**MINUTE.**

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

No. 6 of 1910,  
III. 18.

**An Ordinance to amend The Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910.**

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title.

1 This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Councils Amendment Ordinance, 193

Amendment of section 121 of the principal Ordinance.

2 Section 121 (2) of the principal Ordinance is amended as follows :—

- (a) By the substitution of the words "proportionate remission" for the word "remission" in lines 2 and 3 ;
- (b) By the substitution of the words "the quarter in which this occurs" for the words "any quarter" in line 4 ; and
- (c) By the substitution of the words "a month" for the words "such quarter" in line 6.

*Objects and Reasons.*

The purpose of this Bill is to enable a Municipal Council to remit a portion of the quarterly rates and taxes ordinarily due in respect of a building when for reasons unconnected with structural alterations, repairs or improvements (already provided for in sub-section (1) of section 121 of the Municipal Councils Ordinance, 1910) the building remains untenanted for a whole month. The immediate reason for this amendment is the desire to afford relief to landlords in the present general trade depression which has made the renting of their buildings and the continuance of tenancy a matter of much greater uncertainty than the sub-section that is being amended is adequately capable of providing for in its present form.
