Ordinance enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof.

No. 3 of 1931.

An Ordinance to provide for the investigation and settlement of industrial disputes.

B. H. BOURDILLON.

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Industrial Disputes (Conciliation) Ordinance, 1931.

Interpretation.

2. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires,—

- (a) "Board" means a Conciliation Board established under this Ordinance.
- (b) "Commission" means the person or persons appointed under section 3 of this Ordinance.
- (c) "Controller" means the person for the time being appointed by the Governor to be the Controller of Labour, and includes a person appointed by the Governor to act for the Controller during such time as he is on leave, whether within or outside the Island, or is ill or for any reason unable to act.
- (d) "Industry" includes trade and any branch or section of a trade or industry, and includes agriculture.
- (e) "Industrial dispute" means any dispute or difference between employers and workmen, or between workmen and workmen, connected with the employment or non-employment, or the terms of the employment, or with the conditions of labour, of any person.
- (f) "Workman" means any person who has entered into or works under a contract with an employer in any capacity, whether the contract is express or implied, oral or in writing, and whether it is a contract of service or of apprenticeship, or a contract personally to execute any work or labour.

Appointment of Commission.

3 (1) The Governor may at any time appoint a Commission consisting of one or more persons to inquire into any matter relating to industry which may be referred to it by the Governor.

(2) If more than one person is appointed in any Commission, the Governor may appoint one of such persons to be chairman, who shall decide the quorum competent to act.

(3) Inquiries by a Commission may be conducted either in public or in private, at its discretion, and the Commission shall report thereon to the Governor, and may make interim reports, if it thinks fit.

Constitution of Boards.

4 (1) A board shall consist of a Chairman and one or more other members as the Controller thinks fit, appointed in equal numbers to represent the parties to the dispute. Provided that where it is impossible to secure the representation of a party to the dispute by reason of the refusal to serve on the board of some or all of the persons appointed to represent the party, the board shall consist of the Controller alone or of some other Public Servant alone.

(2) Where the board consists of more than one person, the chairman shall be the Controller or some other Public Servant as may be decided by the Controller in each case.

(3) The Controller shall in each case decide the quorum of the board competent to act.

(4) A board may sit in public or private at its discretion.

(5) All appointments to a board shall be made by the Controller.

Power of Controller to refer trade disputes to conciliation boards.

5 Whenever an industrial dispute exists or is apprehended, the Controller may, if he thinks fit, subject to any general or special directions which he may receive from the Governor,—

- (a) take steps for the purpose of enabling the parties to the dispute to meet together by themselves or their representatives under the presidency of a chairman mutually agreed upon or nominated by the Controller or by some other person or body with a view to the amicable settlement of the dispute;

- (b) cause inquiry to be made whether a reference of the dispute to a board is likely to lead to a settlement; and
- (c) whether all parties consent or not, refer the dispute to a board for it to endeavour to effect a settlement.

Provided that if there are existing in any industry arrangements for settlement by conciliation or arbitration of disputes in such industry, made in pursuance of an agreement between organisations of employers and organisations of workmen representative respectively of substantial proportions of the employers and workmen engaged in industry, the Controller shall not, unless with the consent of both parties to the dispute or unless and until there has been a failure to obtain a settlement by means of those arrangements, refer the matter for settlement or advice in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this section.

6 (1) Where a dispute has been referred to a board under this Ordinance, it shall be the duty of the board to endeavour to bring about a settlement of the same, and for this purpose the board shall, in such manner as it thinks fit and without delay, investigate the dispute and all matters affecting the merits thereof and the right settlement thereof, and in so doing may do all such things as it thinks fit for the purpose of inducing the parties to come to a fair and amicable settlement of the dispute, and may adjourn the proceedings for any period sufficient in its opinion to allow the parties to agree upon terms of settlement.

Duties of boards and publication of settlement by Controller.

(2) If a settlement of a dispute is arrived at by the parties thereto after it has been referred to a board and during the course of the investigation thereof, a memorandum of the settlement shall be drawn up by the board and signed by the representatives of the parties duly nominated under section 6 (5), or in the case of parties for which representatives have not been so nominated, by the parties themselves, and the board shall send a report of the settlement, together with the memorandum, to the Controller.

(3) If no such settlement is arrived at during the course of the investigation, the board shall, as soon as possible after the close thereof, send a full report regarding the dispute to the Controller, setting forth the proceedings and steps taken by the board for the purpose of ascertaining the facts and circumstances relating to the dispute and of bringing about a settlement thereof, together with a full statement of such facts and circumstances and its findings thereon and the recommendation of the board for the settlement of the dispute.

