (17) Mallawa Arachchigo Don Arnolis Appuhami, (18) ditto Don Abraham Appuhami, (19) ditto Don Andris Appuhami, (20) ditto Alice Nona, and (21) ditto Don Porolis Appuhami made claim to the said lots 110 and 267 of the notice; and whereas (22) Mallawa Arachchigo Don Carolis Appuhami made claim to the said lots 57, 74½, 74¼, 74⅓, and 78 of the notice; and whereas the said 1st claimant, withdrew claim to the said lot 149 of the notice; and whereas the said 2nd claimant entered into an agreement in writing dated the 16th day of July, 1927, whereby in consideration of being declared the purchaser of lot 147 of the notice and of the said plan, upon payment on or before the 15th day of October, 1927, later extended to the 31st day of January, 1928, to the Assistant Government Agent at Kalutara, or to the Settlement Officer, of a sum of Rupees Three hundred and Sixty (Rs. 360) only, she withdrew claim to the said lot 149 of the notice; and whereas the said 3rd claimant withdrew claim to the said lot 276 of the notice; and whereas the said 4th claimant entered into an agreement in writing dated the 11th day of July, 1927, whereby in consideration of being declared along with Hewahakuruge Pilotchia the purchaser, in equal shares of lot 96 and 1 acre more or less of lot 103 of the notice and of the said plan, upon payment on or before the 11th day of October, 1927, to the Assistant Government Agent at Kalutara, or to the Settlement Officer, of a sum of Rupees Three hundred and Fifteen (Rs. 315) only, he withdrew claim to the remainder of the said lot 103 of the notice; and whereas it was further agreed that in default of such payment the claim of the said 4th claimant to the said lot 96 and to the said portion of the said lot 103 in respect of which such payment was to be made should also be considered to have been withdrawn and such lands should be declared under the Waste Lands Ordinances to be the property of the Crown; and whereas the said claimant has failed to make the said payment by the due date; and whereas the claim of the said 4th claimant to the said lot 96 and to the said portion of the said lot 103 is considered to have been withdrawn; and whereas the said 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, and 10th claimants entered into an agreement in writing dated the 11th day of July, 1927, whereby in consideration of the Special Officer abandoning from the

notice and the Settlement Officer settling as private property outside the Waste Lands Ordinances ½ acre more or less of lot 124 of the notice and of the said plan, now shown as lot 124A on the same plan, they withdrew claim to the remainder of the said lot 124 and to the said lots 149 and 213 of the notice; and whereas the said 10th claimant entered into an agreement in writing dated the 11th day of July, 1927, whereby in consideration of being declared the purchaser of 1½ roods more or less of lot 110 of the notice and of the said plan, now shown as lot 110E on the same plan, upon payment on or before the 11th day of October, 1927, to the Assistant Government Agent at Kalutara, or to the Settlement Officer, of a sum of Rupees Twelve and Cents Fifty (Rs. 12.50) only, the said 10th claimant withdrew claim to the remainder of the said lot 110 of the notice; and whereas the said 11th claimant withdrew claim to the said lot 84 of the notice; and whereas the said 12th claimant withdrew claim to the said lots 32, 35, 49, 82, 84, and 88 of the notice; and whereas the said 13th claimant entered into an agreement in writing dated the 11th day of July, 1927, whereby in consideration of being declared along with Warahena Tantrage Andris de Alwis Gunatilleke the purchaser of lots 154, 260, 262, and 3½ acres more or less of lot 276 of the notice and of the said plan, the last one now shown as subdivisional lot 276 on the same plan, upon payment on or before the 11th day of October, 1927, later extended to the 23rd day of December, 1927, to the Assistant Government Agent at Kalutara, or to the Settlement Officer, of a sum of Rupees One thousand Two hundred and Forty (Rs. 1,240) only, the said 13th claimant withdrew claim to the remainder of the said lot 276 and to the said lots 144, 146, 246, 257, and 267 of the notice; and whereas the said 13th claimant withdrew claim to the said lot 151 of the notice; and whereas the said 14th claimant withdrew claim to the said lot 254 of the notice; and whereas the said 15th claimant withdrew claim to the said lots 19 and 30 of the notice; and whereas the said 16th claimant entered into an agreement in writing dated the 11th day of July, 1927, whereby in consideration of being declared the purchaser of ½ acre more or less of lot 30 of the notice and of the said plan, now shown as lot 30A on the same plan, upon payment on or before the 11th day of October, 1927, to the Assistant Government Agent at Kalutara, or to the Settlement Officer, of a sum of Rupees Ten (Rs. 10) only, the said 16th claimant withdrew claim to the remainder of the said lot 30 of the notice; and whereas the said 17th, 18th, and 19th claimants entered into an agreement in writing dated the 11th day of July, 1927; and whereas the said 20th claimant entered into an agreement in writing dated the 17th day of July, 1927, whereby in consideration of the said 17th, 18th, 19th, and 20th claimants being declared along with the said 21st claimant the purchasers of lot 90 and 2½ acres more or less of lot 110 of the notice and of the said plan, the latter now shown as subdivisional lot 110 on the same plan, upon payment on or before the 11th day of October, 1927, to the Assistant Government Agent at Kalutara, or to the Settlement Officer, of a sum of Rupees Six hundred and Twenty (Rs. 620) only, the said 17th, 18th, 19th, and 20th claimants withdrew claim to the remainder of the said lot 110 and to the said lot 267 of the notice; and whereas the said 21st claimant having been duly called upon by a notice in writing under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, duly served upon him to appear and produce before Philip James Hudson, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, the evidence and documents upon which he might rely in proof of his claim did not so appear or produce such evidence and documents; and whereas the said 22nd claimant entered into an agreement in writing dated the 11th day of July, 1927, whereby in consideration of being declared the purchaser of 2 acres more or less of lot 57 and 1 acre more or less of lot 78 of the notice and of the said plan, upon payment on or before the 11th day of October, 1927, to the Assistant Government Agent at Kalutara, or to the Settlement Officer, of a sum of Rupees Three hundred (Rs. 300) only, he withdrew claim to the remainders of the said lots 57 and 78 of the notice; and whereas it was further agreed that in default of such payment the claim of the said 22nd claimant to the said portions of lots 57 and 78 in respect of which such payment was to be made should also be considered to have been withdrawn and the said portions of the said lots 57 and 78 should be declared under the Waste Lands Ordinances to be the property of the Crown; and whereas the said 22nd claimant has failed to make the said payment by the due date; and whereas the claim of the said 22nd claimant to the said portions of the said lots 57 and 78 is considered to have been withdrawn; and whereas the said 22nd claimant withdrew claim to the said lots 74½, 74¼, and 74⅓ of the notice, I, Joseph Light, Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances under and by virtue of the powers vested in me in that behalf by section 4 of the said Ordinances, do hereby on this 16th day of August, 1930, order and declare under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said

Ordinances, that the said lands or portions thereof, as more fully described herein below, are the property of the Crown.
