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**PRELIMINARY NOTICES.****Matale Notice No. 10,801.**

## LAND SALES IN THE CENTRAL PROVINCE.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Assistant Government Agent, Nuwara Eliya, will on Monday, February 23, 1931, at 2.30 P.M., at the Kachcheri, Nuwara Eliya, put up for auction the leases of the under-mentioned Crown Building Sites, situated within the administrative limits of the Board of Improvement, Nuwara Eliya, on Lady McCallum's Drive within a distance of three quarters of a mile from the town on the following conditions, *inter alia* :—

1. The officer conducting the sale may, before accepting any bid, satisfy himself of the *bona fides* of the person or persons making it and of his or their ability immediately to make a deposit of ten per centum of the amount of such bid, and should he be unable so to satisfy himself may refuse to accept such bid and may continue the sale as if no such bid had been made.

2. The successful bidder will be required to make immediately with the Assistant Government Agent, Nuwara Eliya, a deposit of ten per centum of the amount of the premium bid, and to make payment of the remaining nine-tenths of the premium bid within one month from the date of the sale.

Information with regard to the situation of the lots, the conditions of sale which the purchasers will be required to sign, and the terms of the leases into which the purchasers will be required to enter, may be obtained from the Assistant Government Agent, Nuwara Eliya. The following are some of the more important covenants, conditions, and stipulations which will be embodied in the leases :—

1. The lease will be for a term of 99 years, the rent being subject to revision by the Lessor after the expiry of every period of 33 years (maximum increase at any revision, 50 per cent).

2. The lessee will be required to covenant with the Lessor that he will—

- (a) erect and complete upon the demised premises within two years from the commencement of the lease and in accordance with plans approved by the Lessor or his Agent a residential building, expending thereon not less than Rs. 12,000;
- (b) not sub-let, sell, donate, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of or deal with his interest in the lease without the written consent of the Lessor or of the Controller of Revenue on the Lessor's behalf;
- (c) maintain all buildings erected by him upon the demised premises in good repair, pay all rates and taxes, and erect and keep in good repair a substantial fence or boundary wall round the demised premises;
- (d) at the expiry of the term of the lease or on its sooner determination surrender the demised premises to the Lessor, together with all buildings erected thereon and all additions, improvements, and fixtures, in good repair and condition, and not be entitled to any payment of any compensation in respect of the said buildings, additions, improvements or fixtures, or on any account whatever;
- (e) preserve all timber and timber-like growths that may be marked by the Forest Officer of the district and pay the liquidated and agreed sum of Fifty Rupees (Rs. 50) for every tree that may be cut or injured.
