PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR.

In the Name of His Majesty GEORGE THE FIFTH, by the Grace of GOD of Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions beyond the Seas King, Defender of the Faith, Emperor of India.

PROCLAMATION.

By His Excellency Sir GRAEME THOMSON, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight Commander of the Most Honourable Order of the Bath, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Island of Ceylon and its Dependencies.

GRAEME THOMSON.

WHEREAS by virtue of the provisions of Article LXI. of the Ceylon (Legislative Council) Order in Council, 1923, the Governor may at any time, by Proclamation, dissolve the Legislative Council;

And whereas by Article 3 of the Ceylon (State Council) Order in Council, 1931, it is provided that the Governor shall dissolve the Legislative Council at such time, not later than six months after the commencement of the said last mentioned Order in Council, as he shall think fit;

And whereas the said last mentioned Order in Council came into operation on the Fifteenth day of April; 1931. Now know Ye that We, the Governor, do hereby proclaim and order that the Legislative Council shall be dissolved on the Seventeenth day of April, 1931.

Given at Nuwara Eliya, in the said Island of Ceylon, this Sixteenth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand Nine hundred and Thirty-one.