(4) The recommendation of the board shall deal with each item of the dispute, and shall state in plain language what in the opinion of the board ought and ought not to be done by the respective parties concerned.

(5) The board shall, if practicable, in any settlement reported or recommended by it, nominate representatives of the parties to the dispute for the purposes of this Ordinance: Provided that—

- (a) no such representative shall be nominated by the board for any party unless the board is satisfied, after such inquiries as are possible in the circumstances, that such representative is approved by the party or the majority of the party; and
- (b) the Controller may, after any settlement has been reported or recommended to him by the board, change any representative of a party so nominated, and may nominate another representative, if he is satisfied that the party or the majority of the party so desires.

7 (1) Where any report of a settlement or any recommendation for a settlement is sent to the Controller under section 6 (2) or (3), the Controller shall forthwith publish the same by notice in the Gazette and make available to the public copies of the report in the English, Sinhalese and Tamil languages. Provided that there shall not be included in any report or publication made by the Controller any information obtained by the board in the course of their enquiry as to any trade union or as to any individual business (whether carried on by a person, firm or company) which is not available otherwise than through evidence given at the enquiry, except with the consent of the Secretary of the trade union or of the person, firm or company in question nor shall any individual member of the board or any person concerned in the enquiry, without such consent, disclose any such information.

Publication of report of or recommendation for settlement.

(2) The Controller shall in the said notice require the representatives of the parties duly nominated under section 6 (5), or the parties themselves in the case of parties for which representatives have not been so nominated, to state in writing to the Controller, within fourteen days after the date of publication, whether they accept or reject the settlement reported or recommended, and any such requirement shall be complied with.

(3) Any statement in writing made under sub-section (2) by the representatives of a party duly nominated as aforesaid shall be deemed to have been made by that party.

(4) Any party which fails to make a statement as required by this section, either by its representatives duly nominated as aforesaid, or by itself in the case of any party for which representatives have not been so nominated, shall be deemed to have accepted the settlement.

Publication of acceptance or rejection of settlement.

8 The Controller shall, on the expiry of the fourteen days referred to in section 7 (2), publish in the Gazette and make available to the public information in the English, Sinhalese and Tamil languages regarding the acceptance or rejection of the settlement by the parties, and every such acceptance or rejection shall be effective for the purposes of this Ordinance from the date of its publication under this section.

Prohibition of strikes, &c., without notice of repudiation of settlement.

9 (1) A settlement which is accepted by both parties shall be binding on them until the representatives of one party duly nominated as aforesaid or, in the case of a party for which representatives have not been so nominated, until that party itself shall, by notice in writing sent to the Controller, signify to him the intention of the party to repudiate the settlement.

(2) Any notice of repudiation sent to the Controller under sub-section (1) by the representatives of a party duly nominated as aforesaid shall be deemed to have been sent by that party.

(3) If, during the continuance of the settlement and before the end of fourteen days after notice of repudiation under sub-section (1) has been received by the Controller, an employer who is a party to the settlement, in breach of the terms of the settlement, employs or keeps in his employment any workman on less favourable terms than those specified in the settlement, or otherwise acts in contravention of the settlement, or any person, whether a workman or not, incites a workman to strike or to discontinue employment or work while the settlement is in force, or takes part in a strike, with a view to procuring the alteration of any matter settled by the settlement, that employer or person shall on summary trial and conviction by a police magistrate be liable for each offence to a fine not exceeding two hundred rupees.

(4) The Controller shall, on receipt of notice of repudiation under this section from any party to a settlement, inform the representatives of the other party duly nominated as aforesaid or, in the case of any party for which representatives have not been so nominated, the other party itself.

(5) The Controller may also, if he thinks fit, cause the fact that he has received notice of repudiation under this section to be published in the Gazette and make the notice available to the public in the English, Sinhalese and Tamil languages.

Means of ascertaining the wishes of workmen.

10 Whenever it is necessary to ascertain the wishes of any body of employers or workmen, such wishes may be ascertained by consultation with the representatives of the employers or workmen, if any such have been duly nominated as aforesaid, or by any other convenient means.

Procedure and powers.

11 (1) The Governor in Council may make regulations, to be published in the Gazette, as to the procedure to be observed by boards and Commissions.

(2) In default of or subject to any such regulations, a board or Commission may regulate its own procedure.

(3) All questions before a board or Commission shall be settled by the majority of votes of members present and voting. If the votes are equal, the chairman shall have a second or casting vote.

(4) For the purpose of dealing with any matter referred to it, a board and a Commission shall have all the powers of a District Court to summon and examine witnesses on oath and order the production of documents.

