## FINAL ORDERS.

## Kurunegala S. O. No. 4,527.

## Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Maningalapillawahena, Kongahamulahena, &c., situate in the village of Gurulawela, in the Karanda pattu korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 15th day of January, 1926, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Maningalapillawahena, Kongahamulahena, &c., situate in the village of Gurulawela, in the Karanda pattu korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent 5 acres 3 roods and 9 perches, and shown as lot 65 in block survey preliminary plan No. 2,118, was made to Navroji Maneckji Bharucha, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such lands would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (*vide* Notice No. 8,988):

And whereas Adikari Mudiyansele Appu Singho on behalf of (i.) Jakodi Mudiyansele Ran Menika and (ii.) Adikari Mudiyansele Kapuruhamy made claim thereto, and Louis Lucien Hunter, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances made due inquiry into such claim; and whereas the said 1st and 2nd claimants and Louis Lucien Hunter, Esq., one of the aforesaid Special Officers, came to two agreements in writing dated 17th and 16th days of September, 1926, respectively, concerning the said lands, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, whereby it was agreed that the said claimants should be declared the purchasers of a portion of the said land, upon payment on or before the 16th day of October, 1926, later extended to the 16th day of November, 1926, to the Government Agent at Kurunegala, or to the Settlement Officer, of a sum of Rupees Sixty (Rs. 60) only, as the purchase amount of the said portion of the said land; and whereas the said amount has been duly paid by the said 1st and 2nd claimants, they are hereby, in pursuance of the agreement aforementioned, declared to be the purchaser of the said portion of the said land, as more fully described herein below, and as described in the survey and description thereof authenticated by Arthur Harry Gerald Dawson, Esq., Surveyor-General, bearing date the 7th day of December, 1929, No. 402,641/F. O. T. P. (L. L. L. No. 2,432).

*Description of the Land referred to.*

The lands commonly called or known as Kongahamulahena, and Nelligahamulawatta, situate in the village of Gurulawela, in the Karanda pattu korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, containing in extent 2 acres and 7 perches, shown as lot 65A in block survey preliminary plan No. 2,118, and bounded as follows: on the north by Maningalapillawahena (lot 41) (private), and Manningalawetiawewa (lot 59) (tank and bund) to be declared the property of the Crown under the Waste Lands Ordinances; on the east by the reservation along cart road from Bowatta to Karabalana, to be declared the property of the Crown under the Waste Lands Ordinances; on the south by Kongahamulahena (lot 65B) to be declared the property of the Crown under the Waste Lands Ordinances, and Andiyawatta (T. P. 382,138) sold by the Crown; on the west by Ambagahamulahena and Maningalapillawahena (lot 65) private.

## Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Wewagawahena, Galwanakotuwahena, situate in the village of Gurulawela, in the Karandapattu korale of the Katugampola hatpattu of the Kurunegala District, in the North-Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 15th day of January, 1926, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Wewagawahena, Galwanakotuwahena, situate

and whereas the said 2nd claimant as the duly appointed guardian over the said 3rd minor claimant entered into an agreement in writing dated the 17th day of March, 1927, whereby in consideration of (a) the Special Officer abandoning from the notice and the Settlement Officer settling as private property outside the Waste Lands Ordinances (i.) lots 16 and 36 of the notice and of the said plan, (ii.) 3 acres more or less of lot 65 of the notice and of the said plan, now shown as subdivisional lot 65 on the same plan, (b) the said 2nd and 3rd claimants being declared the purchasers of 1 acre more or less of lot 54 of the notice and of the said plan, now shown as lot 54E on the same plan, for the sum of Rupees Twenty (Rs. 20) only, paid to the Government Agent at Kurunegala on the 9th day of October, 1926, the said 2nd claimant withdrew the claim of the said 3rd minor claimant to the remainders of the said lots 54 and 65 of the notice; and whereas the said 4th claimant entered into an agreement in writing dated the 16th day of September, 1926, whereby in consideration of being declared the purchaser of  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre more or less of lot 6 of the notice and of the said plan, now shown as lot 6D on the same plan, upon payment on or before the 16th day of October, 1926, to the Settlement Officer, or to the Government Agent at Kurunegala, of a sum of Rupees Ten (Rs. 10) only, he withdrew claim to the remainder of the said lot 6 of the notice; and whereas the said Adikari Mudiyansele Ukku Menika as the duly appointed guardian over the said 5th and 6th minor claimants entered into an agreement in writing dated the 22nd day of March, 1927, whereby in consideration of the said 5th and 6th claimants being declared the purchasers of  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre more or less of lot 6 of the notice and of the said plan, now shown as lot 6A on the same plan, for the sum of Rupees Fifteen (Rs. 15) only, paid to the Settlement Officer on the 22nd day of March, 1927, the said Adikari Mudiyansele Ukku Menika withdrew the claim of the said 5th and 6th minor claimants to the remainder of the said lot 6 of the notice; Lindara Mudiyansele Herathamy and (ii.) ditto Podi Appuhamy the purchaser of  $\frac{1}{2}$  acre more or less of lot 57 of the notice and of the said plan, now shown as lot 57F on the same plan, upon payment on or before the 16th day of October, 1926, to the Settlement Officer, or to the Government Agent at Kurunegala, of a sum of Rupees Five (Rs. 5) only, the said 15th claimant withdrew claim to the remainder of the said lot 57 of the notice; and whereas the said 16th claimant entered into an agreement in writing
