## VITAL STATISTICS OF TOWNS IN CEYLON FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 1930.

### REPORT OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL.

THIS report deals with the vital statistics of the 35 principal towns in the Island, proclaimed under sections 31-36 of the Ordinance No. 1 of 1895.

#### Marriages.

2. The number of marriages of residents in proclaimed towns was 436 (357 General, 7 Kandyan, and 72 Muslim), as against 379 in the preceding month and 589 in the corresponding month of last year.

#### Births.

3. The births registered numbered 2,194 (1,105 males and 1,089 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 40·5 per 1,000 of the population, as against 38·2 in the preceding month, 32·6 in the corresponding month of last year, and 34·8 the average for the corresponding months since 1920. The rate ranged from 12·1 in Rambukkana to 112·5 in Kegalla. There were 1,849 births of children whose mothers were residents of the towns, equivalent to an annual rate of 34·1, as against 33·1 in the preceding month, and 27·9 in the corresponding month of last year.

4. In the city of Colombo the births registered numbered 863 (427 males and 441 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 39·0, as against 33·1 in the preceding month, 35·5 in the corresponding month of last year, and 32·6 the average for the corresponding months since 1920. The rate, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 18·0 in Kollupitiya and Wellawatta North to 35·1 in Kotahena South. There were 700 births of children whose mothers were residents of the city, equivalent to an annual rate of 31·5, as against 32·9 in the preceding month and 23·6 in the corresponding month of last year.

#### Deaths.

5. The total deaths registered during the month numbered 1,825 (944 males and 881 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 33·7 as against 30·3 in the preceding month and 36·4 in the corresponding month of last year. There were 1,362 deaths of residents of the towns, equivalent to an annual standardized rate of 27·2, as against 23·5 in the preceding months, 29·3 in the corresponding month of last year, and 28·2 the average for the corresponding months since 1920. The standardized death rate ranged from 11·8 in Weligama to 54·8 in Trincomalee.

6. In the city of Colombo the deaths registered numbered 618 (314 males and 304 females), and were equivalent to an annual rate of 27·8, as against 24·7 in the preceding month and 32·5 in the corresponding month of last year. There were 471 deaths of residents of the city, which corresponded to an annual standardized rate of 24·4, as against 21·4 in the preceding month, 27·4 in the corresponding month of last year, and 23·0 the average for the corresponding months since 1920. The death rate of residents, exclusive of the Fort and the Pettah Wards, ranged from 23·0 in Maradana East to 6·0 in Kollupitiya.

7. The stillbirths registered during the month numbered 163 (91 males and 72 females), as against 158 in the preceding month and 172 in the corresponding month of last year.

#### Infant Mortality.

8. The deaths of children under one year of age amounted to 419, and corresponded to a rate of 220 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended November, 1930. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only, the rate was 191, as against 171 in the preceding month, 221 in the corresponding month of last year, and 289 the average for the corresponding months since 1920. There were 369 deaths of children under

one year of age whose mothers were residents of the towns, which corresponded to a rate of 200 as against 170 in the preceding month, and 232 in the corresponding month of last year.

9. In the city of Colombo the deaths of children under one year of age amounted to 157, and corresponded to a rate of 212 per 1,000 births registered during the twelve months ended November, 1930. Reckoned on the births registered during the month only, the rate was 181, as against 135 in the preceding month, 187 in the corresponding month of last year, and 210 the average for the corresponding months since 1920. There were 131 deaths of children under one year of age whose mothers were residents of the city, which corresponded to a rate of 187, as against 134 in the preceding month and 190 in the corresponding month of last year.

#### Causes of Death.

10. The highest mortality was from Pneumonia to which 12 per cent. of the total deaths were due. Debility (of children under one year of age) caused 9 per cent.; Senility 7 per cent.; Phthisis 6 per cent.; Convulsions and Diseases and Accidents of Childbirth each 5 per cent.; Prematurity, Enteritis, Malaria and Malaria Cachexia, Ankylostomiasis, Bright's Disease and Nephritis each 4 per cent.; Intestinal Parasites other than Ankylostomiasis, Dysentery and Heart Disease each 3 per cent.; Diarrhoea, Bronchitis, Enteric Fever, Paralysis and Influenza each 2 per cent.; Cerebral Hemorrhage, Cancer and Tetanus each 1 per cent.

11. In Colombo, too, the highest mortality was from Pneumonia to which 12 per cent. of the total deaths were due. Debility (of children under one year of age) caused 11 per cent.; Phthisis 7 per cent.; Enteritis 6 per cent.; Senility, Heart Disease, Prematurity, Diseases and Accidents of Childbirth each 5 per cent.; Bright's Disease and Nephritis and Convulsions each 4 per cent.; Bronchitis and Influenza each 3 per cent.; Intestinal Parasites other than Ankylostomiasis, Paralysis and Malaria and Malaria Cachexia each 2 per cent.; Enteric Fever, Cancer, Diarrhoea, Accidents and Negligence, Dysentery and Anaemia each 1 per cent.

12. One death from Plague was registered (in Colombo) as against 2 in the previous month and 1 in the corresponding month of last year.

13. *Infectious Diseases reported.*—The infectious diseases most prevalent during the month was Phthisis of which 134 cases were reported (76 in Colombo, 27 in Kandy); Enteric Fever followed with 64 cases (19 in Colombo, 17 in Kandy); Dysentery 64 (17 in Colombo, 9 in Mullaitivu); Chickenpox 66 (37 in Colombo, 7 each in Kalutara, Galle and Jaffna); Continued Fever 24 (8 in Galle, 7 in Kandy); Mumps 9 (5 in Jaffna, 3 in Colombo); Whooping Cough 3 (2 in Panadure); Measles 2 (in Colombo); Diarrhoea 1 (in Galle); Diphtheria (in Kandy) and Plague 1 (in Colombo).

#### Meteorology.

14. *Rainfall.*—Batticaloa recorded the highest rainfall (20·91 in.). In other towns rainfall ranged from 15·50 in. in Kalmunai to 1·68 in. in Mannar. Colombo recorded 9·73 in.

15. *Mean Temperature.*—The mean temperature varied from 81·4° in Mannar to 60·7° in Nuwara Eliya and was 80·0° in Colombo.
