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FINAL ORDERS.**Ratnapura S. O. No. 1,982.****Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."**

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Puswelketiyehena, Delwattehena, &c., situate in the village of Paragahamaditta, in the Helapalle pattu of the Meda korale of the Ratnapura District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 19th day of November, 1926, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Puswelketiyehena, Delwattehena, &c., situate in the village of Paragahamaditta, in the Helapalle pattu of the Meda korale of the Ratnapura District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, containing in extent 29 acres 1 rood and 25 perches, and shown as lot 63 in block survey preliminary plan No. 263, was made to Ralph Henry Bassett, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such lands would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (*vide* Notice No. 9,388):

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Halpanwilettenehena, Bollilagalahena, &c., situate in the village of Paragahamaditta, in the Helapalle pattu of the Meda korale of the Ratnapura District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, and 1903."

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Puwalgasmadehena, Galaudamandiyehena, &c., situate in the village of Paragahamaditta, in the Helapalle pattu of the Meda korale of the Ratnapura District, in the Province of Sabaragamuwa, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."

and whereas it was further agreed that in default of such payment the claim of the said 5th claimant to the said portion of land in respect of which the said payment was to be made should also be considered to have been withdrawn, and the said portion of land should be declared to be the property of the Crown under the Waste Lands Ordinances;