(5) Every matter before a board or Commission by virtue of this Ordinance shall be deemed to be a judicial proceeding within the meaning of sections 190 and 223 of the Ceylon Penal Code.

12 This Ordinance shall apply to persons in the employment of the Crown or Government only if their emoluments are fixed at daily rates :

Provided however that it shall not apply to persons in the naval, military, or air services of the Crown, or to the police or prison services :

And provided further that no action with reference to an industrial dispute between the Government and workmen employed by the Government shall be taken under this Ordinance, except by the order of the Governor.

The following Draft of a proposed Ordinance is published for general information :—

An Ordinance to amend "The Criminal Procedure Code, 1898."

No. 15 of 1898,

BE it enacted by the Governor of Ceylon, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof, as follows :—

1 This Ordinance may be cited as "The Criminal Procedure Code (Amendment) Ordinance, 1931."

Short title.

2 Section 157 of the principal Ordinance is amended—

Amendment of

(a) In sub-section (1) by substituting the words "when a Magistrate who is not specially empowered by the Governor to exercise the powers under sub-section (2) has concluded the inquiry he shall" for the words "when the inquiry has been concluded the Magistrate shall" in lines 1 and 2 ;

(b) In sub-section (2) by renumbering it as sub-section (3) ;

(c) In sub-section (3) by renumbering it as sub-section (4) ;
and

(d) After sub-section (1) by inserting the following as new sub-section (2) :—

(2) When a Magistrate who is specially empowered by the Governor to exercise the powers under this sub-section has concluded the inquiry he shall (a) if he finds that there are not sufficient grounds for committing the accused for trial discharge him or (b) if he finds that there are sufficient grounds for committing the accused for trial first frame a charge declaring with what offence the accused is charged, read and explain it to him and proceed in respect thereof in the manner prescribed in section 155, then make an order committing the accused for trial before a higher court by which such offence is shown in the eighth column of the Second Schedule to be triable, and finally forward the record to the Attorney-General remanding the accused to custody or admitting him to bail as he thinks proper.

3 Section 158 of the principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) In sub-section (1) by inserting the words "that the committal be quashed or" between the word "directs" and the word "that" in line 3 ; and

(b) In sub-section (2) by inserting the words "or not quashed" between the word "directed" and the word "by" in line 1, and by adding the words "and if such indictment charges the accused with an offence other than that in respect of which the evidence was recorded he shall with reference to the

offence in the indictment be addressed and have his statement recorded in the manner prescribed in section 155 and be allowed to recall and examine any witnesses already examined" at the end.

Amendment of section 160 of the principal Ordinance.

4 Section 160 of the principal Ordinance is amended by substituting the words "On the accused being served with a copy of an indictment" for the words "On committing the accused" in line 1.

Amendment of section 161 of the principal Ordinance.

5 Section 161 of the principal Ordinance is amended in sub-section (1) by substituting the words "After the accused has been served with a copy of the indictment and before the commencement of the trial the Magistrate may if he thinks it desirable and shall if so required by the Attorney-General" for the words "The Magistrate may after commitment and before the commencement of the trial" in lines 1 and 2.

Amendment of section 162 of the principal Ordinance.

6 Section 162 of the principal Ordinance is amended in sub-section (1) by substituting the words "When the accused is served with a copy of the indictment the Magistrate shall" for the words "When the Magistrate commits the accused for trial he shall" in lines 1 and 2.

Amendment of section 163 of the principal Ordinance.

7 Section 163 of the principal Ordinance is amended by substituting the words "The Magistrate shall when the accused is served with a copy of the indictment" for the words "The Magistrate shall if the accused is committed for trial" in lines 1 and 2.

Amendment of section 164 of the principal Ordinance.

8 Section 164 of the principal Ordinance is amended by substituting the words "After the accused is served with a copy of the indictment" for the words "When the accused has been committed for trial" in line 1.

Amendment of section 165 of the principal Ordinance.

9 Section 165 of the principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) In sub-section (1) by substituting the words "When the accused is served with a copy of the indictment the Magistrate shall" for the words "When the Magistrate commits the accused for trial he shall" in lines 1 and 2; and
- (b) In sub-section (2) by substituting the words "The Magistrate shall after the accused is served with a copy of the indictment notify the committal" for the words "The Magistrate shall forthwith after committing the accused for trial notify such committal" in lines 1 and 2.

Amendment of section 192 of the principal Ordinance.

10 Section 192 of the principal Ordinance is amended in sub-section (1) by adding the words "Provided that a Magistrate who is specially empowered by the Governor to exercise the powers under section 157 (2) shall comply with the requirements of sub-section 2 (b) of the said section before so forwarding the record" at the end.

