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FINAL ORDERS.

Kalutara S. O. No. 158.

Order under Section 4, Sub-section (1), of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."

In the matter of the lands commonly called or known as Mahawilegoda, Hunganwilegoda, situate in the village of Kamburawala, in Pasdun korale east of the Kalutara District, in the Western Province, and of "The Waste Lands Ordinances of 1897, 1899, 1900, 1903, and 1927."

WHEREAS in pursuance of section 1 of the said Ordinances it was duly declared and notified on the 21st day of October, 1927, that if no claim to the lands commonly called or known as Mahawilegoda, Hunganwilegoda, situate in the village of Kamburawala in Pasdun korale east of the Kalutara District, in the Western Province, containing in extent 3 acres 1 rood and 29 perches, and shown as lot 193 in block survey preliminary plan No. 114, was made to Norman John Luddington, Esq., Special Officer appointed under section 28 of the said Ordinances, within the period of three months from the date specified in the said notice, such lands would be declared the property of the Crown, and dealt with on account of the Crown (*vide* Notice No. 9,642):
