## LAND SALES IN THE WESTERN PROVINCE.

**Colombo No. 27.**—The Government Agent, Western Province, will on Saturday, July 25, 1931, at 12 noon at the Government Agent's Office in Colombo, put up for sale by auction, or otherwise dispose of, the allotment of Crown land, more particularly described in the schedule hereto, in accordance with the regulations of Government regarding sales of Crown land and subject to the following special conditions :—

- (1) The auction will be confined to the original owners from whom the allotment of land was acquired by the Crown or to the heirs of such of the original owners who are now deceased.
- (2) Prior to the auction, the Government Agent shall prepare a list of such original owners or their heirs and no bid will be accepted from or on behalf of any person whose name does not appear in such list.
- (3) The decision of the Government Agent or of his representative who will conduct the sale as to the right of any person or persons to have his or their name or names included in such list shall be final. The Government Agent or his representative may, in his absolute discretion, refuse to accept any bid from any person.
- (4) The allotment of land will be sold to the highest bidder whose name appears in such list provided expressly that he agrees to be bound by these conditions of sale and duly signs a copy of such conditions as evidence of the fact that he agrees to be so bound.
- (5) The successful purchaser shall, within a period of one year from the date of purchase, fill the pits on the allotment of land at his own expense and shall, within a period of one month from such date, sign a special agreement undertaking so to fill the pits on the land at his own expense.
- (6) If the successful purchaser fails to fill the pits within the period of one year referred to above or if he fails or neglects to perform and carry out the agreement referred to in condition 5 above, the purchase money paid by such successful purchaser shall be forfeited to the Crown as liquidated damages and not as a penalty and the title to the allotment of land or to any interest therein shall remain in or revert to the Crown.
- (7) No Crown grant shall be issued in favour of the successful purchaser unless and until such purchaser has duly observed and carried out the conditions and provisions herein and in the agreement referred to in condition 5 above contained.