Amendment of section 387 of the principal Ordinance.

11 Section 387 of the principal Ordinance is amended by substituting the words "direct that the accused be committed to the court nominated by him and shall when he so directs or when he acquiesces in a commitment made under section 157 (2)" for the words "name the court to which such commitment shall be made and in such event shall" in lines 4 and 5.

Insertion of new section 387A in the principal Ordinance.

12 After section 387 the principal Ordinance is amended by inserting the following as new section 387 A :—

Attorney-General may quash commitment.

387 A. Whenever a Police Court shall have committed an accused for trial under the provisions of section 157 and the Attorney-General shall be of opinion that no valid charge can be preferred against the accused in respect of the facts proved the Attorney-General may forward to such court an order in writing directing that the commitment be quashed and that the accused be discharged from the complaint information and charge on which he was committed and from further detention if he is in custody, and thereupon a Police Magistrate of such court shall cause the accused to be brought before him and so discharged and all proceedings against the accused on the said complaint information and charge shall be stayed.

Amendment of section 389 of the principal Ordinance.

13 Section 389 of the principal Ordinance is amended in sub-section (1) by inserting the words "When a Police Magistrate has forwarded the proceedings in any case to the Attorney-General as required by section 157 (1)" at the beginning.

- 14 Section 390 of the principal Ordinance is amended—
- (a) In sub-section (1) by inserting the words "if pending" between the word "shall" and the word "be" in line 5; and
- (b) In sub-section (2) by substituting the word "inquiry" for the word "case" in line 2, by substituting the words "such proceedings" for the words "the inquiry to which such proceedings relate" in line 4 and by deleting the words "and to conduct and conclude such inquiry in accordance with the terms of such instructions" at the end.

Amendment of section 390 of the principal Ordinance.

Objects and Reasons.

This Bill gives effect to the recommendations contained in the "Report of the Committee on Delays in the Administration of Justice in Criminal Courts" (Sessional Paper XII.—1929) that the Criminal Procedure Code, 1898, be amended so as to authorize Police Magistrates to commit for trial without reference to the Attorney-General those cases which they are not permitted to try summarily. It is considered advisable however to extend this new privilege only to Police Magistrates who are specially empowered by the Governor to exercise it, and the amendments necessary for this purpose would therefore merely supplement and not alter the existing procedure. But in giving effect to the required changes it has been found necessary to amend the form of some sections which are and will remain concerned with only the present procedure.

2. Clause 2 (a) of the Bill amends section 157 (1) of the principal Ordinance so as to limit its applications to Magistrates who are not specially empowered by the Governor to exercise the new powers and clause 2 (d) introduces a new sub-section (2) to section 157 which confers on Magistrates who are so empowered the right to themselves commit cases for trial without prior reference to the Attorney-General.

3. Clause 12 enacts a new section 387A which empowers the Attorney-General to quash a committal made by a Magistrate under the new section 157 (2) when he thinks it unsustainable, and clause 3 (a) by an amendment of section 158 (1) requires the Magistrate to discharge the accused in such circumstances.

4. Clause 11 amends section 387 so as to require the Attorney-General to prepare and send to the Magistrate an indictment whenever he does not exercise his powers of quashing the committal, and under section 158 (2) as amended by clause 3 (b) the Magistrate has to read, explain and serve a copy of this indictment on the accused.

5. To provide for a case where the Attorney-General is of opinion that more evidence than has been already recorded by the Magistrate should be available at the trial, clause 14 introduces changes in section 390 which will permit the Attorney-General after the conclusion of the inquiry and after the indictment has been served on the accused to direct the Magistrate to record further evidence by virtue of the powers in section 161 as amended by clause 5. The present right of the Attorney-General to require the Magistrate to record such supplementary evidence during the inquiry and before the indictment is served on the accused is made inapplicable to the new procedure governing Magistrates enjoying the new privilege by the alteration to section 389 effected by clause 13.

6. Clauses 4, 6, 7, 8, and 9 alter the stage at which the steps provided for in sections 160, 162, 163, 164, and 165 are to be taken, by fixing it for the future with reference to the time at which a copy of the indictment is served on the accused. And clause 5 does the same thing among others in respect of section 161.

7. Clause 10 by a new proviso to section 192 authorizes a Magistrate who enjoys the right conferred by the new section 157 (2) to himself commit a case for trial to a higher court when at the end of a summary trial of that case he thinks the accused ought to be punished with a sentence exceeding the jurisdiction of the Police Court.
