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## FINAL ORDERS.

#### Kalutara S. O. No. 148.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."

In the matter of the land commonly called or known as Etambagahadeniya, situate in the village of Migahatenna of the Maha pattu south, in the Pasdun korale east of the Kalutara District, in the Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

Whereas in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 3rd day of April, 1925, that if no claim to the land commonly called or known as Etambagahadeniya, situate in the village of Migahatenna of the Maha pattu south, in the Pasdun korale east of the Kalutara District, in the Western Province, containing in extent 2 acres 2 roods and 29 perches, and shown as lot 801 in block survey preliminary plan No. 109, was made to Walter Terence Stace, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such land would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (vide Notice No. 8,772):

And whereas Potdeniyage Carneris Appu made claim thereto; and whereas the said claimant having died during the pendency of the inquiry, his heirs, namely, (1) Jasinge Lokuhamy, (2) Potdeniyage Abraham Sinno, (3) ditto Andris Appu, (4) ditto John Sinno, (5) ditto Aron Sinno, (6) ditto Podi Sinno, (7) ditto Podihamy, and (8) ditto Brampy Sinno were substituted as claimants; and Walter Terence Stace, Esq., the aforesaid Special Officer, made due inquiry into such claim; and whereas the said substituted claimants and Walter Terence Stace, Esq., the aforesaid Special Officer, came to an agreement in writing dated the 20th day of July, 1927, concerning the said land, under section 4, sub-section (1), of the said Ordinances, whereby it was agreed that the said substituted claimants should be declared the purchasers, in the shares of ½ to the said 1st claimant and ½ to the said 2nd to 8th claimants of a portion of the said land, upon payment on or before the 20th day of August, 1927, to the Assistant Government Agent at Kalutara or to the Settlement Officer of a sum of Rupees Thirty (Rs. 30) only, as the purchase amount of the said portion of the said land; and whereas the said amount has been duly paid, the said substituted claimants are hereby, in pursuance of the agreement aforementioned, declared to be the purchasers in the said shares of the said portion of the said land, as more fully described herein below, and as described in the survey and description thereof authenticated by Arthur Harry Gerald Dawson, Esq., Surveyor-General, bearing date the 12th December, 1929, No. 402,759/F. O. T. P. (L. L. L. No. 2,373.)

The land commonly called or known as Etambagahadeniya, situate in the village of Migahatenna of the Maha pattu south, in the Pasdun korale east of the Kalutara District, in the Western Province, containing in extent 2 roods and 5 perches, and shown as lot 801A in block survey preliminary plan No. 109; and bounded as follows: on the north by Wawulhenemukalanyaya (lot 764) to be declared the property of the Crown under the Waste Lands Ordinances; on the east and south by Etambagahadeniya (lot 801) to be declared the property of the Crown under the Waste Lands Ordinances; on the west by Etambagahadeniya deniyeowita (lot 802) private, Patharahena alias Issarahagodahena (T. 
